1. Call to order – Finance Committee Chair Richard Jones called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

- 2. Roll call (establish a quorum) Finance Committee members present were Richard Jones, George Jaeckel, Russell Kutz, Conor Nelan and Amy Rinard. Other board members present were Anita Martin, Laura Payne, and Walt Christensen. Staff in attendance were County Administrator, Ben Wehmeier; Finance Director, Marc DeVries; Assistant Finance Director, Tammy Worzalla; County Treasurer, John Jensen; Assistant County Treasurer, Kelly Stade; Corporation Counsel, Blair Ward; Paralegal, Sarana Stolar; and Land & Water Conservation Director Patricia Cicero. Members of the public present were Shelly Skildom representing Jellystone Park of Ft. Atkinson, Attorney Daniel Bach and Mike Mittelstadt of Jefferson, Stan Smoniewski of Lake Mills and Frankie Fuller of Cambridge.
- **3. Certification of compliance with the Open Meetings Law** County Administrator Wehmeier certified compliance with the Open Meetings Law.
- **4. Approval of the agenda** –The agenda was approved.
- 5. Approval of Finance Committee minutes for September 10, 2020; September 21, 2020; September 22, 2020; September 23, 2020; and September 24, 2020 A motion was made by Jaeckel/Rinard to approve the minutes for September 10, 2020; September 21, 2020; September 22, 2020; September 23, 2020; and September 24, 2020. The motion passed 5-0.
- 6. Communications None.
- 7. Public Comment Attorney Daniel Bach addressed the Committee on behalf of his client Mike Mittelstadt expressing a desire to work with the Committee to purchase a parcel of real property formerly owned by his client. Frankie Fuller addressed the Committee expressing her support for the Water Resource Management position. Walt Christensen addressed the Committee expressing his support for the Water Resource Management position. Anita Martin addressed the Committee expressing her support for the Water Resource Management position and mentioned she has been contacted by other communities that had also expressed support.
- **8. Discussion and possible action on Supervisor budget amendment process** County Administrator Wehmeier discussed the process for Supervisors to amend the budget after the October 13 presentation to the Board of Supervisors. No action was taken.
- 9. Discussion and possible action on 2021 sales tax estimates Wehmeier explained that Forward Analytics had released its sales tax estimates which are higher than Jefferson County has budgeted. Jefferson County is budgeting a reduction of \$200,000 in sales tax from \$6,525,000 to \$6,325,000. Wehmeier explained the uncertainty in the economy due to COVID and the outcome of legislative

negotiations made it difficult to accept the estimates proposed by Forward Analytics. The 2021 budget was built on a conservative sales tax estimate that would be monitored closely throughout the year and adjusted upward if necessary to accomplish goals like implementing steps back into the compensation system, addressing unfunded public health demands, and filling/restructuring positions that were unfunded in the 2021 budget. Wehmeier recounted that the Finance Committee had tasked him with finding a way to fund the Water Resource Management position and that increasing the sales tax estimate was a potential way of filling that position if the Committee wished to do so. No action was taken.

