15. Future Meeting dates: February 28, 2018 and March 28, 2018 at noon.

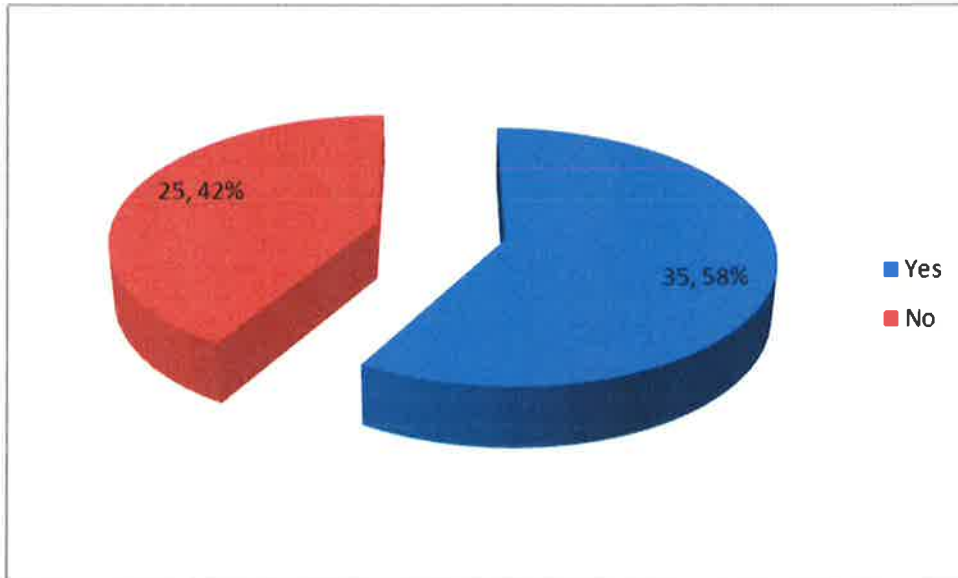

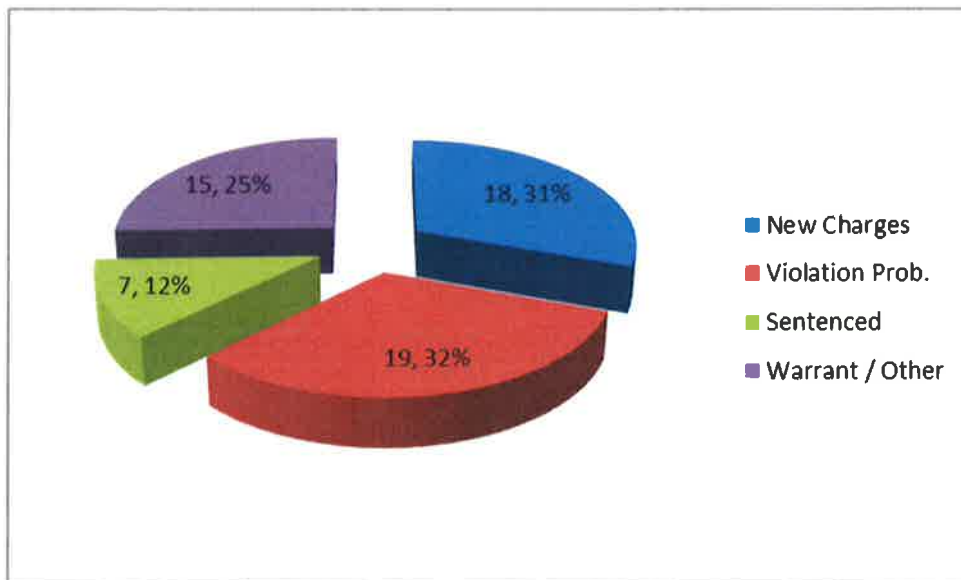

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2018

