- 1. The Outcome Evaluation being conducted by Dr. Meg Waraczynski from U.W.-Whitewater has progressed. With the cooperation of the DOC, we will collect a specific set of demographic data on all ATC program participants. As well, the DOC will collect the same set of data on all non-program offenders with OWI 3-5 convictions. One area of concern involved the potential inability to find exact Matched Pair non-participants. Dr. Waraczynski assured that collecting a large enough sample size can allow her team to account for any demographics differences or shortcomings.
- 2. Dr. Paul Gregory from U.W.-Whitewater will be conducting a Process Evaluation of ATC on March 13th through March 15th. This will consist of a review of all program materials, two half days of interviews with the Treatment Court Team and observing Treatment Court staffing and Court on March 14th. Following the study, his team will prepare a report on the program's adherence to evidenced based practices. This report will grade each component of the program and will make specific recommendations for improvements.
- 3. In the process of organizing these evaluations, we were able to initiate a cooperative study between Walworth County Human Services and Jefferson County Human Services looking at the effectiveness of treatment interventions for OWI 1st and 2nd treatment clients. Dr. Waraczynski and her students will work directly with both agencies to complete the study.
- 4. The WCS contract was finalized and signed, and was submitted to the Dept. of Justice on 1/29/2018 as part of the Grant Award packet.
- 5. The purchase of 51 shots of Vivitrol has been made and those doses are available to program participants as of this week. Samples continue to be available in the jail.
- 6. WCS is continuing to enter ATC Participant Data into CORE. All DTC Participant data is entered.
- 7. Case Manager James Feldman's last day with WCS is March 3rd. WCS has posted this position and is actively seeking applicants. Case Manager Morgan Rhode will handle the supervision of all program participants. I will assist in meeting with participants as needed and will observe all urine testing for male participants.
- 8. CORE report functions continue to be inactive. There has been no date provided by DOJ when these features will be available. I will follow up with DOJ again prior to next month's meeting.
- 9. The Jefferson County Drug Free coalition is continuing to host free Narcan trainings at Jefferson County Libraries. I will be coordinating trainings at the Watertown Public Library on March 6, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. and the Lake Mills Public Library on March 20, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. There will also be training in Palmyra at the Powers Memorial Library on March 7th, 2018 at 6:00 pm. Spanish interpretation services have been available at all training sessions and will be available at the remaining sessions.

- 10. On April 12th, 2018, the Drug Free Coalition will be putting on screening of the award winning documentary "Written Off." This film chronicles the initial addiction, subsequent patterns of use and ultimate overdose death of a young WI man based on his detailed diaries, photos and videos. Following the screening, a Q&A session will be held examining common themes from the film and exploring concrete steps the audience can take if they observe these same behaviors in people they know. I have secured the commitment of Chief Roets from Watertown Police Department to participate in the Q&A and am looking for and considering other individuals. A resource fair will be held immediately prior the screening.
- 11. The Treatment Court Team will be attending the WATCP conference from April 18th through the 20th.