- 10. Discussion and possible action on Flood Mitigation Program matching funds Wehmeier explained that due to the cost restraints implemented early during the COVID crisis, and subsequent receipt of CARES funding relief, along with better than expected sales tax collections, the County is expecting to have a better year than what was forecasted at the beginning of the crisis. If trends continue through the end of the year there could be potential carryover from the 2020 results to apply as matching funds to the Flood Mitigation grants. Motion by Jaeckel/Rinard to accept the grants and use carryover funds as grant match to maximize potential funding, with the condition that a policy for end use of the land purchased is developed. The motion passed 5-0.
- 11. Discussion and possible action on funding reserve for Public Health in 2021 budget Wehmeier explained to the Committee that the County Health Department is estimating to spend approximately \$1 million on COVID response related activities during 2020. This year, the CARES Act has provided all funding for these activities. The County will receive an additional \$436,000 for 2021-2022 to continue these activities. There is some concern that this may not be enough and also that additional demands may be placed upon local health department agencies when a vaccine is approved for administration. Jefferson County has reserved \$105,960 in Other Contingency to assist in with any future unfunded costs related to COVID response. Motion by Rinard/Jaeckel to approve \$105,960 in Other Contingency budget line for COVID response in the 2021 budget. The motion passed 5-0.
- 12. Discussion and possible action on Water Resource Management Specialist position in Land and Water Conservation Department Wehmeier recalled to the Committee that the Water Resource Management Specialist position was unfunded to give administration time to study it and align it with policy coming through the comprehensive plan and make any corresponding compensation adjustments. At the last Finance Committee meeting the Committee had tasked the County Administrator with finding a way to fund the position immediately. In an earlier agenda item, it was mentioned that sales tax could be a potential funding source. There is also a DNR grant available in the amount of \$13,000 to assist with funding the position. Motion by Nelan/Kutz to approve an increase in the sales tax budget line of \$49,097 to fund the position at .5 FTE with full benefits to satisfy the immediate needs of the position and restructure the position based on the needs of the comprehensive plan and sustainability of funding. The motion passed 4-1 with Jaeckel dissenting.
- 13. Discussion and possible action on Management Analyst/Public Relations/Public Information Officer in Administration Department No action was taken.
- **14.** Discussion and possible action on allocation of funds in **2021** budget for department restructure Supervisor Martin was recognized by the Chair and commented that she believed that the discussion on department restructure was premature since the Board of Supervisors had not yet

approved a department restructure. Wehmeier explained that the item was added to the agenda as a reminder that several other positions are also unfilled in order to allow time for the Board and Administration to process the comprehensive plan, determine which functional skill sets and facility improvements are needed to execute the plan, and leave some availability for funding in the budget as well as study other sustainable funding sources for execution. No action was taken.

- 15. Discussion and possible action on approval of 2021 department budgets DeVries explained that due to the addition of a county-wide 1% COLA increase after the budget hearings were completed, all department budgets have been re-engineered and should be approved by the Committee prior to Board action. A summary sheet of each departments' budget was provided in the agenda package. Instead of voting on each individual department as was done in the budget hearings, DeVries suggested that the Committee vote on all departments' revised budgets with one motion. Motion by Rinard/Jaeckel to approve all departments' budgets as presented in the agenda package. The motion passed 5-0.
- 16. Discussion and possible action on setting the 2021 tax levy DeVries explained that the changes to the budget previously discussed had caused a shift in allocation between the Countywide and non-Countywide levies. The levy amounts and corresponding mill rates were included in the revised budget resolutions in the Committee agenda packages. Motion by Jones/Jaeckel to approve the resolutions and forward to the Board of Supervisors. The motion passed 5-0.
- **17. Discussion and possible action on CARES fund update** DeVries explained that the next reporting period was opening the following week and the Finance personnel were working hard to identify and report the next round of expenditures. At this time there is nothing to report. There will be more information to report to the Committee at the next meeting. No action taken.
- **18.** Discussion and possible action on amendment of the Real Estate Tax Foreclosure Policy Treasurer Jensen and Corporation Counsel Ward discussed potential changes to the policy including the appraised amount for the first advertised bid after foreclosure, increasing fees associated with settlement, and language requiring the Sheriff's Office to serve the property owner with notice of foreclosure prior to taking judgment. The Committee directed the Treasurer's office to work with Corporation Counsel on revised language to propose to the Committee for consideration. No action was taken.
- 19. Discussion and possible action on determining disposition of foreclosed properties, setting minimum bids for the sale of foreclosed properties and considering offers to purchase on foreclosed properties No action was taken.
- 20. Convene in closed session pursuant to section 19.85 (1)(e) Wis. Stats. for deliberating or negotiating the purchase of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session, for the purpose of discussion and possible action on setting minimum bids, selling and considering offers to purchase on tax foreclosed properties and other county owned properties and pursuant to section 19.85 (1)(g) Wis. Stats. to confer with legal counsel concerning strategy to be adopted by Jefferson County with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved for the purpose of discussion and possible action on claims against Jefferson County Motion by Jones/Jaeckel to convene into closed session. The Committee voted by roll call to convene into closed session. The motion passed 5-0.

