1. CALL TO ORDER was made by David Hughes at 9:30 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL: Board Members Present – Chairman Hughes, Secretary Magnoni and Ron Griebenow.

A. DRAIN 36

The Drain Board discussed the issue of the assessment to be "Not later than December 31, 2024," contained in the County/Drain Board Memorandum of Understanding. Brian Udovich will ask Corporate Counsel if this agreement stipulation requires a contract amendment because the D.O.T. will not have bid results until after January 2025. No other information was given concerning this project.

B. DRAIN 15 MAIN THROUGH 15D

Secretary Magnoni reported that the special assessment formula was not received from Dane County via DATCP. Chairman Hughes reported that he was working with Dan Prunuske, engineer, who agreed that the Drainage District map for Drain 15 Main was not correct. Dan stated he would attempt to get the map corrected. Dan also agreed that a flat rate assessment was the way to go, with a possible benefitted acres amount of \$50,000 with a 10% assessment. Chairman Hughes is to get a time line so the Board and attorney can plan for the landowners' meeting. It was agreed that the current date of December 10 was not possible. It was agreed to set a new date in February 2025, subject to the availability of Attorney Griggs and having corrected maps.

C. DRAIN 41

Ron Griebenow reported that he had met with Andy's Excavating regarding the culvert replacement. Ron received a bid from Andy's in the amount of \$8,475.00 to replace the culvert. The Drain Board tabled this bid as current funds do not support payment of this bid amount and there is a question of this culvert being in the District or not.. Ron is to follow-up with Jaeckel Brothers to remove cattails from this drain.

Patricia Cicero passed out September flexible period report indicating that \$5,452.64 of the \$10,000.00 county allocation has been spent year to date.

SPECIAL NOTE: Following the Drain Board meeting, Secretary Magnoni received a call from Emily Straka of Ranger Power, representing Badger Solar. She indicated that Badger was requesting a 3rd request for an extension until July 1, 2025. However, Badger must be under construction by May 31, 2025, or landowners' rental leases will expire. The third request for extension to the PSC will be reviewed this month.

b. Erosion control and storm water ordinances – No new information was given concerning these two isues.
