

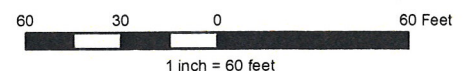

Dear Farmland Preservation Participant:

Based on information you provided on your 2016 Annual Certification, you indicated you have dairy cattle. New Conservation Standards have been added to Farmland Preservation. One of the rules directly affects dairies.

There must be no significant discharge of process wastewater to waters of the state from feed storage, milkhouse waste or other sources.

As part of our Status Review process, the Jefferson County Land and Water Conservation Department is sending out this questionnaire to all dairy farms enrolled in Farmland Preservation.

In order to assist the Jefferson County Land and Water Conservation Department with determining your compliance with the new rule, please answer the following questions:
