Resolutions and Ordinances:

Jaeckel, Highway Committee Chair, introduced Resolution No. 2020-17.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jefferson County Highway Department is authorized to enter into a contract with Bjoin Limestone for limestone crushing in 2020

Fiscal Note: Adequate funds are available in the Highway Department budget for this contract.

Jaeckel moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2020-17. Seconded and passed.

Morris, Law Enforcement & Emergency Management Committee Chair, introduced Resolution No. 2020-18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors that the County Administrator or the Sheriff is authorized to negotiate and enter into a contract with Southern Health Partners to provide inmate medical services.

Fiscal Note: The fiscal impact of this resolution will not exceed \$132,325 for the remainder of the 2020 fiscal year. Adequate funds are budgeted for 2020 in the Sheriff's Department for inmate medical services. An amount of \$639,130, which includes a 3% cost increase beginning on the second contract year, will be included in the 2021 budget.

Morris moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2020-18. Seconded and passed.

Morris, Law Enforcement & Emergency Management Committee Chair, introduced Resolution No. 2020-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors that for the purpose of developing and completing the installation of a new P25 Digital Radio communications System by General Communications, the County Administrator is hereby authorized to:

- Negotiate terms for the purchase or use of land to construct a communications tower at a location in Palmyra which may include negotiating a public/ private partnership agreement with Bertram Communications, LLC to share in the costs of constructing a communications tower; and
- 2) Negotiate terms for the purchase or use of land to construct a communications tower at a location in the Village of Cambridge which may include a public/private partnership agreement with Bertram Communications, LLC to share in the costs of constructing a communications tower; and
- Negotiate terms for Jefferson County to install communications equipment on a tower owned by Bertram Communications, LLC in Johnson Creek; and
- 4) Negotiate terms for a public/private partnership agreement with Bertram Communications, LLC to share in the costs of constructing a tower at the Sheriff's Office Annex site; and
- Negotiate terms with the State of Wisconsin and UW-Whitewater for use of UW-Whitewater Residence Hall to install communications equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that before any agree-

ment is entered into as described herein, such agreement must be approved by the Jefferson County Law Enforcement and Emergency Management Committee.

Fiscal Note: Funds for the acquisition of tower sites and construction of the towers have been included in the project budget that was outlined in the Series 2020A bond issue. Adequate bond funds exist in the Capital Projects fund to finance the acquisition of tower sites and construction of towers specified in the original project plans. Jefferson County anticipates that additional costs initially borne by the County for modifications in scope to the project plan to accomplish mutual public-private partnership goals, should any arise, will be recuperated through negotiations with the private entities involved.

Morris moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2020-19. Seconded and passed.

Johns, Parks Committee Chair, introduced Resolution No. 2020-20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the proposed updates to the 2020 Jefferson County Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan are hereby adopted. Fiscal Note: Adoption of this Plan does not commit Jefferson

County to any future expenditures. All future projects and acquisitions will need County Board approval at the time they are proposed. An updated Plan is necessary to continue to qualify for state and federal grants.
