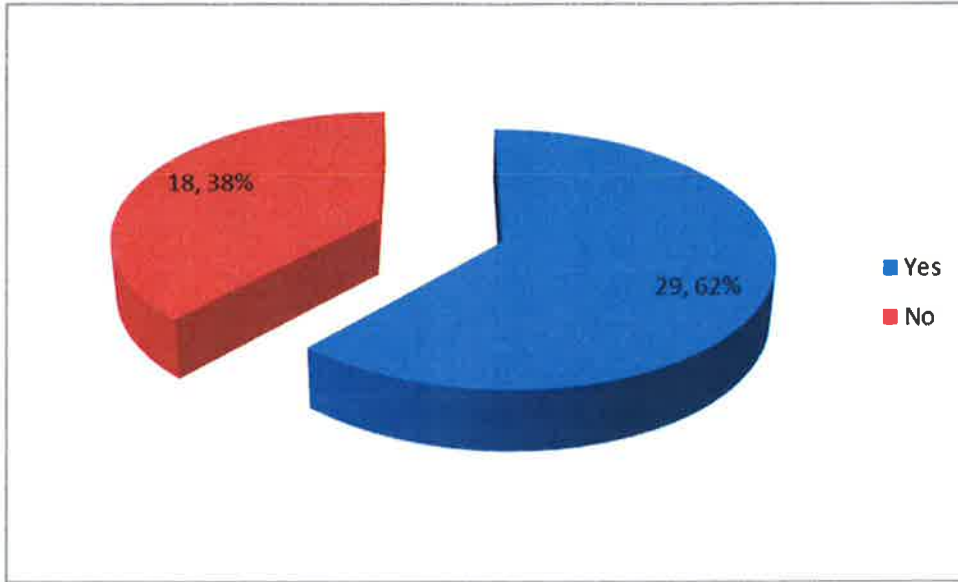

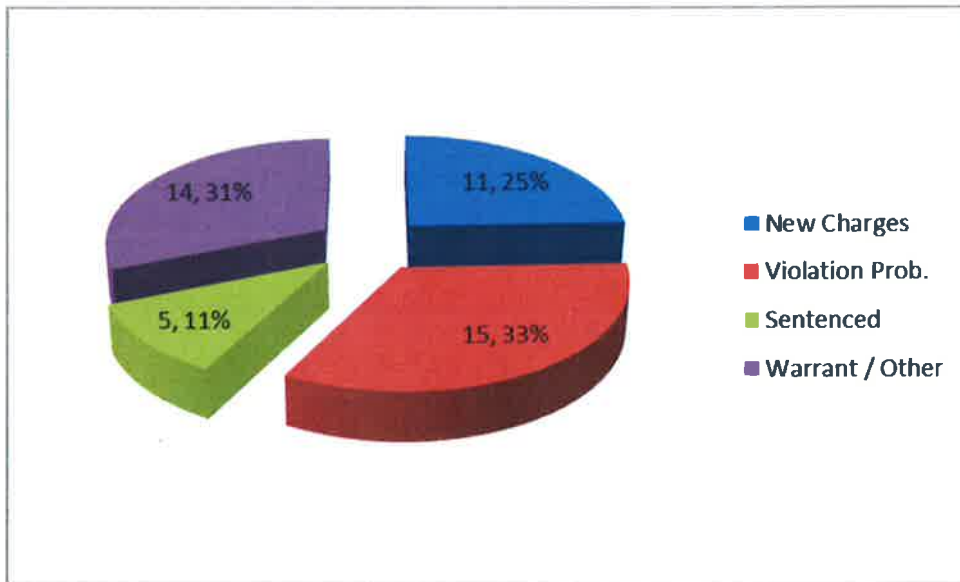

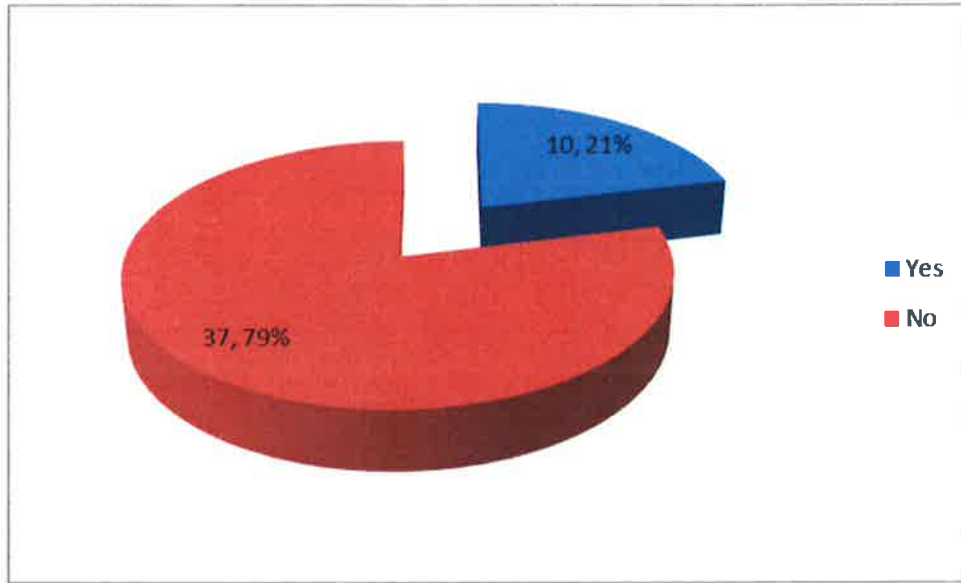
RE- INCARCERATION OCTOBER 2018



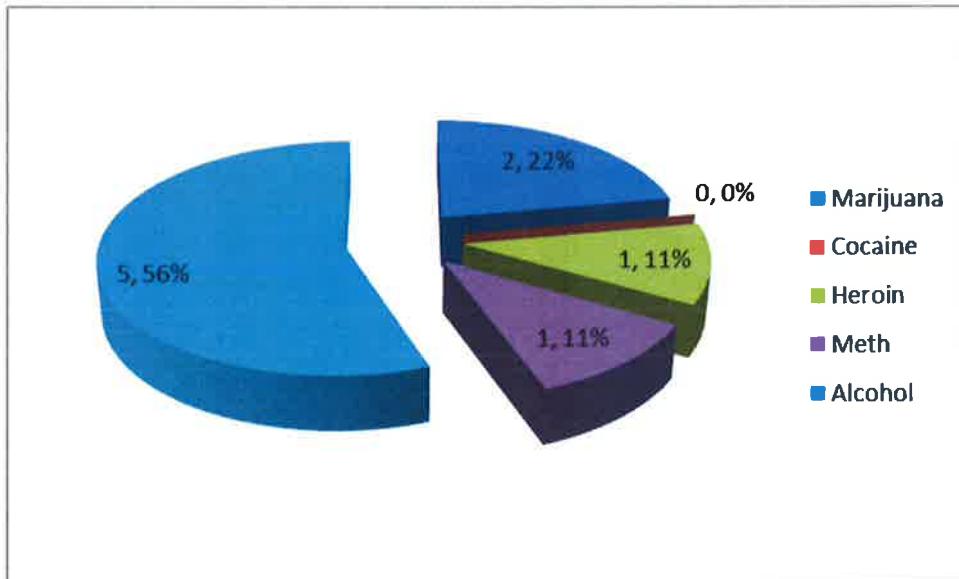
BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS



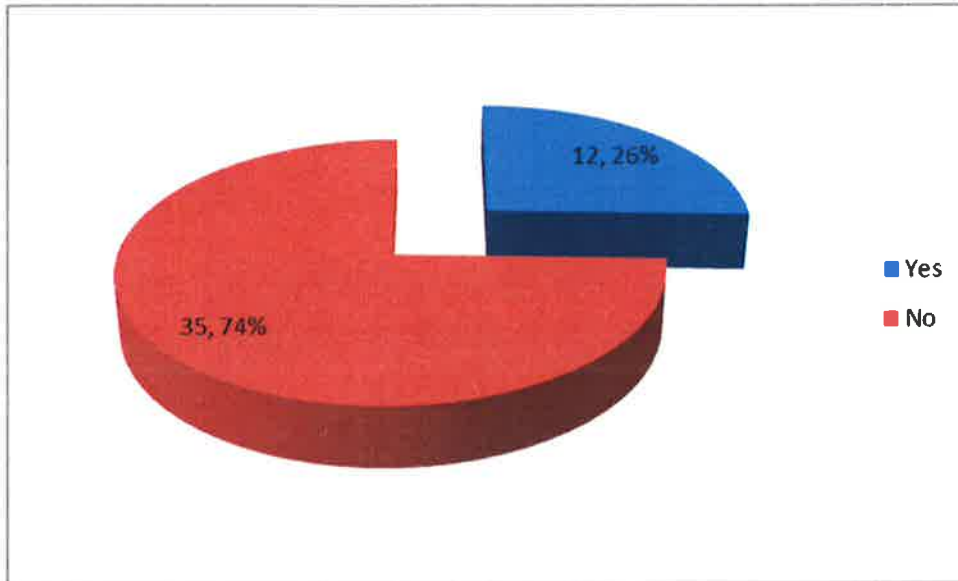
REASON FOR INCARCERATION



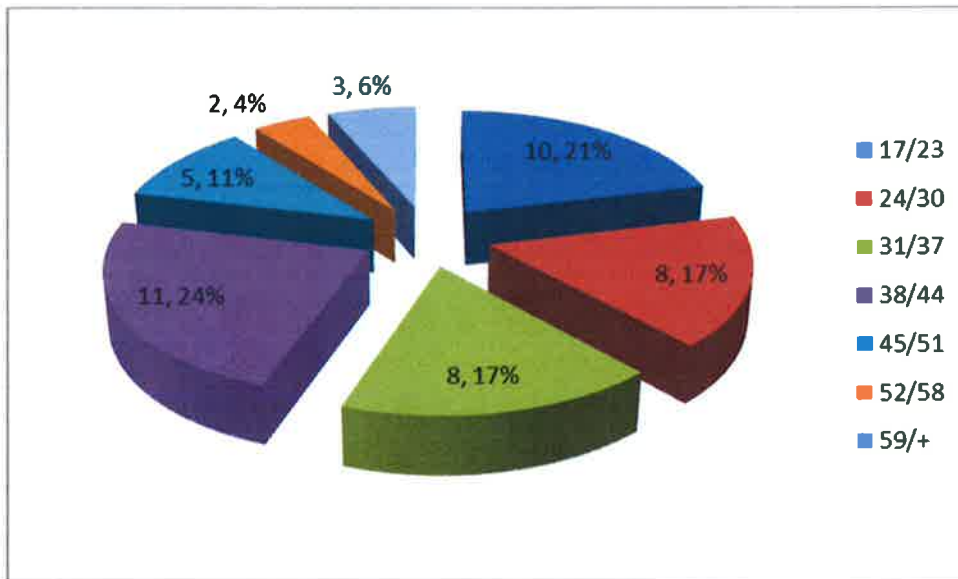
DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED



TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED

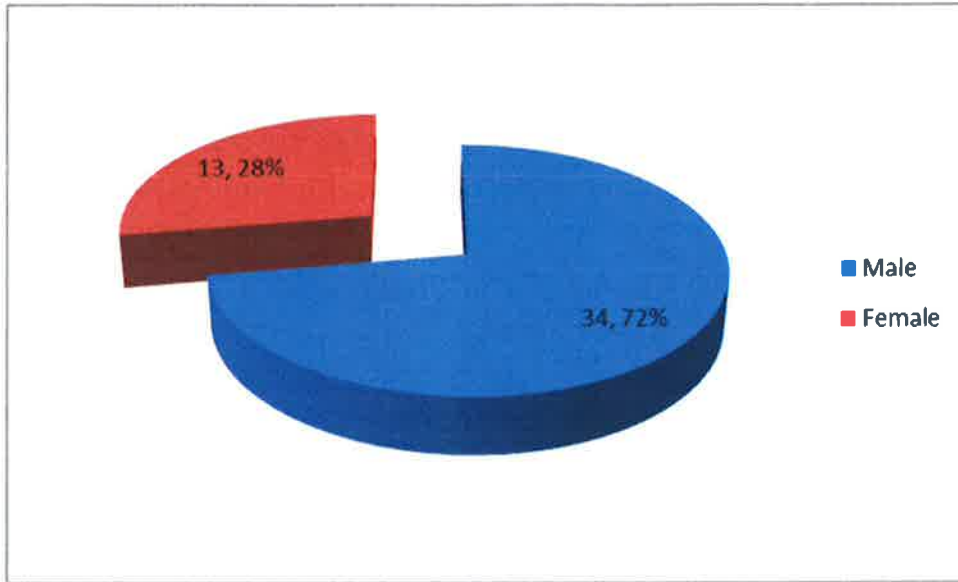


UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING

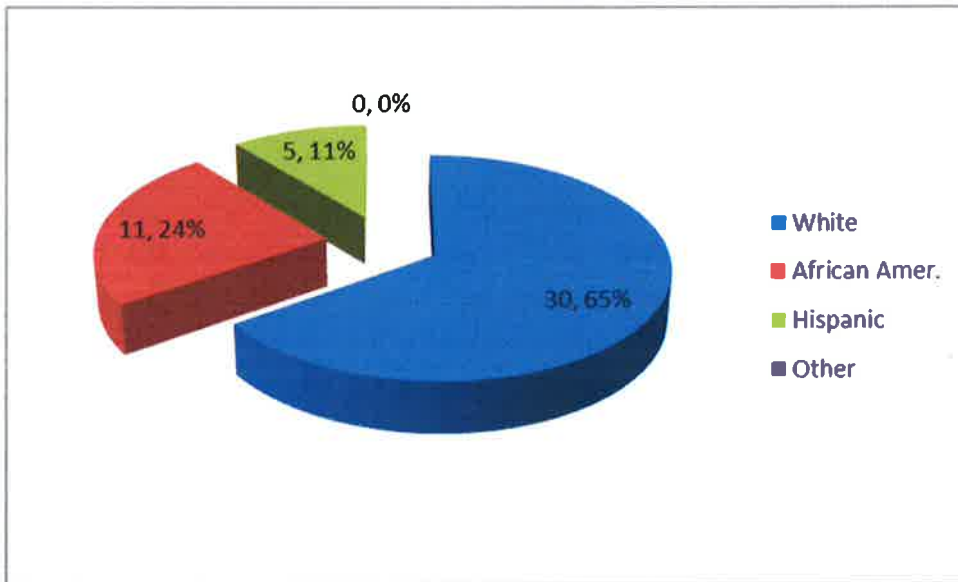


AGE PROFILE

RE- INCARCERATION OCTOBER 2018

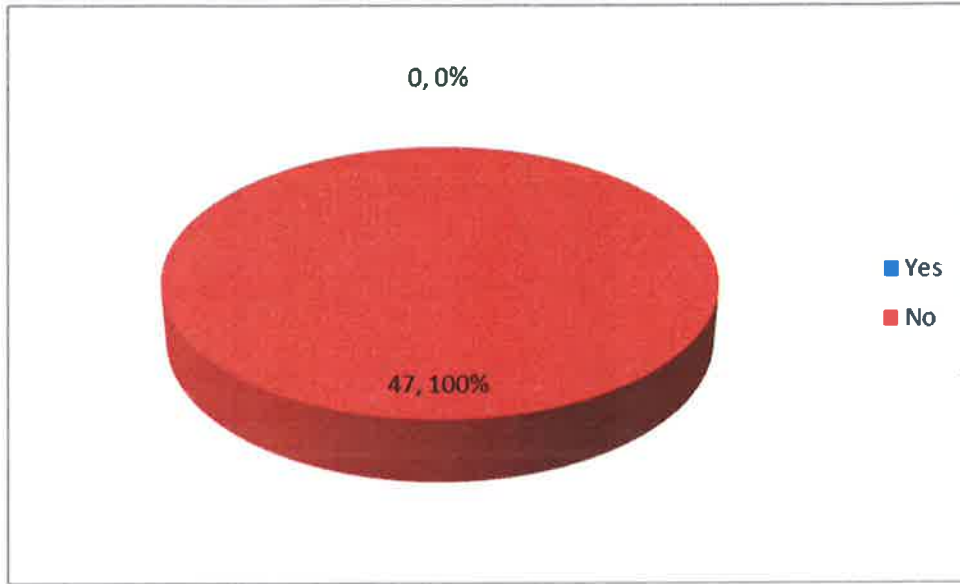


