RESOLUTION NO. 2022-____

Awarding Audio/Visual Equipment bids for the Courthouse/Sheriff/Jail Project

Executive Summary

Jefferson County continues its work toward renovating the Courthouse, Sheriff's Office, and/Jail. A key area of emphasis is to ensure that this project meets current and anticipated future technology needs, to include audio visual needs. Design Engineers, as a sub-contractor to Potter Lawson and Pro-Audio as consultant to the county, have been working with staff, the state court system (CCAP), and the 3rd Judicial District, which has administrative oversight of Jefferson County Courts to determine the County's audio/visual needs. The audio/visual bid package was published on October 20, 2022 and consisted of a base bid and twenty alternative bids. The base bid included requirements for the courts, including court rooms and hearing rooms; jury deliberation rooms; larger jury assembly and training rooms; the county board room and adjacent conference rooms; and the Sheriff's Office dispatch center, emergency operations center, and roll call and patrol room. The alternative bids consisted of seven alternatives for office space, nine alternatives for conference room space, one alternative for a room scheduler, and one alternative for an extended service contract. This project has been budgeted to be funded through carryover funds allocated towards this project.

A total of 2 bids were received and were opened on November 4, 2022. Upon review of the bids, staff made a recommendation to the Building and Grounds Committee at the November 8, 2022 meeting to postpone action until additional due diligence could be completed for its next meeting on December 5, 2022. The full bid tabulation is provided in Exhibit 1 attached and incorporated hereto.

Upon review of bids, the County Administrator recommend to the Building and Grounds Committee and Finance Committee to accept the following bids: base bid; alternative 1 (6 units); alternative 5 (1 unit), alternative 7 (2 units), alternative 8 (1 unit), alternative 9 (2 units), alternative 10 (1 unit), alternative 11 (1 unit), alternative 12 (1 unit), alternative 14 (1 unit), alternative 15 (2 units), alternative 16 (1 unit), alternative 18 (1 unit), alternative 19 (1 unit) and alternative 20 (1 unit) for a total cost of \$2,376,061.87. Further, the County Administrator is authorized to install infrastructure at priority locations at a price not to exceed an additional \$50,000.

The bids were considered by the Building and Grounds Committee on December 5, 2022, which recommended approval by a vote of 4-0. The Finance Committee also considered these bids on December 7, 2022, and recommended approval by a vote of 5-0. This resolution authorizes the County Administrator to enter into a contract with AVI-SLP and accept the base bid and proposed alternatives.

WHEREAS, the executive summary and the below bid tabulation are incorporated into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board has approved the project budget and has

authorized funds for purposes of audio/visual systems, with additional revenue sources identified to limit use of project contingency and

WHEREAS, bids were solicited, received, and reviewed by staff of Jefferson County, Pro-Audio, and Maas Brothers Construction for said project, and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2022, the Building and Grounds Committee reviewed the bids and on December 7, 2022, the Finance Committee reviewed the bids, with both committees recommending to award this bid to the lowest responsible bidder, AVI- SLP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with AVI-SLP and accept the base bid and proposed alternatives.

Fiscal Note: The original budget for audio-visual equipment was \$1,000,000. This resolution will increase the budget for this item to \$2,426,062. Additional funding sources for this item have been identified as follows: \$400,000 of interest income from the investment of bond proceeds; \$375,000 of funding from the American Rescue Plan Act; \$216,000 from fees received from Bug Tussel for the guarantee of \$20,000,000 of revenue bonds issued by Fond du Lac County, and \$435,061 of combined carryover funds from 2022 general fund operating results and project contingency. Administration and Finance will continue to work with the Finance Committee to identify other alternative funding sources in order to minimize the impact to project contingency.

Amending supervisory district boundaries to reflect annexations

Executive Summary

On November 9th, 2021, the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution Number 2021-43 which established 30 supervisory districts for the purpose of electing the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors. Wisconsin statute section 59.10(3)(c) allows the County Board of Supervisors to amend supervisory districts to reflect city and village incorporation, annexation, detachment or consolidation which has occurred since its last adoption or amendment of supervisory districts and to make such adjustments to supervisory district boundaries as may be appropriate for purposes of election administration. A common practice is for cities and villages to assign the area being annexed to the adjacent ward within their corporate limits and the County Board to amend supervisory district boundaries to reflect the annexations which have occurred since the County Board adopted the current supervisory districts following the 2020 Census. To date, three annexations have occurred since the 2021 adoption of the supervisory districts. The annexations are described in detail below and the attached maps identify the annexations. The Executive Committee considered this resolution on November 30, 2022 and recommended forwarding to the Jefferson County Board for adoption.

WHEREAS, the executive summary is incorporated into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, resolution number 2021-43 established 30 supervisory districts and their boundaries within Jefferson County, and

WHEREAS, three annexations have occurred since the supervisory districts were established on November 9, 2021, in Resolution Number 2021-43, and

WHEREAS, the table below shows the 2021 supervisory districts and the proposed amendments to the supervisory districts.





