## Minutes of the HOME Board Meeting July 18, 2019

I. The meeting was called to order by Kathleen Schilling, Board Chair, with a quorum of the Board present at 9:14 a.m.

- II. The Board Chair led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. On a motion by Joe Birbaum and seconded by Jay Shambeau, the minutes from the May 20, 2019 HOME Board meeting were unanimously approved.
- IV. There were no public comments. Kristin Silva said the 2019 Annual Plan hasn't been approved by HUD yet, but she expects the approval soon. HUD will be coming to Waukesha County for a routine monitoring in August.
- V. The Fund Balance Report was reviewed, a new format shows all of ongoing projects and balances remaining.
- VI. The 2020-2022 Urban County requalification process is complete. Letters were sent to the municipalities in the four-county consortium with the option to opt-in or out of the Urban County and HOME Consortium. Palmyra and the Village of Pewaukee opted in, residents in those communities will be eligible to participate in the programs beginning 1/1/20. Kristin will submit the information to HUD.
- VII. Habitat for Humanity's new Executive Director, Mike Crowley, is a Waukesha County Supervisor. Kristin met with him and he was very receptive to HOME funding and the HUD rules. He is interested in applying for rehab money in the future.
- VIII. There was a 30-day public comment period as well as a public hearing for the 2020 HOME allocation, Kristin received no comments regarding the HOME funding. The 2020 HOME allocation will remain as follows:
