PUBLIC COMMENT:

- a. Expressed speed concern on USH 18: WISDOT to study
- b. Expressed speed and additional truck traffic concerns on STH 89
- c. Concerns were expressed about the intersection of Boos Ln., STH 106, & CTH CI.
- d. Concerns regarding speed on CTH K (Fort Jefferson) were expressed.

OLD BUSINESS

- a. Discussed speed concerns on CTH B (CTH F Waukesha County)
 - i. Counts were completed, speeds (85%) consistent with speed limit and minimum crashes. No Motion
- b. Discussed speed concerns on STH 18 near Cambridge
 - i. WIS DOT studying a future paving project with wider shoulders and a high friction surface treatment. No Motion

NEW BUSINESS

- a. Discuss Traffic Safety Website and subcommittee outreach efforts
 - i. The Committee discussed the Traffic Safety Subcommittee outreach efforts. Nothing is currently scheduled, but they hope to have some around prom time. They also

discussed possible involvement at the State Fair (August 1-11) and/or the National Night Out (August 6) No Motion.

10. Traffic Accident Spot Map – Jefferson County Sheriff's Department

The Spot Map was reviewed by the Committee. 2 fatal crashes thus far in 2024 vs. 6 fatal crashes at this point in 2023. No Motion.

11. WisDOT Southwest Region, Madison - Traffic Section

Sheriff Milbrath stated that oversized stop signs installed at STH 18 and CTH Y appear to be effective.

STH 106 and Loga Road substandard curve- submitted for safety funding. Shoulders will be widened on STH 59 paving project (Palmyra).

12. WisDOT Bureau of Transportation Safety – Transportation Safety Report & Highway Safety Input

Todd Horn presented the 1st quarter crash data as well as numerous important dates, programs, and legislation related to DOT.
