1. The Treatment Court Team met on 03/11/2021 and recommend changes to the Alcohol Treatment Court Manual to allow for OWI 4-6 offenders serving a period of Extended Supervision to apply for ATC as an Alternative to Revocation. This would allow offenders who violate their supervision following their release from prison access to the program. The Recommended Language is as follows:

Proposed ATC ATR Language:

Alternative to Revocation (No New Pending Charges): Alcohol Treatment Court (ATC) has the capacity to serve as an Alternative to Revocation of supervision for up to 5 participants at any given time. Offenders convicted of OWI 4th, 5th or 6th, who are serving a period of Extended Supervision and who are facing revocation of their supervision may apply, regardless of whether the offender is facing new criminal charges. Offenders who apply must meet eligibility requirements. ATC applications must be accompanied by a DOC a violation report. The Treatment Court Team must approve before any offender is admitted into Alcohol Treatment Court as an ATR. If the offender is accepted into the Alcohol Treatment Court program, his/her participation should be required as a formal ATR agreement. The expectation of the Alcohol Treatment Court Program is that offenders who do not successfully complete the Alcohol Treatment Court as an ATR may face revocation of his/her supervision.

2. The Alcohol Treatment Court Restructuring Subcommittee met and endorse the previously proposed changes to the sentence structure offered to OWI 3rd and 4th defendants as a means to increase the incentives for Alcohol Treatment Court participation. The recommended changes are as follows:


3. The Alcohol and Drug Treatment Courts have resumed in-person hearings for sanctions as of 03/17/2021. The Treatment Courts will resume full in-person treatment court sessions beginning 04/07/2021. Virtual options will be afforded to Treatment Court Team members and participants who cannot attend in-person for COVID/medical reasons.


- 4. System Mapping has concluded and the Policy Team is reviewing for revisions. A DRAFT of final product accompanies this report for CJCC review.
- 5. Two DTC Participants have been screened for CCS since last month with one qualifying. A referral to CCS will be made once the individual leaves a sober living placement outside of Jefferson County and returns to Jefferson County in his own residence.
 - All participants have been reviewed again for insurance and all participants receiving Badger Care will be considered for a CCS screening.
- The CORE reporting system is now generating program summary reports as well as individual
 case reports. Examples of these reports have been included and will be incorporated for CJCC
 review.




Local Justice System Map Fall-2020 through Spring-2021



Percent of Participants by Employment Status






Percent of Participants by Highest Education Level