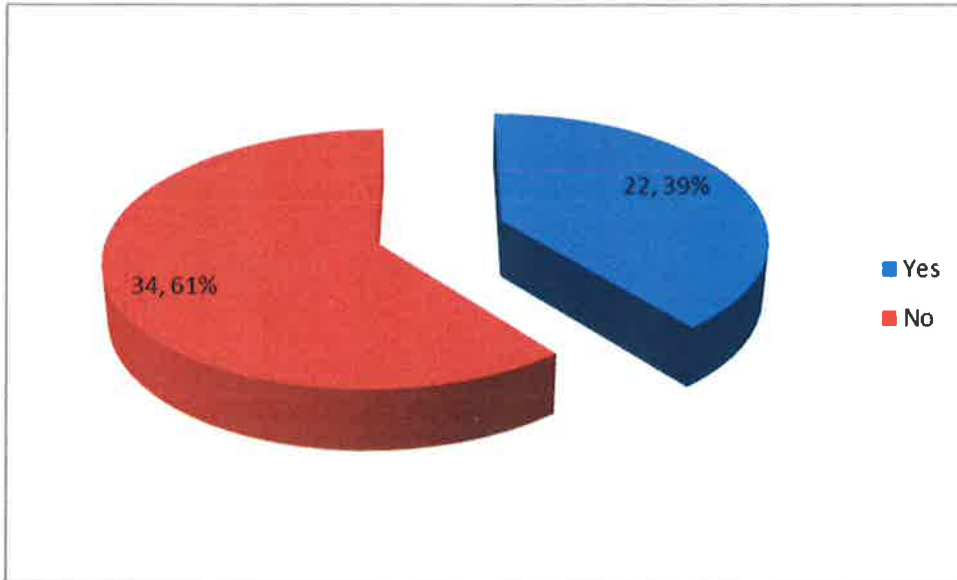


BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS

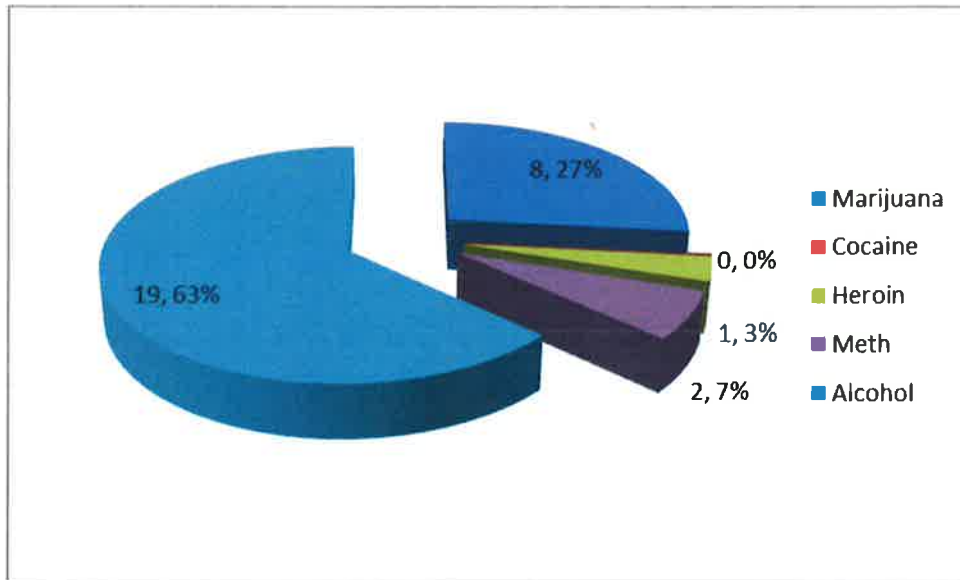


REASON FOR INCARCERATION