- 21. Reconvene in open session for action on closed session items if necessary Motion by Jones/Jaeckel to convene into open session. The motion passed 5-0. Motion by Jones/Rinard to approve sale of property back to Mike Mittelstadt for the full amount of taxes, interest, penalties and associated fees. The motion passed 5-0. Motion by Jones/Jaeckel to approve sale of one lot of tax foreclosure property to Jellystone Park and directed Corporation Counsel to work with Shelly Skildom on determining associated fees related to the sale. The motion passed 5-0. The Committee also advised the County Administrator to negotiate with an interested buyer on the Lamp Road property, advertise the property in the Town of Milford, advertise the property on South Monroe in Waterloo, run plates on the cars in the parking lot of the property on County Highway A and notify owners to remove them, advertise the property on Union Street in Johnson Creek and advertise the property formerly known as the Ice Pump in Jefferson.
- **22.** Discussion and possible action on **2020** projections of budget vs. actual revenues and expenditures DeVries reviewed the unadjusted September 30 results and comparison to prior years at September 30, noting that current trends are favorable and if continued, Jefferson County will end the year in a stronger position than previously anticipated. No action was taken.
- 23. Review of the financial statements and department update for August 2020 Finance Department No action taken.
- 24. Review of the financial statements and department update for August 2020 Treasurers Department – No action taken.
- 25. Review of the financial statements and department update for August 2020 Child Support Department No action taken.
- **26. Update on contingency fund balance** The balance of the 2020 contingency funds is \$529,534. There are currently no contingency funds budgeted in the other contingency line, and the vested benefits balance is \$300,000.
- 27. Discussion of funding for projects related to the new Highway Facilities and sale of old Highway Facilities. Wehmeier updated the Committee on the progress of the old highway site.
- **28. Set future meeting schedule, next meeting date, and possible agenda items** The next meeting is scheduled for November 5, 2020 at 8:30 a.m. Potential agenda items include a report on the CARES purchases and expenditures to date, amendment of the Real Estate Tax Foreclosure Policy, and Supervisor budget amendments.
- **29. Review of Invoices** After review of the invoices, a motion was made by Jaeckel/Nelan to approve the payment of invoices totaling \$3,867,382.34. The motion passed 5-0.
- 30. Adjourn A motion was made by Jones/Kutz to adjourn at 11:34 a.m. The motion passed 5-0.

### Jefferson County, Wisconsin Real Estate Tax Foreclosure Policy

#### **Definition**

The legal process by which ownership interest in real property is terminated due to delinquent property tax payments. This process typically results in the sale of the property by competitive bidding, public auction or other methods allowed by law which are determined to be in the best interests of the County, with the proceeds being applied to the delinquent property taxes and interest.

### **Policy**

This policy provides guidance to Administration and staff on dealing with the various issues related to tax foreclosures, such as setting minimum bids, allowing the repurchase of land by former owners and the eviction process.

### **Procedure**

The Treasurer will send out a letter to the property owner that the County is starting the process of foreclosing on the property.

The first step in the foreclosure process is to establish a list of properties that meet the criteria for foreclosure. Properties are able to be foreclosed on after 2 years of being tax delinquent. For example, if the Treasurer issues a tax certificate for the 2016 delinquent taxes on September 1, 2017, then delinquent taxes from 2014 or earlier would be subject to a tax foreclosure action. (s. 75.20, Wis. Stats.) (Tax certificates shall be void 11 years following December 31st of the year in which such certificates were dated.) (s. 75.521 (3)(a)4, Wis. Stats.)

Administration will determine if there are any properties that should not be foreclosed on. For example, if the property owner is making payments that are greater than the amount of delinquent taxes and interest each year, a decision not to commence a foreclosure action on that property may be appropriate.