GENDER PROFILE

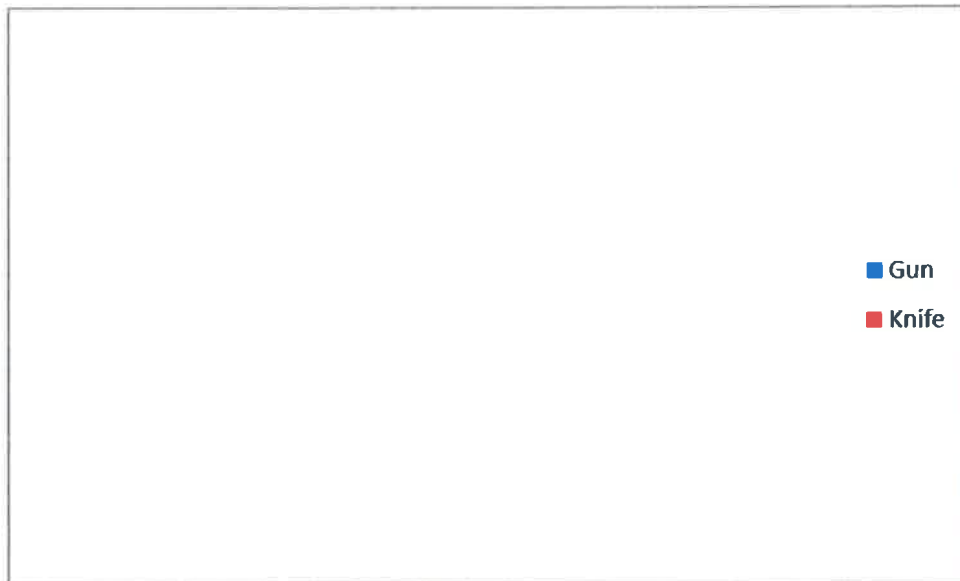


ETHNIC PROFILE

RE- INCARCERATION OCTOBER 2018

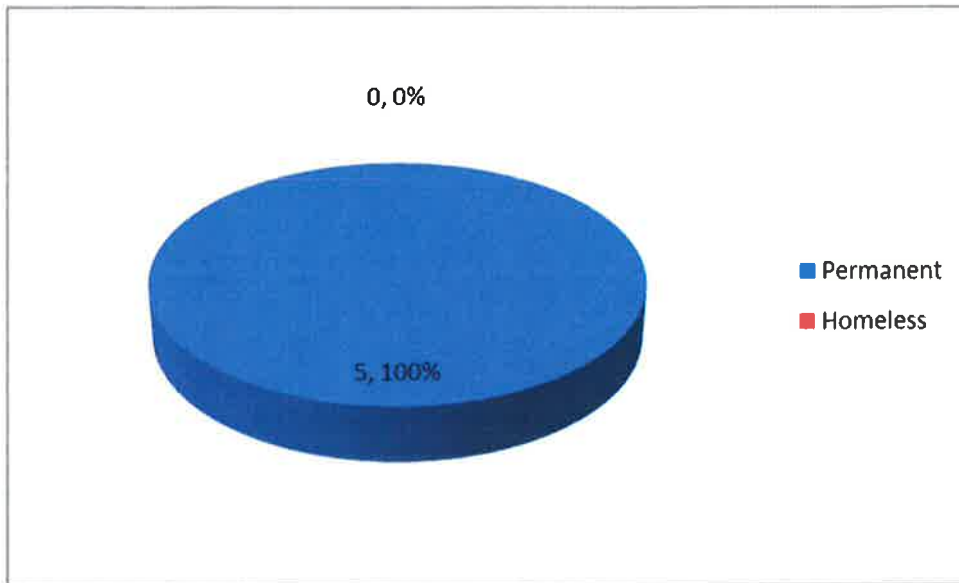


WEAPONS USED

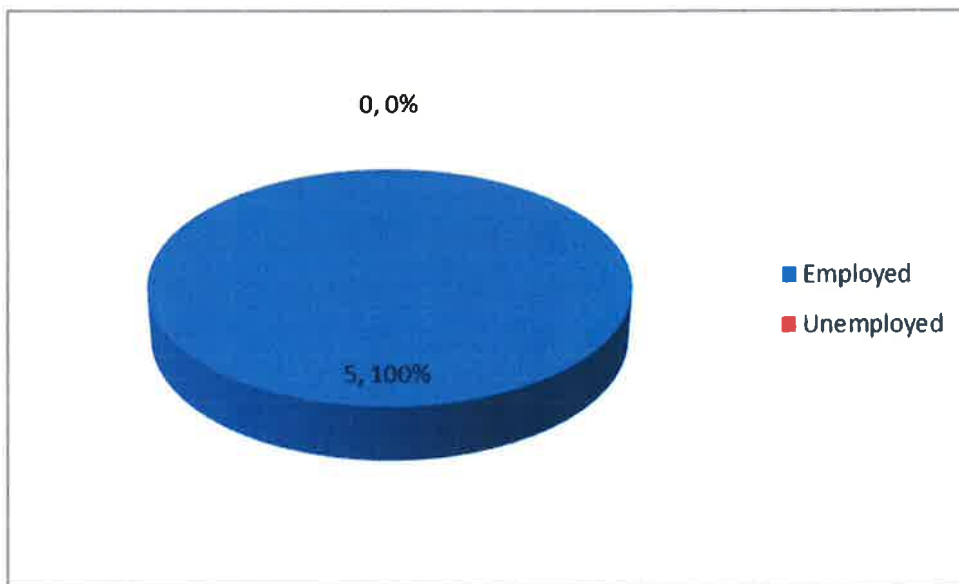


TYPE OF WEAPON

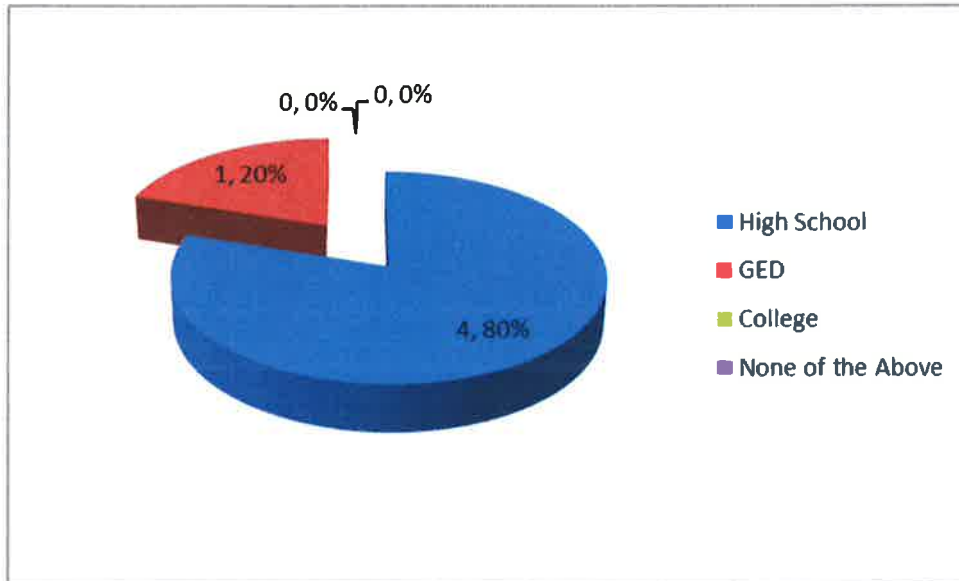

