






INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS






DRUGS USED




DRUG TYPE




UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING




AGE PROFILE




GENDER PROFILE






WEAPONS USED




TYPE OF WEAPON USED


BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS




REASON FOR INCARCERATION




DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED






