6. Report from CJCC/Treatment Coordinator (Holler)

The team is looking at increasing participation in the program. 5th and 6th offenses are automatic prison time and are no longer eligible for the program. He also discussed the testing process with COVID-19 issues. Positive COVID participants will have the program suspended until they are cleared.
