1. Call to order – Ed Morse Called the Meeting to order at 8:32a.m.

- 2. Roll call (establish a quorum) Council members present: Ed Morse, Dick Schultz, Steve Mode, and Laura Payne (@ 8:34am). Council members absent: Bob Birmingham. Staff present: Mary Nimm (Program Assistant, Parks), Kevin Wiesmann (Field Supervisor, Parks), Mark Watkins (Director, Land & Water), Nichol Tesh (Jefferson County Medical Examiner). - 3. **Certification of compliance with open meetings law** Mary Nimm certified compliance with the Open Meetings Law.

Discussion and possible action on proposal for addition to Potters Field Nichol Tesh, Medical Examiner stated that the indigent (unclaimed persons) are the responsibility of the medical examiner and there is a need for a burial/storage site. She stated that research is being done to find out how many can be kept on a particular site at one time. Kevin Wiesmann stated that there are obvious depressions on the Potter's Field Site, but archeology work will need to be done. A Schultz/Mode recommendation was made to support the effort to place a crypt on the Potter's Field site for indigent remains and to forward the recommendation onto the Parks Committee at their September

meeting. The recommendation passed 4-0.
