<u>CTH "F" Project (CTH "CI" – Village of Sullivan</u>): Paving is nearing completion, shoulder work and striping will be completed in September.

<u>CTH "P" Project (CTH "F" – US 18)</u>: Construction, pulverize, and pave project. Project delayed because of utility relocates. Construction project work will begin September 7, storm sewer and curbing should be completed by the end of September.

<u>Village of Sullivan:</u> Street work including storm sewer, curb and gutter, and paving. Project work is nearly complete, all paving work is done.

<u>CTH "SC" Project (STH 16 – CTH "CW")</u>: Design is about 50% complete.

9a. Discontinue 450' section of "old" CTH "G" near US 12

Commissioner Kern discussed the southerly 450 feet of CTH "G" right of way north of US 12, which is generating a title problem for the owners. The discussion focused on whether the County Board needed to take any action to discontinue the "old" section of highway.

It was moved by Mr. Jaeckel and seconded by Mr. Borland to table this agenda item until further information can be obtained.

9b. Discuss policy on highway right-of-way (ROW) encroachment

Commissioner Kern reviewed the current right-of-way policy with the Committee, noting that the department minimizes encroachments currently by routine maintenance. The Department addresses safety issues and hazards as the top priority. In the future, decisions may need to be made regarding the survey and sell back of land to adjacent landowners not needed for highway purposes, the survey and land rental to adjacent farmers for crops, the use of the land for other miscellaneous highway uses, or the placement of ROW markers at locations and delivery of written notice to landowners to not encroach into the county property (property needed for sight distance and drainage). With regards to last month's correspondence from Paul and Donna Crossman on CTH "A", the farming of county property, the following was discussed: There are no ROW markers in the field to mark new property lines; there is no immediate hazard regarding crops, but the farmer has been contacted regarding encroachment into the Highway ROW property.

It was moved by Mr. Buchanan and seconded by Mr. Borland to pursue the current right-of-way policy and notify the adjacent neighbors as to what is being done.

9c. Consider changes in speed zones on CTH "W" and CTH "J" near the City of Jefferson

Commissioner Kern recommended setting a speed of 45 mph on CTH "J" from the centerline of STH 89 for a distance of .4 miles east, and a speed of 35 mph on CTH "J" from a distance of .4 miles east of STH 89, for .5 miles east to Collins Road. He also recommended setting a speed of 45 mph on CTH "W" from the centerline of the "new highway" for a distance of .5 miles north, and a speed of 35 mph on CTH "W" from a distance of .5 miles north of "new highway", for a distance of .7 miles north to Collins Road. Committee member, George Jaeckel, addressed concerns in comparison to CTH "N" and STH 106. There was discussion regarding sections of both highways that were within City of Jefferson corporate limits. No Motion.

<u>9d. Discuss highway facility studies, facility conditions, and future timeline for facility planning and improvements</u>

Commissioner Kern discussed the 2011 budgeted \$250,000.00 for facility design work. There was further discussion on the improvement of current facility vs. the purchase of new land elsewhere. The discussion of environmental obligations was reviewed.

It was moved by Mr. Borland and seconded by Mr. Jaeckel to start the process of environmental studies I and II to see how ground contaminates sit before the next step of the timeline is pursued.