Administration will send a listing to the municipalities where the properties are located informing them that the County is starting the foreclosure process and requesting that they inform the county of any issues with the property. (i.e. zoning issues, environmental issues, bankruptcy etc.)

Administration will send a listing of the properties to the title company to conduct a title search.

Administration will conduct a search to determine if any properties are the subject of a bankruptcy petition. If any property is the subject of a bankruptcy petition, the county is stayed from proceeding on the foreclosure until the bankruptcy petition is dismissed or the property owner is granted a discharge.

### Commence Legal Action Pursuant to § 75.521, Wis. Stats.:

After the title search is completed and the title letters are received from the title company, a petition, notice and list of delinquent tax parcels is drafted and filed with the Clerk of Courts. These 3 documents are published as a class 3 notice in the County's official newspaper and are sent out by certified mail with return receipt requested to property owners and all lien holders.

The property owner has eight weeks from the first publication of the notice to redeem the property by paying the delinquent taxes and interest for the delinquent tax years. If full payment is received, a redemption certificate is filed with the Clerk of Courts.

After the redemption date has expired, any person having any right, title or interest in or lien upon the property may serve an answer (such as disputing the foreclosure) to the Treasurer, which has to be filed with the Clerk of Courts within 30 days.

If there is an answer, Corporation Counsel will appear in court and represent the County's interests.

If there is no answer, an affidavit of default and judgement are filed with the Clerk of Courts, recorded with the Register of Deeds and sent to the Finance Director for sending notice to municipal clerks informing them of the tax exempt status of the properties.

On a foreclosed property, notices will be sent out to the occupants for payment of rent to be sent to the County in the future. A determination will need to be made on how much rent should be paid. Anyone living on the property when the county takes title will be given a 5 day notice to pay rent and expenses (gas, water, sewer etc.) and enter into a month to month rental agreement to continue to pay rent and expenses, as well as to perform general maintenance on the property (snow removal, lawn care, etc.) or vacate the premises. If the tenants agree to pay rent and continue to reside on the property, the property will be advertised as tenant occupied and inform prospective purchasers they could have a rental unit with tenants, or upon request of the prospective purchaser, the county will commence eviction proceedings.

The foreclosed property will be brought forward to the Finance Committee for authorization to sell the foreclosed property (Resolution 2002-16, 05-14-2002).

If requested by the former property owner, the committee may allow the repurchase of the foreclosed property by the former property owner by payment of (1) all delinquent taxes together with interest thereon to the date of payment; (2) specific costs attributable to the property including special assessments, interest and foreclosure costs; and (3) an additional sum equal to 125 percent of the foregoing year's taxes. (Ordinance 2002-12).

The Finance Committee may offer sale of the land to the municipality where the foreclosed property is located, at the cost of the delinquent taxes and interest. Note: If any property is sold to the municipality, it shall be approved by County Board action. Notice may be given

to any other state and local agencies that may be interested in the property.

Administration will place the property for sale at a minimum bid of the property's assessed value which the Finance Committee has determined will be equal to the estimated fair market value of the property for no less than 20 days.

If the property does not sell at a minimum bid of the estimated fair market value, administration will place the property for sale at a minimum of the total delinquent taxes and interest for no less than 20 days.

If the property does not sell at the minimum of the total delinquent taxes and interest, administration will place the property for sale at a minimum of the delinquent taxes for no less than 20 days.

If the property does not sell for an amount equal to or greater than the delinquent taxes, administration will bring forward to the Finance Committee for discussion on how to dispose of the property.

Administration has the authority to accept bids following these guidelines.

Any properties that Administration feels would not be able to follow this procedure will be brought to the Finance Committee for discussion and possible action.

#### Administration

This policy is for use in guiding financing decisions of the County, and can be interpreted by the Finance Committee as part of overall discussions related to foreclosed properties. It is administered by the Finance Committee in conjunction with the County's other fiscal policies. It may be amended or revised from time to time as determined by the Finance Committee.