RESOLUTION NO. 2022

Establishing the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program

Executive Summary

The Jefferson County Fair Park is seeking to establish the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program. This program offers financial support to fair animal auction participants to enhance their ability to succeed in livestock projects and help with their participation in the Jefferson County Fair. Funding for this program is through activities such as a silent auction, pledges, and other fundraising activities or donations designated for this program. Applicants must submit a formal application; be a current Jefferson County Fair Junior exhibitor who has participated in the annual Jefferson County Fair Auction after 2022; and be in good standing with the Fair. Award recipients will be announced during the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction & Youth Celebration each year beginning in 2023 and continuing as long as funds are available. The Jefferson County Fair Park Committee considered this resolution on December 8, 2022, and recommended forwarding to the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors to approve establishing the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program.

WHEREAS, the executive summary is incorporated into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, establishing the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program will provide financial support to fair animal auction participants helping them to enhance their ability to succeed in livestock projects and with their participation in the Jefferson County Fair, and

WHEREAS, this Grant Program will be exclusively funded through fundraising events and donations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors that the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program is hereby established as described herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Fair Park Committee is delegated policy oversight in the administration of the Jefferson County Fair Animal Auction and Youth Celebration Grant Program.

Fiscal Note: Funding for this resolution in the amount of \$360,000 of revenue and expense was established in the 2023 Fair Park budget which was passed on November 15, 2022. No budget adjustment is necessary.

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-____

Amending the 2023 Land and Water Conservation Department Budget

Executive Summary

The 2021-2030 Land and Water Resources Management Plan was approved by the Jefferson County Board in February 2021. This plan sets forth a strategic work plan for achieving goals that protect and improve land and water resources in the county. One of the actions in the plan is to obtain a better understanding of the groundwater quality throughout the county through a well water study. This action is also in the Comprehensive Plan's implementation plan.

The Land and Water Conservation Department, in collaboration with other Departments, worked with the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point to design a study of the groundwater in Jefferson County. The plan details the following: selection of wells to represent the diversity of factors that may influence well water quality, recruitment of property owners to have their wells tested, the 18 different elements in the water that will be analyzed, data analysis, and dissemination of the information. The results will be used to understand the quality of Jefferson County's groundwater, educate well owners about any identified health risks, and educate citizens about the importance of well water testing and the protection of groundwater.

The scope of work and study design was presented to the Land and Water Conservation Committee on November 16, 2022, and the Finance Committee on December 7, 2022. The Finance Committee recommend 5-0 to allocate up to \$150,000 of American Rescue Plan Act funds for the study from the 2023 Land and Water Conservation Budget. A budget amendment is required to increase revenue and expenditures in the Land and Water Conservation Department 2023 budget for this groundwater study. There will be no additional costs to the county or well owners who participate on a voluntary basis.

WHEREAS, the executive summary is incorporated into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County had allocated \$200,000 of its American Rescue Plan Act dollars towards "Clean Water Initiatives," and

WHEREAS, staff identified and recommend the development of a county-wide comprehensive groundwater study based on previous planning work completed and approved by the County Board through the 2021-2030 Land and Water Management Plan and the Jefferson County Comprehensive Plan, and

WHEREAS, the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point was engaged to perform this groundwater study due to its known quality of work and established processes based on working with other counties in the state on similar studies and its efforts to aggregate data.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with the University of Wisconsin - Stevens Point for purposes of a ground water study at a cost not to exceed \$150,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2023 Land and Water Conservation Department Budget is hereby amended for the adjustments described herein.

Fiscal Note: On September 2, 2021, the Joint Executive and Finance Committees approved a plan for the expenditure of the American Rescue Plan Act funding which included \$200,000 for a water study in Jefferson County. The proposal referenced by this resolution was received after the 2023 budget was approved and therefore a budget adjustment is necessary to enact this resolution. This resolution authorizes an increase of \$150,000 of ARPA funding to the Land and Water Conservation Department budget and increases the budgeted expenditures in the Land and Water Conservation Department by \$150,000. This is a budget amendment. County Board approval requires a two-thirds vote of the entire membership of the County Board (20 votes of the 30member County Board).

Amending Official Zoning Map

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors has heretofore been petitioned to amend the official zoning map of Jefferson County, and

WHEREAS, Petitions R44465A-22, R4446A-22 and R4447A-22, were referred to the Jefferson County Planning and Zoning Committee for public hearing on November 17, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments have been given due consideration by the Board of Supervisors in open session.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors does amend the official zoning map of Jefferson County as follows:

FROM A-1, EXCLUSIVE AGRICULTURAL TO A-2, AGRICULTURAL AND RURAL RESIDENTIAL

Rezone PIN 002-0714-0831-000 (32.383 ac) with conditional use to allow a recreational facility (outdoor motorcycle riding/racing) directly related to open space uses & the necessity for a rural location.
