CALL TO ORDER was made by Chairman Hughes at 9:32 a.m.

ROLL CALL: Board Members Present – Hughes, Greibenow, and Magnoni

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The Drain approved the agenda for the October 14, 2019 meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: The Drain board approved the minutes of the September 9, 2019, meeting.

REPORTS OF DRAINS:

a. **DRAIN #32**

Ronald and Nancy Smith from Watertown appeared before the Drain Board and requested a hearing to approve a clean out from West Road to approximately 1 mile north/northwest. They are making this request due to recent tiling of lands west of their farm land which has caused their land to flood. The Drain Board has been aware of this drain issue and approved calling a hearing of all benefited landowners to discuss this issue. The Drain Board directed the Secretary to contact Attorney Griggs to send out a notice for a meeting after January 1, 2020. The last clean out assessment on this drain was in 2007.

b. **DRAIN #36**

Attorney Griggs notified the Drain Board of possible dates for a meeting with the D.O.T. The Drain Board selected Thursday, October 31 and Tuesday, December 10. Ron Griebenow reported that Dean Jagger contacted him because the pump was not working. Mr. Jagger stated he could fix the problem, however, he would need to be paid. Ron asked Mr. Jagger to submit a proposal for Board approval before proceeding. Secretary Magnoni discussed the bill sent to We Energies regarding the damage done to this drain.

c. **DRAIN #1**

The Circuit Court hearing on this drain has been scheduled for October 30 at 10 a.m. at the County Courthouse.
