Holler said that peer support services have been increasing with the assistance of Human Service. Brantmeier talked about the importance of having a Peer Support Specialist. Cauley explained that this is a contracted position which utilizes grant funds.

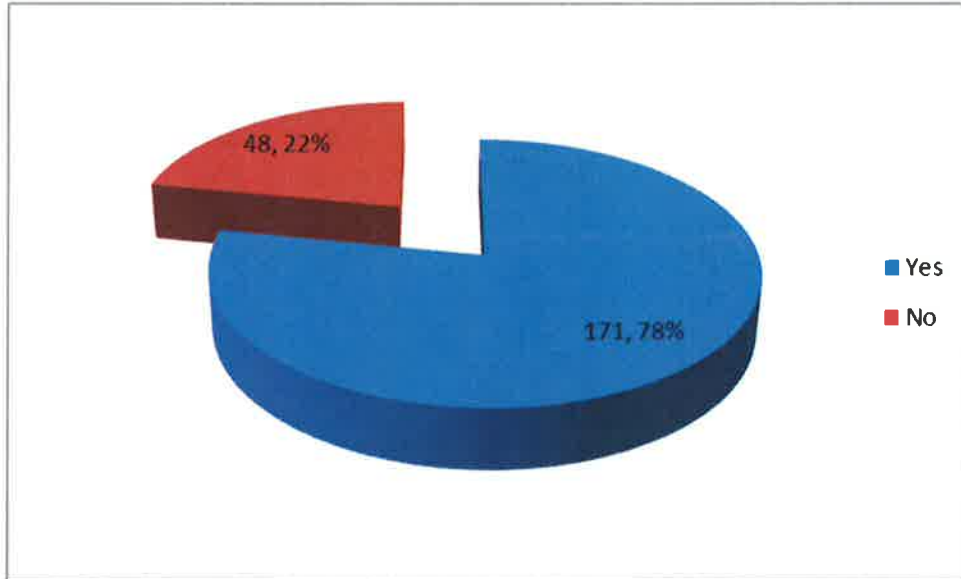

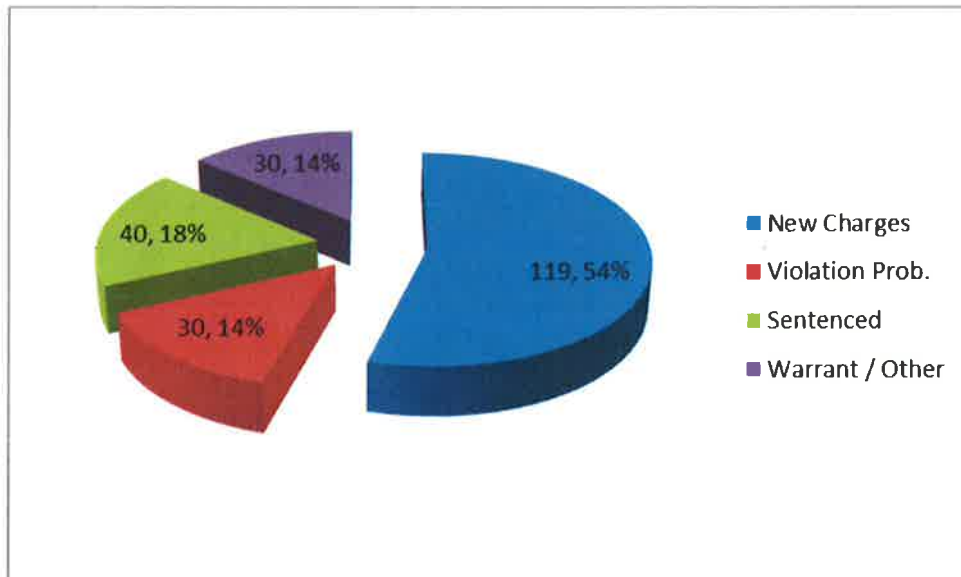

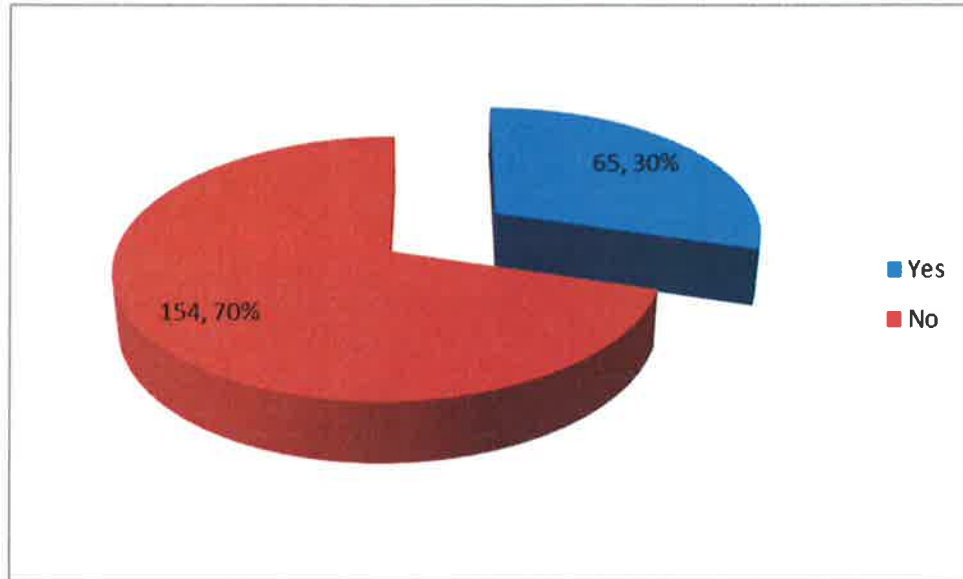


BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS

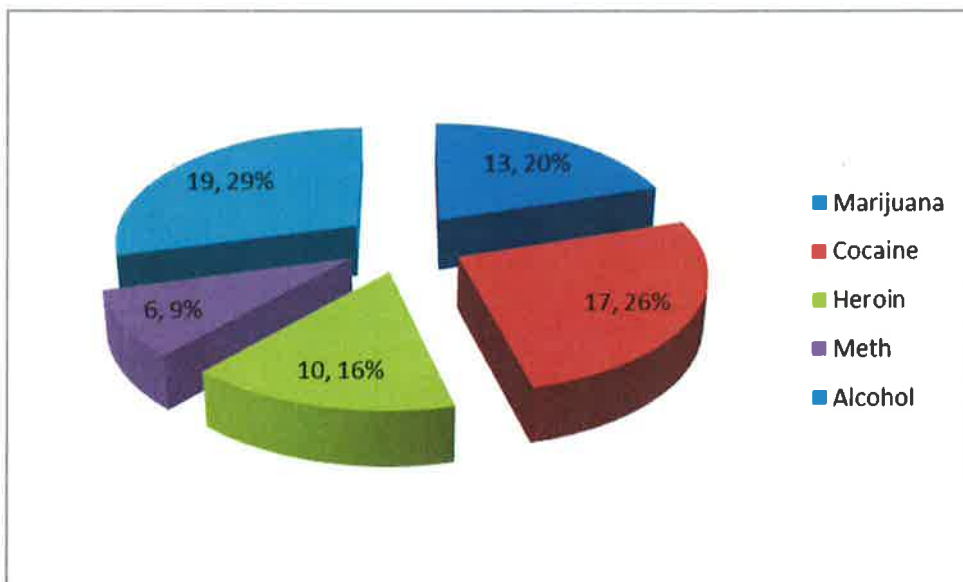


REASON FOR INCARCERATION