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2018

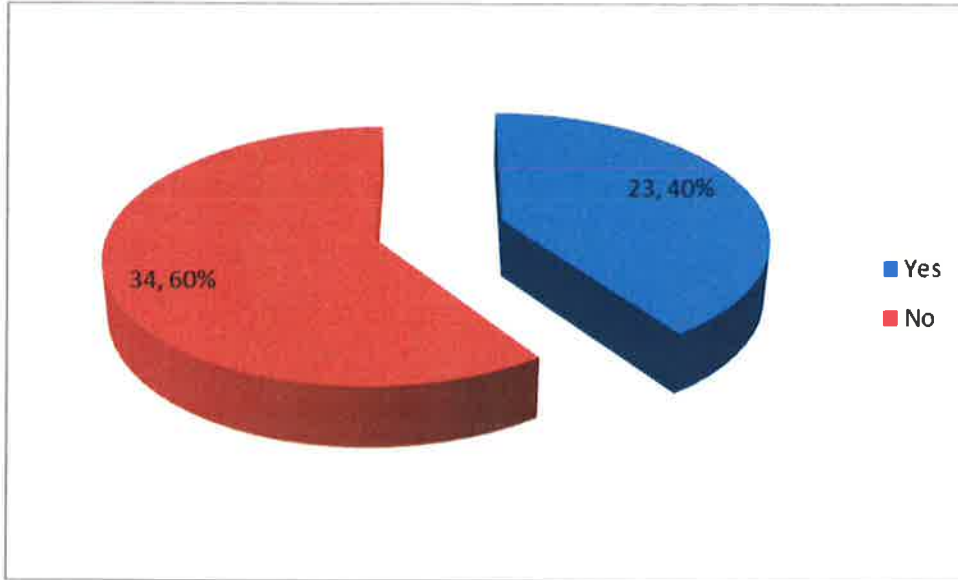


DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED

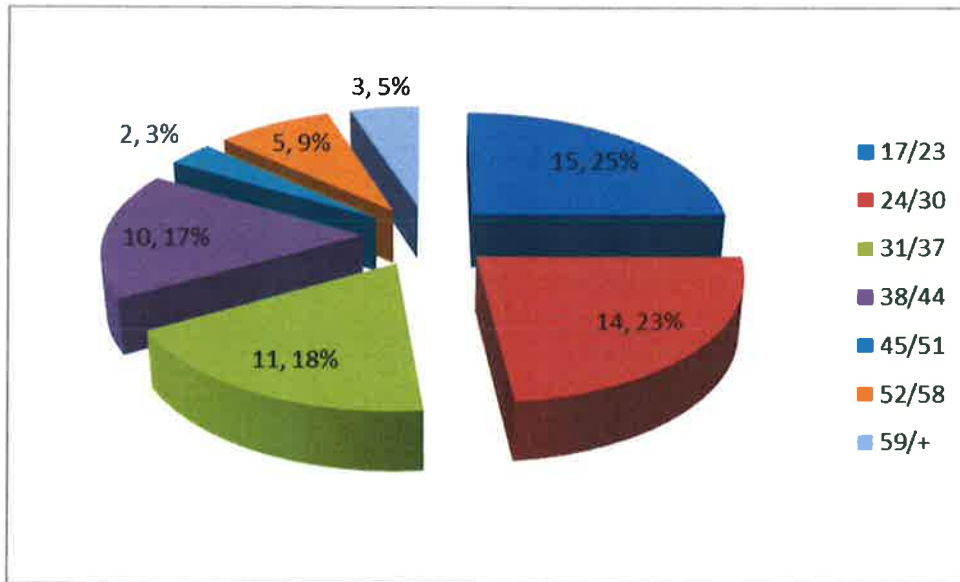


TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2018

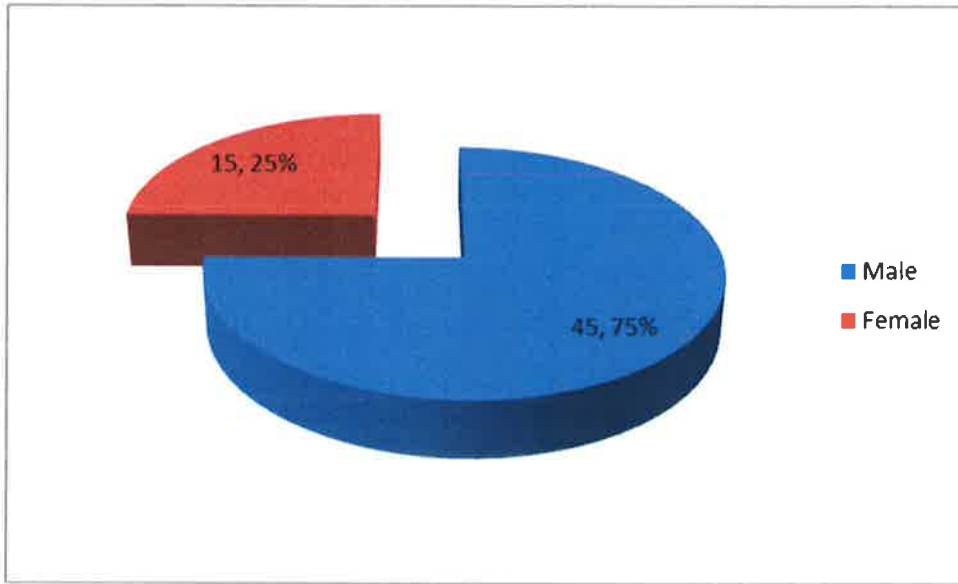


UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING

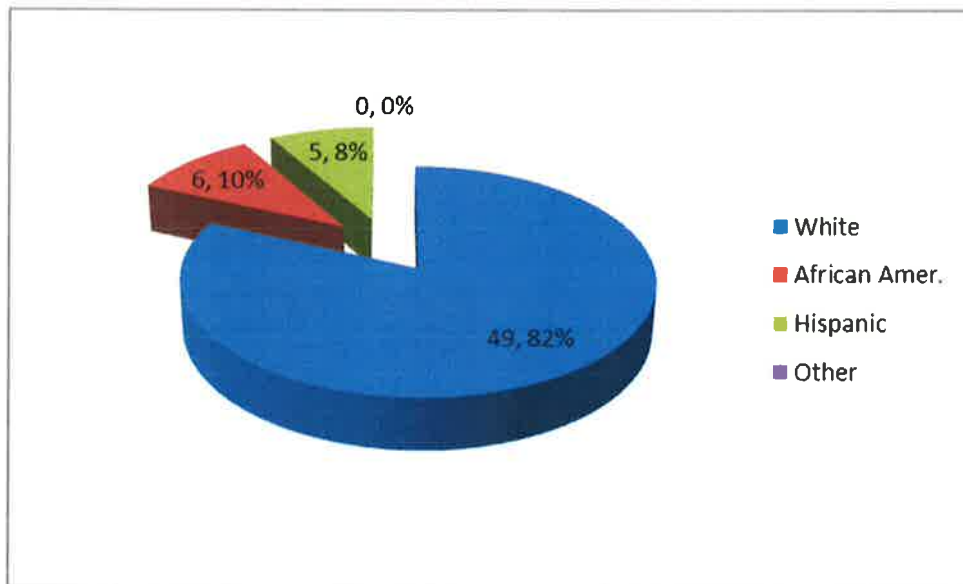


AGE PROFILE

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2018

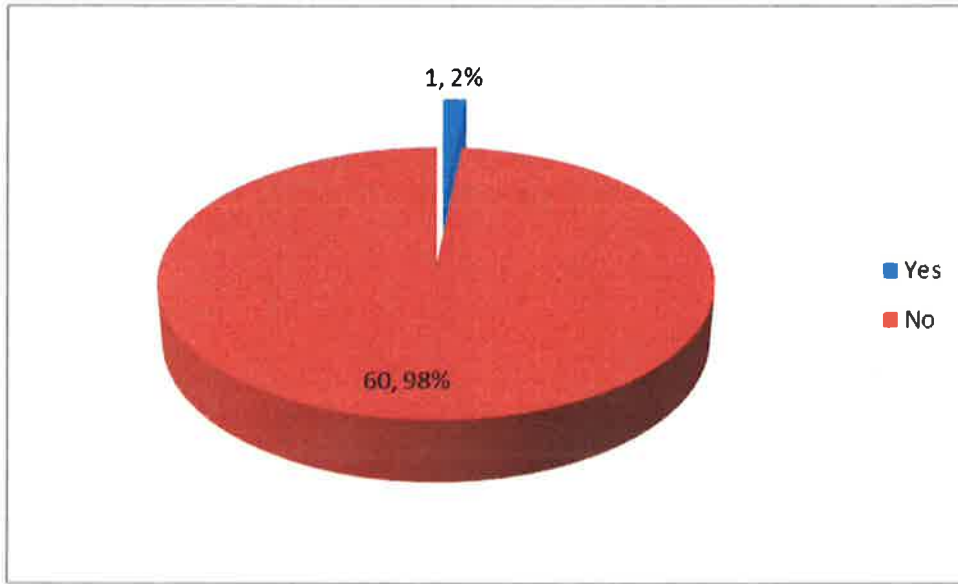


GENDER PROFILE

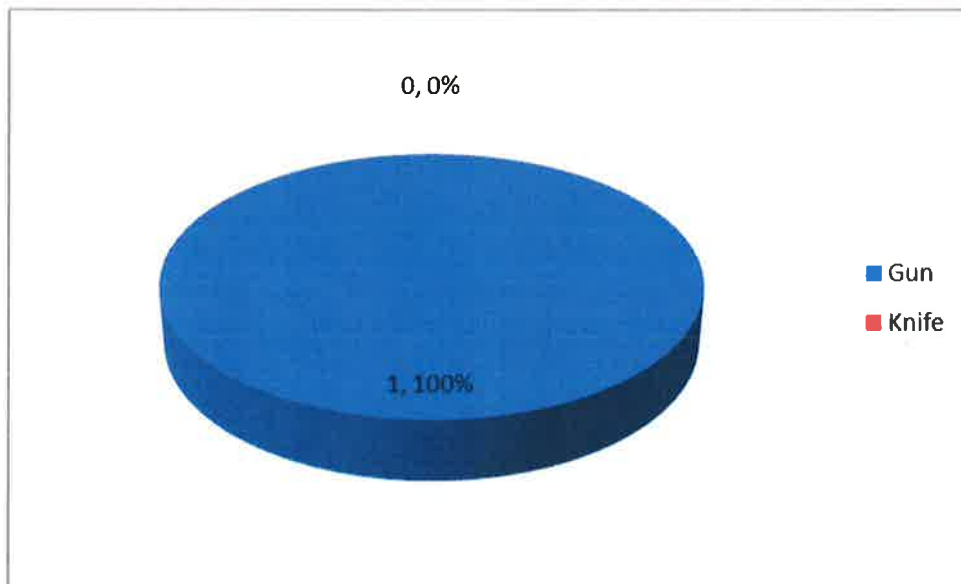


