1. Dr. Paul Gregory from U.W.-Whitewater and a student intern conducted two days of interviews and observed a Treatment Court staffing and Court session as part of a Process Evaluation. The interviews occurred on March 13<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> and the Court session occurred on March 14<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Gregory and his student will review their materials and will likely be conducting a follow up interview with the Coordinator in the coming weeks. They will then prepare an initial report assessing Jefferson County's adherence to evidence based practices and WATCP Treatment Court Standards. This will be reviewed with Coordinator Holler and Administrator Wehmeier for accuracy with a final report likely available in May. Dr. Gregory will be available to present his report to this body once the final report is completed. It is anticipated he would be able to present his report to the CJCC in May.
2. WCS is continuing its search for a Case Manager. One interview has been conducted as of this report with another candidate being reviewed.
3. There has been no change in the CORE report accessibility. The DOJ stated they hope the reports are available in late spring or early summer.
4. Jefferson County has been in communication with DOJ to schedule a data migration from the previous DOJ database into CORE. DOJ is not ready for this migration to occur but will notify us when they are.
5. Due to CORE being available, the screening and eligibility process for ATC is now the same process as DTC. In addition, additional background information on each applicant is being provided to the District Attorney's Office following the initial screening. This includes Substance Abuse History, Residential Situation, Employment/Educational Situation, Treatment History,
6. See attachment for the "Written Off" documentary screening. The screening will take place on April 12<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. District Attorney Susan Happ, Watertown Police Chief Tim Roets and Watertown Health Officer/Director Carol Quest have all agreed to participate in a panel discussion following the film. This screening is being organized by the Jefferson County Drug Free Coalition and hosted free of cost by the Towne Cinema in Watertown.
7. The Jefferson County Drug Free Coalition was able to assist in purchase of a medication drop box for the Johnson Creek Police Department with a contribution of \$700. The Jefferson County Solid Waste Committee covered the remaining \$300 and the drop box was delivered to Johnson Creek on March 12th. And is available for use.
8. From January through March, the Jefferson County Drug Free Coalition coordinated the training of over 200 individuals on the use of Narcan or Naloxone. Over 400 doses were distributed to those who attended.
9. All members of the Treatment Court Team will be attending the WATCP Conference from April 18<sup>th</sup> through the 20<sup>th</sup>.
