- b) **Farm Bureau** The income from this building has lagged behind our other permanent buildings during Fair. A new sponsor contract has been signed for three years to include \$6,000 of product for us to sell. It was suggested that they be moved to a new space, a tent for the first year. They would pay the foot fee and electric usage. This would give them time to look for a trailer and coolers for 2012 Fair. Ron Buchanan made a motion to enter in a new agreement with Farm Bureau without the building. Greg Torres seconded. Motion carried unanimous.

Wind Turbine – The next step would be to meet with the City of Jefferson after Snocross.

Snocross Updates - We have lots of snow. The city has been bringing snow. The trail classes could be the largest ever.