ETHNIC PROFILE

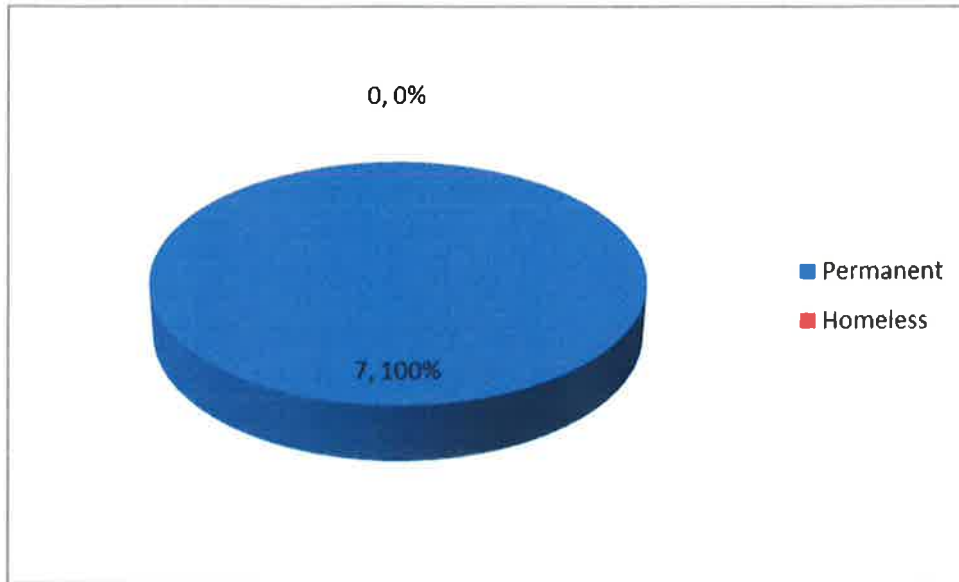


WEAPONS USED

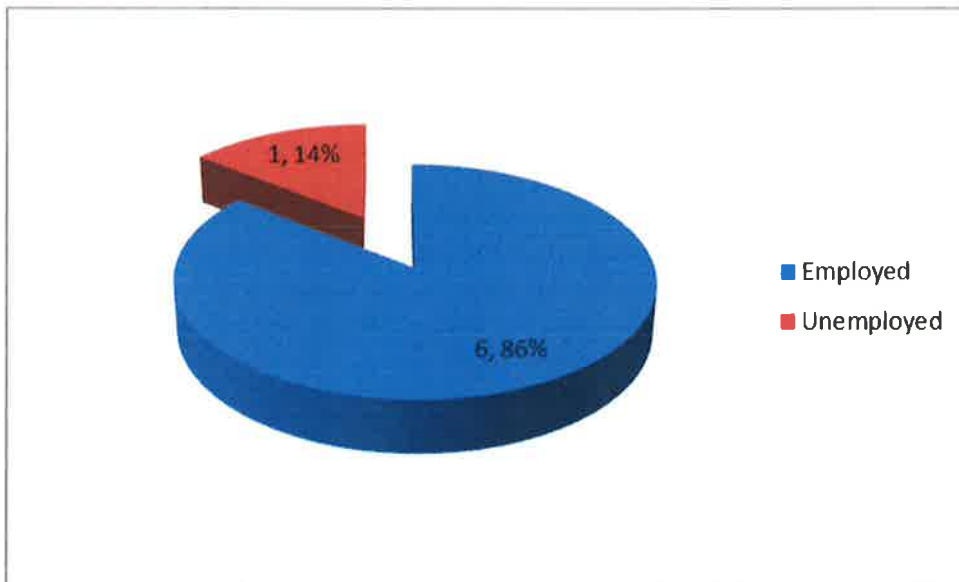


TYPE OF WEAPON

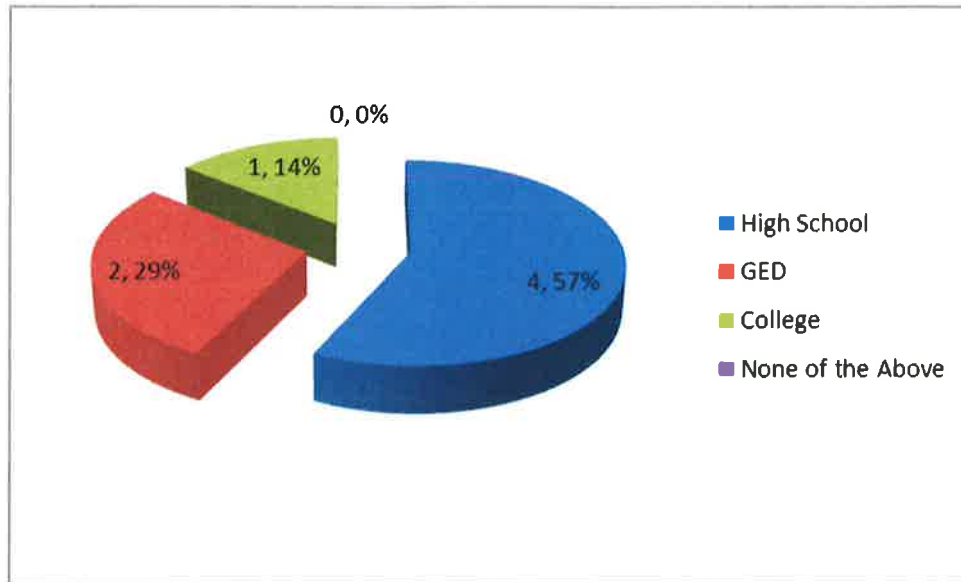


HOUSING
