## 1. Call to Order

## 6. Review of the 2024 Jefferson County Fair

- Roberts shared that over 10 debrief meetings have been held since the end of the Jefferson County Fair. These meetings have focused on evaluating the event's successes and areas for improvement.
- Feedback was provided by various attendees regarding the current layout and use of the "Heart of the Park" Space.
- Several ideas were discussed regarding how to best recruit gate workers for 2025.
- Handicap parking inside the park was discussed.
- Safety concerns regarding the demolition derby as well as the rodeo were shared.

## 7. Preparation for 2025 County Fair

- There was extensive discussion on managing entertainment events, with a focus on crowd safety.
- The group considered the possibility of finding new promoters for both the Demolition Derby and the Rodeo, to improve event organization and safety protocols.
- A suggestion was made to explore relocating the rodeo to the draft horse arena which could better accommodate the crowd and ensure safer viewing and participation as well as for the animals involved. Further evaluation of this idea will be necessary as to the cost of renting bleachers and expanding the existing arena.
- The group discussed the idea of opening the poster contest to local schools, aiming to engage the community and encourage student participation.
- There was consideration of the timeline for this initiative, with suggestions on how to align it with school schedules to maximize involvement. Further planning is needed to finalize the timeline.

- Roberts presented a plan to move the “Kidz Zone” and incorporate the Pig & Duck races into that area. Other changes proposed were adding a community stage, moving Rabbits and adding a food option within the Activity Center.
- Other timeline changes were discussed, including updates to the Premium book, Sponsorship as well as Fair Week activities.
- Additional changes in development include creation of an Entertainment Committee & Auction Committee.
- Carie Pellman provided a financial update on the Auction, reporting a final amount of \$519,713.70.