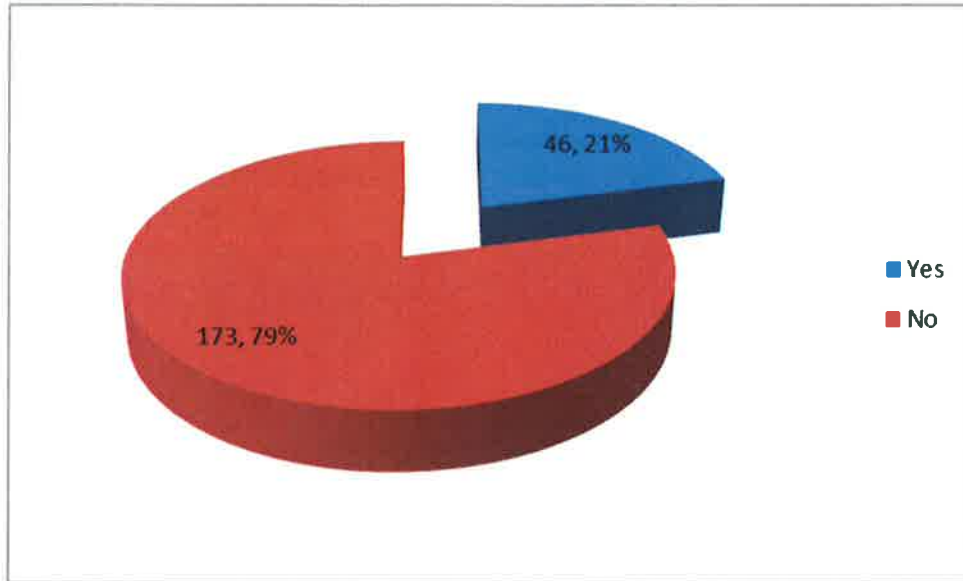


DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED

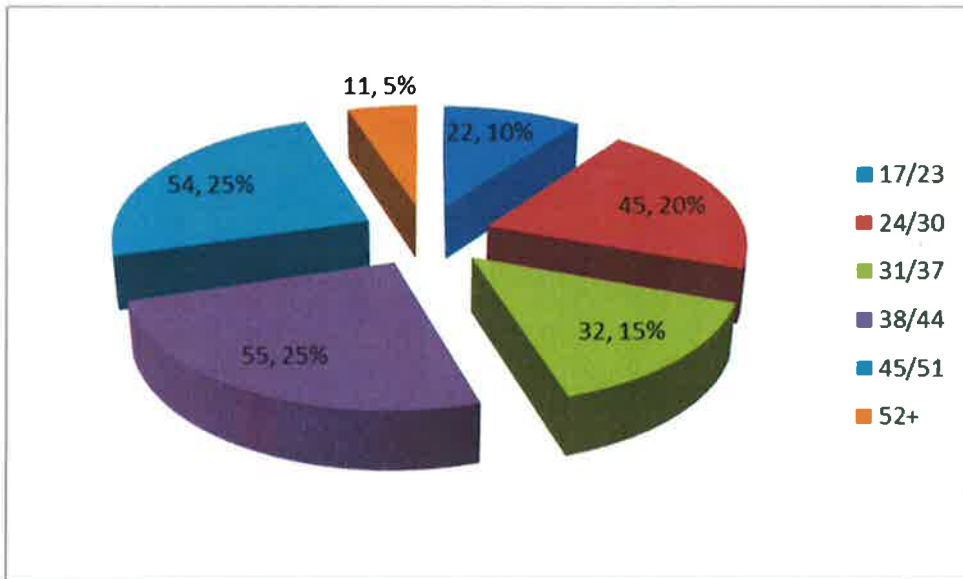


TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2022

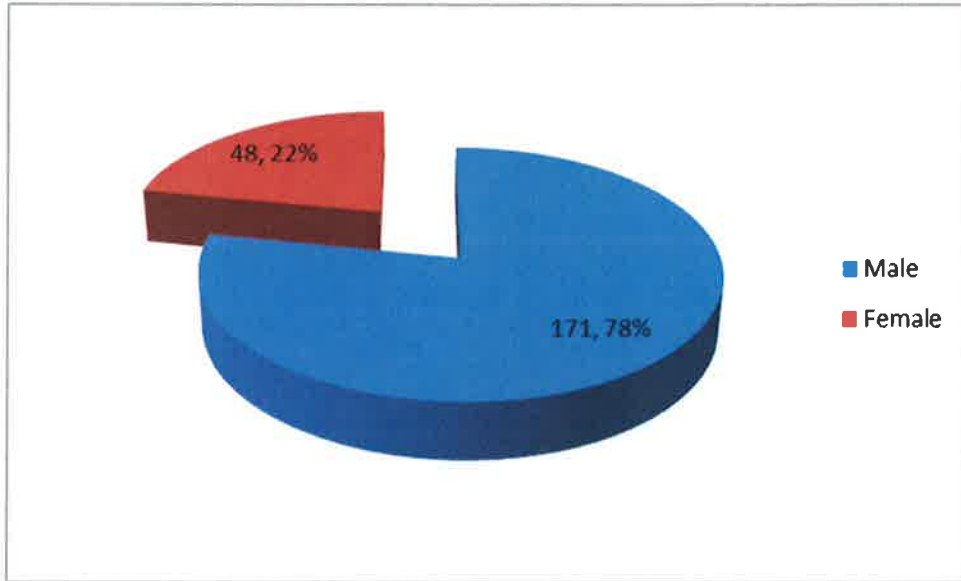


UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING

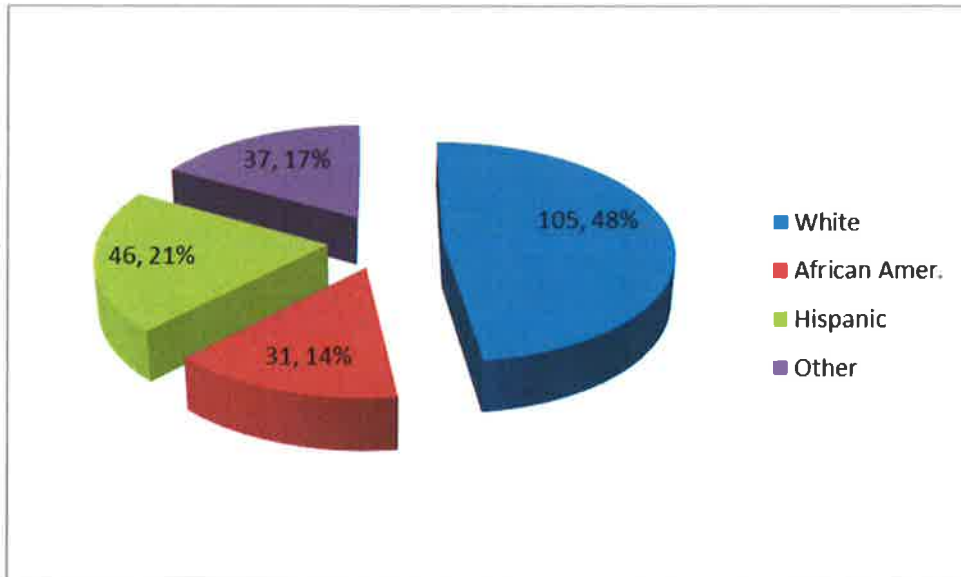


AGE PROFILE

RE- INCARCERATION JANUARY 2022

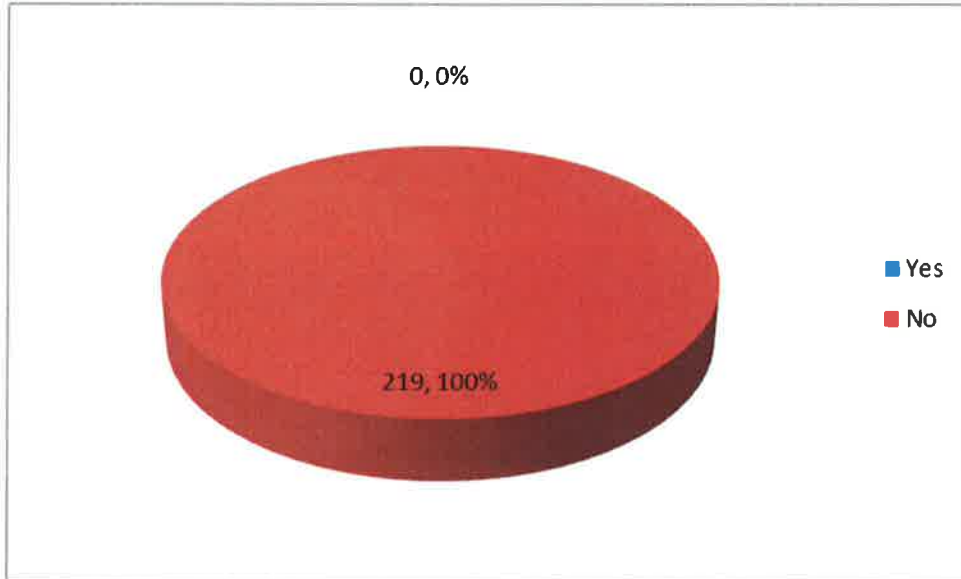


GENDER PROFILE

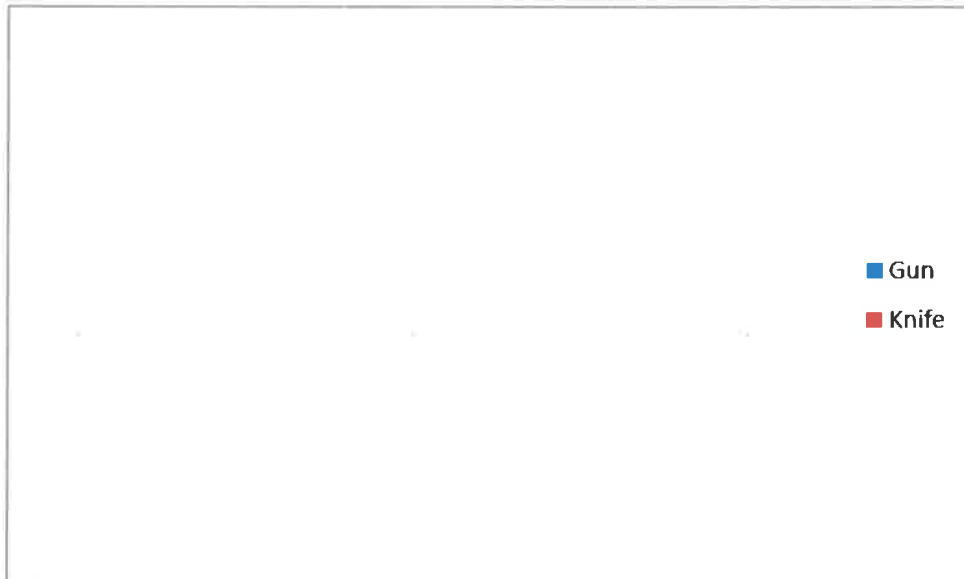


