
REASON FOR INCARCERATION




DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED




TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED








INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS






DRUGS USED




DRUG TYPE




UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING




AGE PROFILE




GENDER PROFILE






WEAPONS USED




