- Open Class Entries are complete – some up, some down
- Fair Week Staff has been completed – most are returning with a couple new added to transition into next year
- Same two people for Beverage
- One returning in Ag Adventure Tent and one new since Monica has moved into the office
- Reigning Fairest, Willow and the Fairest contestants handed out Tri-Folds at the Pork Chop Dinner last Friday and did the Marshall Fire Department Festival parade last Sunday, and will do Lake Mills Town & Country days this coming Saturday. Will also be doing Watertown 4<sup>th</sup> of July parade.
- We have expanded the Food Row area with two additional vendors
- Working on parking passes for employees, vendors and camping tags
- VIP parking will be across from Gate #1 with vendors – will be first come, first serve.
- The garden is struggling – too dry last year and too wet this year. The weeds are grown just fine.