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

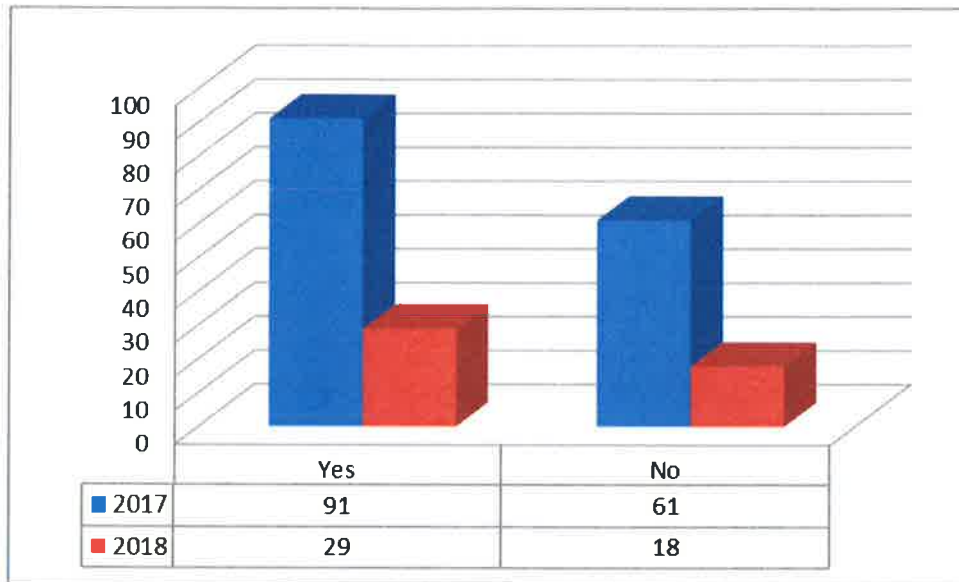

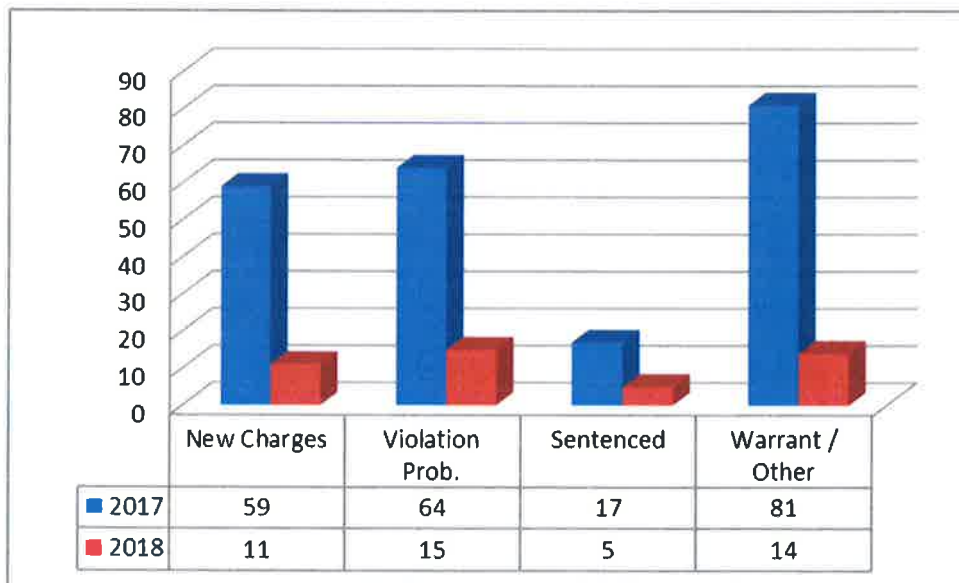
EDUCATION LEVEL

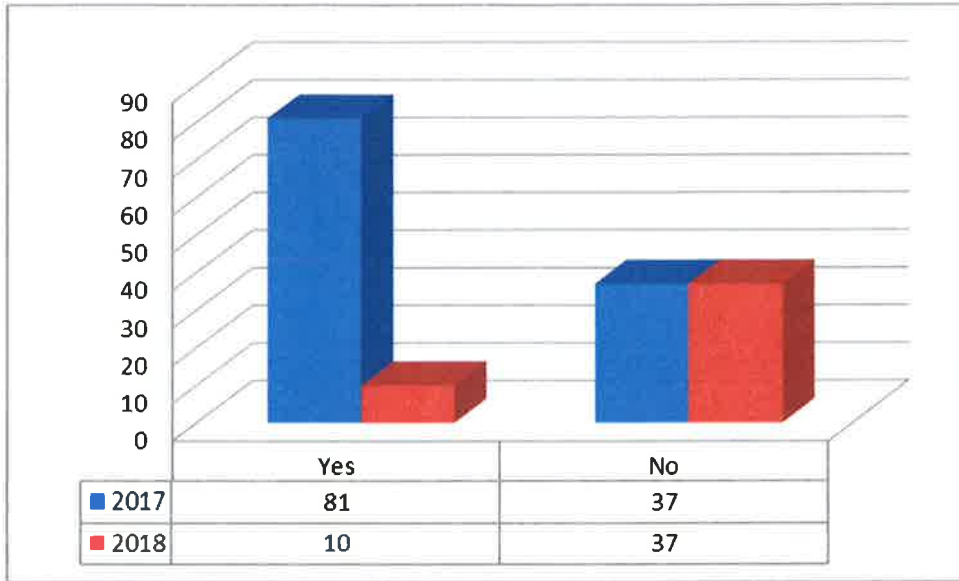
INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS



