Marty Krueger passed around a spike taken from the removed track in the cities of Sauk City/Prairie du Sac that was manufactured into a bottle opener. He stated they were for sale at different locations and on the bike trail website. He didn't know the price. However 100% of sale price would go to the trail expenses of the Great Sauk Trail.

REPORTS & COMMISSION BUSINESS

7. Review and Award of Bid for the stabilization of Bridge 428 – B – Alan Sweeney, Chair.

Items 7 and 8 were combined together for discussion by Chair Sweeney.

Ken Lucht reported the bids were opened on Dec.14th by his team at WSOR. There were 5 bids received from Janke - \$2.999M, Kraemer North America - \$2.964M, JF Brennan - \$1.4M, Michaels Corp - \$1.035M, and Veit & Company Inc. - \$884,100. of Rogers,

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MN, which was below the proposed budget amount. WSOR and their project Manager, Dave Bierman, researched and reference checked the low bidder and were satisfied with the low bidder receiving the contract. A performance bond and certificate of insurance is required. Start date set for January 1^{st,} 2018 and completion date of March 31^{st,} 2018. With final payment due by June 1^{st,} 2018. The DNR will be occasionally on site and have already given their approval to the removal process. WRRTC's insurance agent suggested to our atty. Eileen Brownlee that we ask to have the Cert. of Ins. also include the class for Longshoreman and Harbor Workers to be added.

• Motion to award the contract to Veit and Co as amended with the additional inclusion of the clause, as recommended by the attorney – Krueger/Mace.

Demby asked if any federal dollars were involved. The answer was no. That only the DOT, WSOR, and WRRTC dollars were involved. Another question was asked by Chris James RE: cost over runs and/or change orders. Following a discussion, Lucht re-read a portion of paragraph 6 of the bid document which stated any and all changes were to go through their project manager Dave Bierman.

- Motion to amend the original motion to limit change order of no more than \$20,000 additional funds, allowing the project manager to authorize a single change order up to that limit Krueger/Gray. Passed Unanimously.
- Motion to have Sweeney and Anderson sign the rewritten contract with above changes Ladewig/Cornford. Passed Unanimously.
- *Original motion to award the contract with amendment Passed Unanimously.*
