Everything is falling into place to start the drug court. They are waiting for the court reporting system from the DOJ and WCS is in the process of hiring a case manager. No action taken.

Forseth explained that they have subdivided into teams. They are discussing new technology to the jail. This could be used as a reward in exchange for education. They are looking into some fund raising options to support this program. No action taken.

Lutz said that they had a Task Force meeting last week. They have seen a decline in opiates but a rise in cocaine, marijuana and meth. There are two more educational sessions similar to Highway to Heroin coming up in the near future. No action taken.


BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS




REASON FOR INCARCERATION




DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED




TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED




UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING




AGE PROFILE








WEAPONS USED




EMPLOYMENT STATUS

RE- INCARCERATION May 2017




EDUCATION LEVEL




INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS






DRUGS USED




DRUG TYPE

MAY




UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING




AGE PROFILE




GENDER PROFILE




ETHNIC PROFILE




WEAPONS USED




TYPE OF WEAPON USED