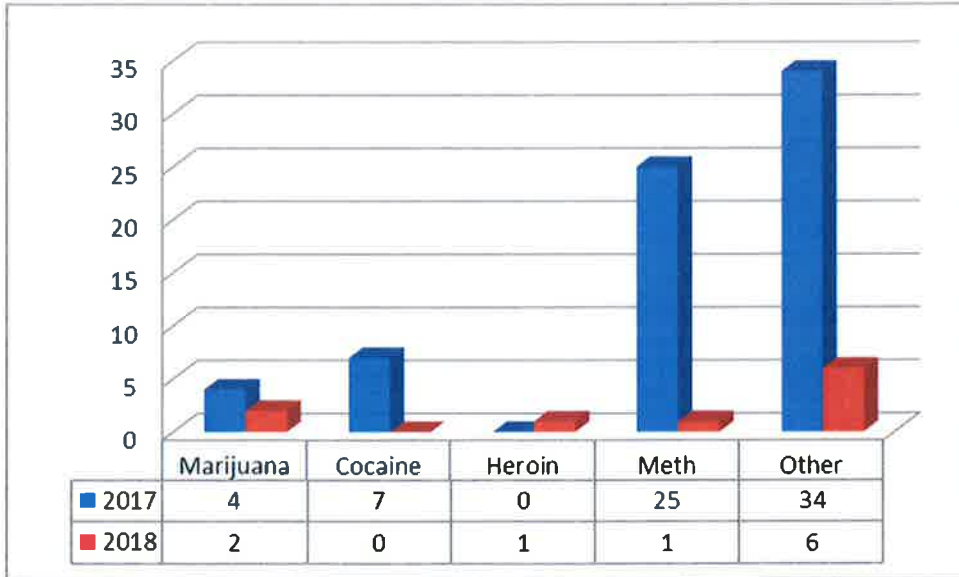
REASON FOR RETURN

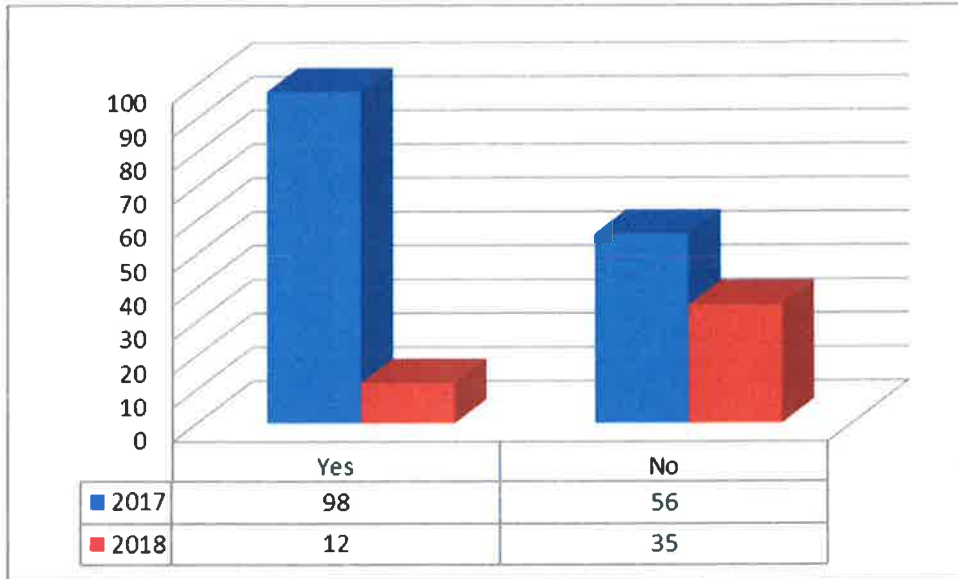
DRUGS USED



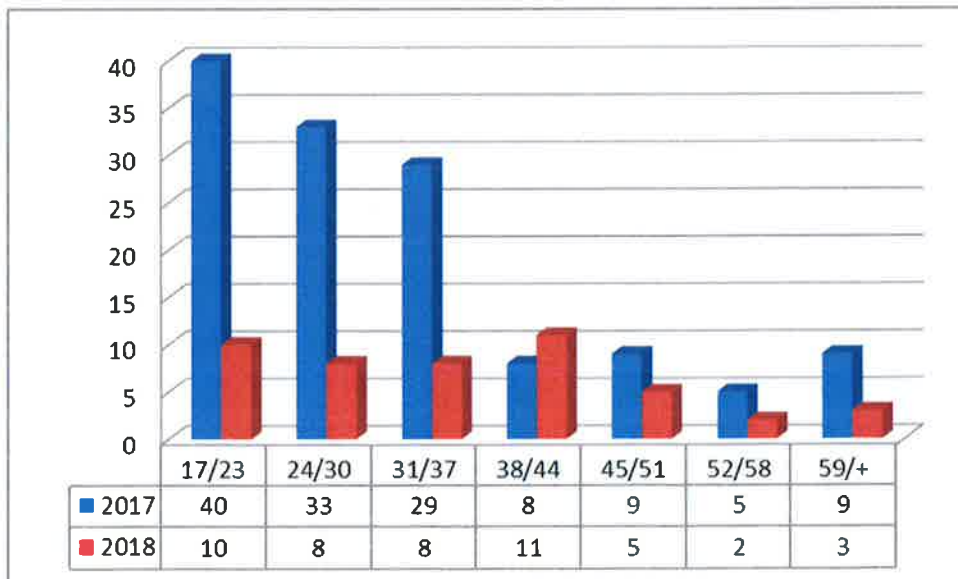
DRUG TYPE

