

LAW ENFORCEMENT/EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MINUTES

DATE: 05/22/26

Call to Order: Meeting called to order by Corporation Counsel Danielle Thompson at 11:03 a.m.

Roll Call: Members of the committee present were: David Drayna, Kirk Lund, Jenifer Quimby Brandon White

Others present were: Sheriff Travis Maze, Corporation Counsel Danielle Thompson, County Administrator Michael Luckey

Absent: Dwayne Morris, Undersheriff Jerry Haferman

Certification of Compliance with open meetings law: Corporation Counsel Danielle Thompson certified compliance with the open meetings law.

Election of Officers: Supervisor Drayna motioned to have Supervisor Morris as chair, seconded by Supervisor Lund, all in favor. Motion carried. Supervisor White motioned to have Supervisor Drayna to be vice chair, seconded by Supervisor Lund, all in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion and possible action on future meeting schedule: All supervisors agreed to the 4th Friday of the month at 8:30 a.m.

Approval of the agenda: Agenda approved.

Public Comment: none.

Approval of the February 27, 2026, meeting minutes: A motion was made by Supervisor White , and seconded by Supervisor Lund that the February 27, 2026 , minutes be approved as printed. Motion carried.

Communications:

- Sheriff informed the committee that the department got two communications, one about Deputy Farley on his work on a child abuse case. He was professional and caring during his interactions. The second was a dispatcher who was off duty who called in a bad driving complaint that ended in an OWI arrest.
- Sheriff also spoke on Deputy Danner on a recent stop her had that resulted in finding a wanted person who was hiding from being picked up from a warrant.

Grants – Update of ongoing or new grants:

- Sheriff spoke on there are no new grants currently, however the seat belt grant is at 65% and the speed grant is at 52 %. These both have resulted in 1500 traffic stops, 800 citations, and 46 arrests.

Report from the Sheriff:

- As of 05/05 the Sheriff's office was fully staffed. 35 fully trained in the jail, 2 in training, and 1 on light duty. 31 fully trained in Patrol, 2 in training, and 2 on military leave.
- Promoted Robert Krueger as Dispatch Supervisor which leaves 2 open dispatch spots to fill but hoping to maybe fill those with transfers.
- Sergeant Horvatin is retiring July 17th and already has a conditional job offer to an individual to start in the jail when that happens. Sergeant Johnson is going to DTF which opens his spot at the department which the process has already started. Hoping to have the new person named in 2-3 weeks.
- Sheriff informed the committee that they are looking to add EM to the Sheriff department app

Review monthly bills and financial items (March, April): – The committee approved the monthly recap reports for March bills in the amount of \$ 269, 550.19 and April in the amount of \$ 305,989.77 . A spreadsheet summarizing current bills was reviewed by the committee members.

Report on the budget:

- Sheriff informed the committee that budget is right on track where they want it to be at this time.

Review monthly jail and patrol activity reports: Jail and patrol activity reports were available and reviewed.

Discussion and Possible action on approving jail assessment fund purchases:

- Bills were presented for dish washer lease washer lease dish washer lease washer lease (03/19/26-04/18/26) for \$232.41, dish washer lease washer lease dish washer lease washer lease (04/19/26-05/18/26) for \$232.41, and inmate instruction for March and April for \$3,600.00 for a total of 4,064.82 .
- Bill for \$997.00 to cover the overage for installing the new steamer in the kitchen.

The jail assessment balance at the end of April is \$ 228,217.37 .
