Legislative Report

Ballweg: Reorganization of 911-eliminate county contracts and have a single state contract. Campaign reform and voter registration ID.

Olsen: Halfway through the budget process, expected to be done by July 1. K-12 will get more money and University will get less. Transportation bill passed with bipartisan support.

WCA Update of County Issues

Child support enforcement funding is increased. State Highways saw a \$52.5 million increase with a 4% increase for local road. Open book mandate has no funding attached.

Program – Trust, Motivation, and Engagement of County Employees

Professor Jack Christ of Ripon College shared research and best practices on how leaders can build trust and motivation in an organization. Professor Christ provided several resources for further study in a handout.

The candle problem and the utility of carrots, sticks, and money

What psychologists know that organizations have failed to learn

- Motivation 1.0 survival – up to rise of civilizations
- Motivation 2.0 rewards and punishments to mid-20th century
- Motivation 3.0 1950s Maslow, McGregor et al – autonomy, mastery, purpose

Why people join organizations

- Because they have no choice (e.g. racial-ethnic groups)
- Goals, values (e.g. religious, political groups)
- Activities, tasks (whatever the group does that is enjoyable in itself)
- People (e.g. going to a college or a church because you like the people)
- Tangible instrumental rewards (e.g. \$)

Enforcing compliance in organizations

- Recruitment (get the right people in the right seats on the bus)
- Orientation (initial introduction upon entry, boot camp)
- Continuing education, development (keep them learning)
- Organizational norms (dress codes, jargon)
- Tangible instrumental rewards (e.g. \$)