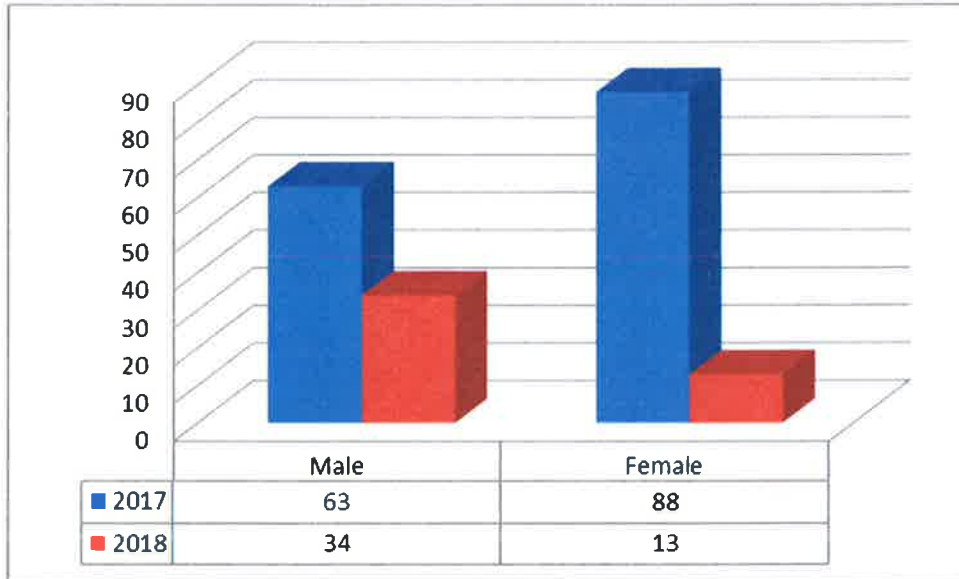

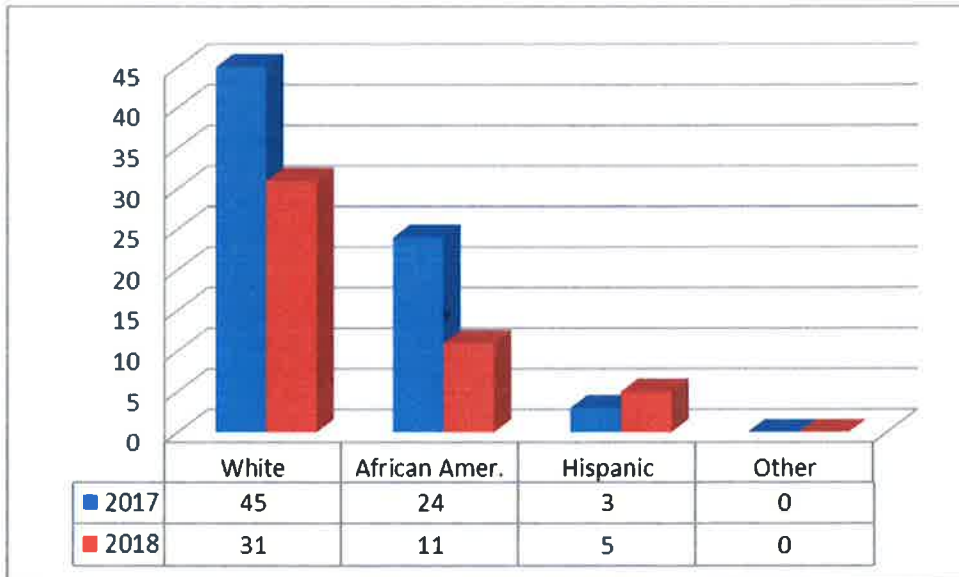
AGE PROFILE

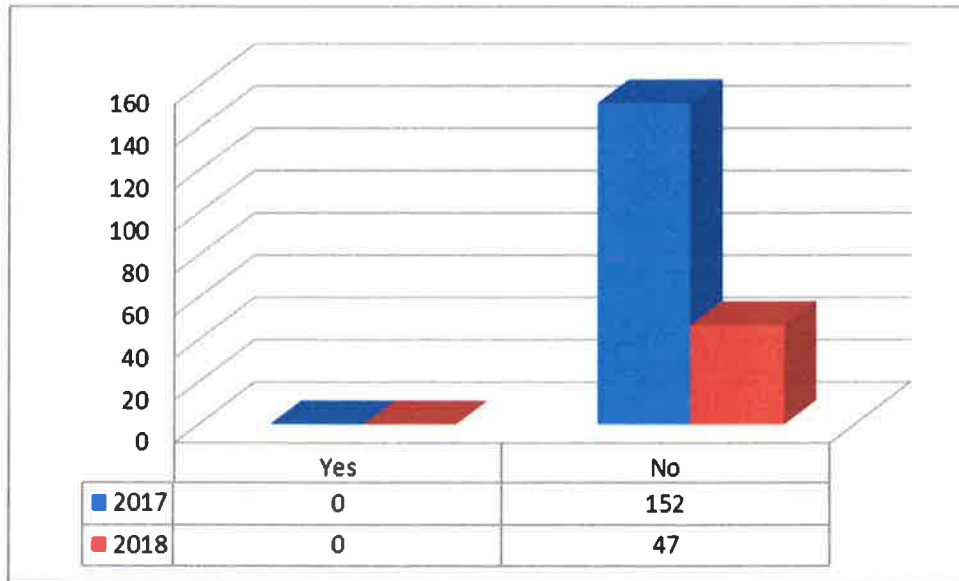
GENDER PROFILE



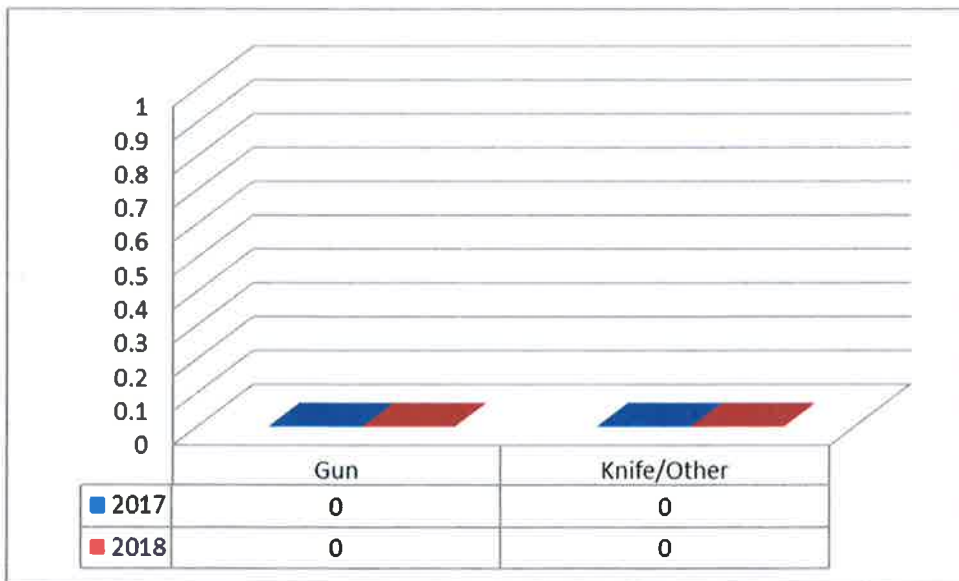

