Fair Time Campsite Registration Jefferson County Fair – July 9 – 13, 2014

All youth exhibitors showing livestock at the Jefferson County Fair can apply for a campsite (with adult supervision) on the grounds during the fair as space permits, **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE.** This privilege is provided by the Jefferson County Fair Park Committee. While using the campsite the following rules will be enforced.

- 1. All young people (under 21 years of age) staying on the fairgrounds overnight must be under the direct supervision of at least one of their parents or a qualified (21 years of age or older) adult as designated by their parents. There must be a qualified adult in the campsite overnight. Young people without appropriate supervision will be asked to leave the grounds. No one at any time is allowed to stay in stock trailers either inside or outside the park unless they are camping units and paying for camping.
- 2. Only one vehicle is allowed per campsite and park only in your own space or be ticketed.
- 3. No alcohol will be permitted in the Campground area; this is the policy of 4-H and the Fair Park. It is only allowed in the designated areas by the Grandstand and Entertainment Tents.
- **4.** Youth on the fairgrounds are not allowed to have in their possession or consume alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs. Any underage person consuming alcohol will be ticketed and ejected from the fairgrounds.
- 5. Fairground curfew is 1 a.m. By that time, everyone should be settled down for the evening and quiet. If you are stopped by security, you will be required to be escorted to the campsite and follow up with responsible adult.
- 6. Also, youth are expected to conduct themselves in an orderly fashion with respect for other people and property.
- 7. For safety reasons, all extension cords will be placed by the campground superintendent ONLY.
- 8. No open fires of any type will be allowed on the Fair Park grounds.
- 9. Camping will be allowed in designated areas ONLY.
- 10. GOLF CARTS and other similar Utility Vehicles by **PERMIT ONLY** and on a case by case basis.
- 11. NO bikes, skateboards, scooters, or roller blades are allowed inside the park at any time.
- 12. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by UW-Extension Agents or Fair Park Staff may result in the removal of exhibitor, camper, projects and premium loss. NO REFUNDS.
- 13. NO PETS ARE ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE CAMPING AREA!!! This includes project animals, i.e. horse, steer, sheep, dairy as well as dogs. Violators will be asked to leave.

Anyone not following these rules will have their passes revoked and will be asked to leave the fairgrounds. Anyone asked to leave the fairgrounds for an infraction of the rules will not be allowed to camp in the following years. Persons needing to get in touch with overnight fairgrounds campers for emergencies should try one of these phone numbers: Fair Office: 920/674-7148 or Jefferson County Sheriff's Department: 920/674-7310. Overnight security will be present at the park from Wednesday, July 9 - Saturday, July 12. Jefferson County Sheriff's Department Deputies will be patrolling.

If you have any questions regarding campsites, please contact the fair office or the campground superintendent (920/988-0880) before signing this form. The campground's superintendent will assign campsites.

Every campsite will be required to purchase one (1) Family Five Pack

Livestock exhibitors at the Jefferson County Fair may use the campgrounds designated for their use. All persons staying overnight at a campsite MUST be registered with the Fair Park Office by June 2nd, 2014.