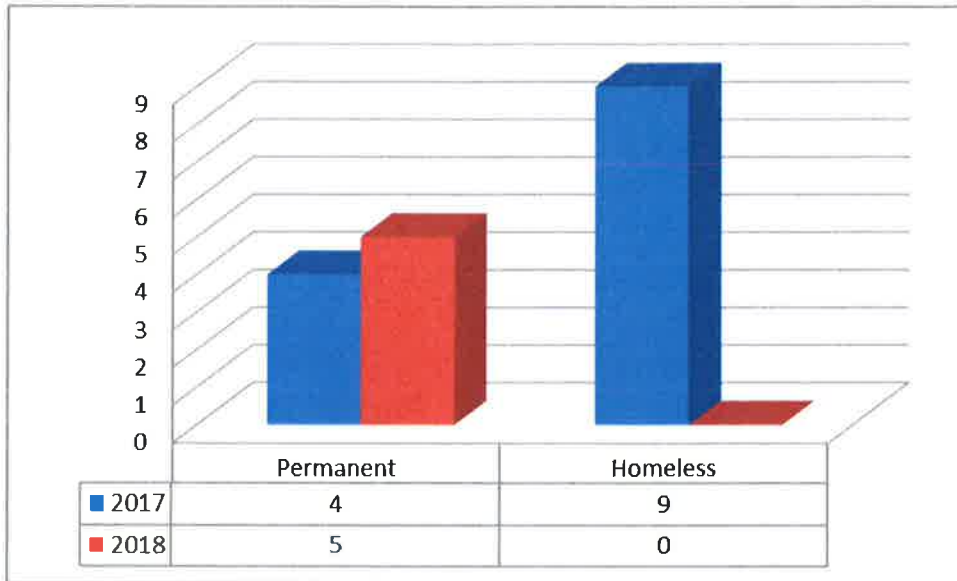
WEAPONS USED



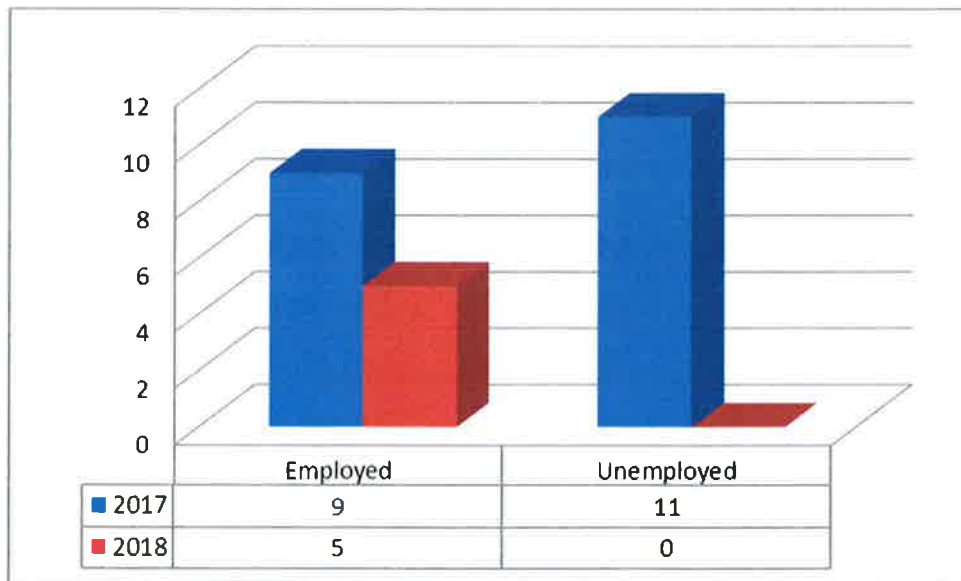
TYPE OF WEAPON USED

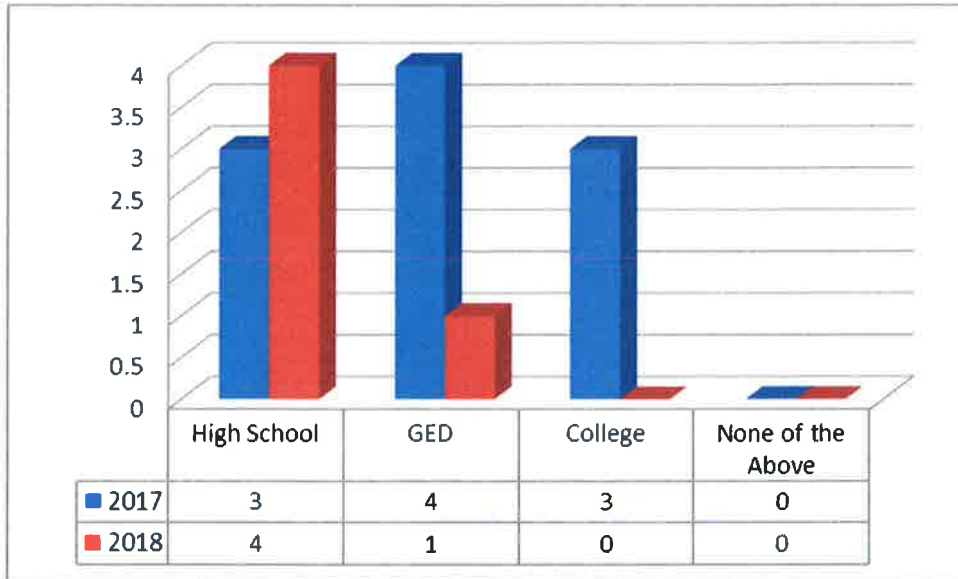