ETHNIC PROFILE

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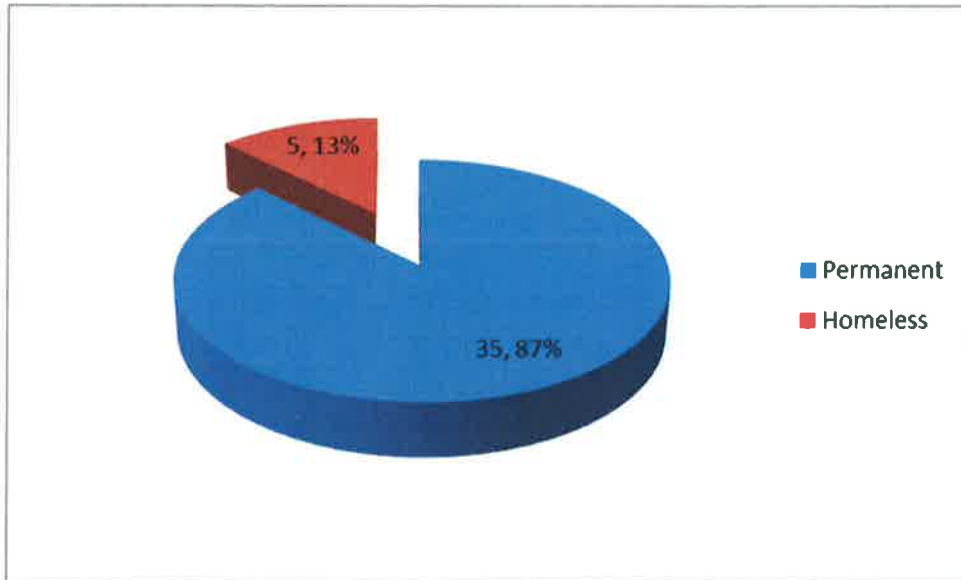


WEAPONS USED

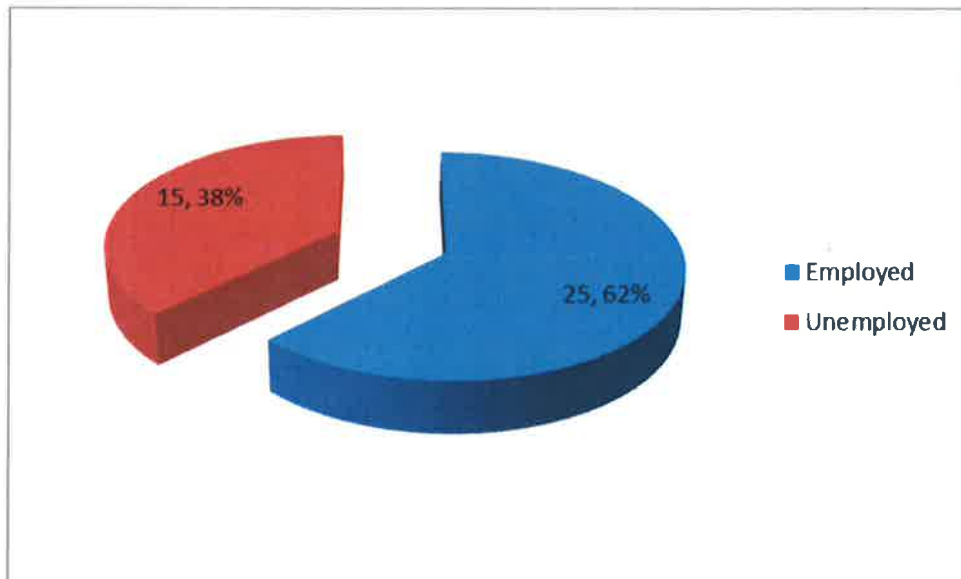


TYPE OF WEAPON

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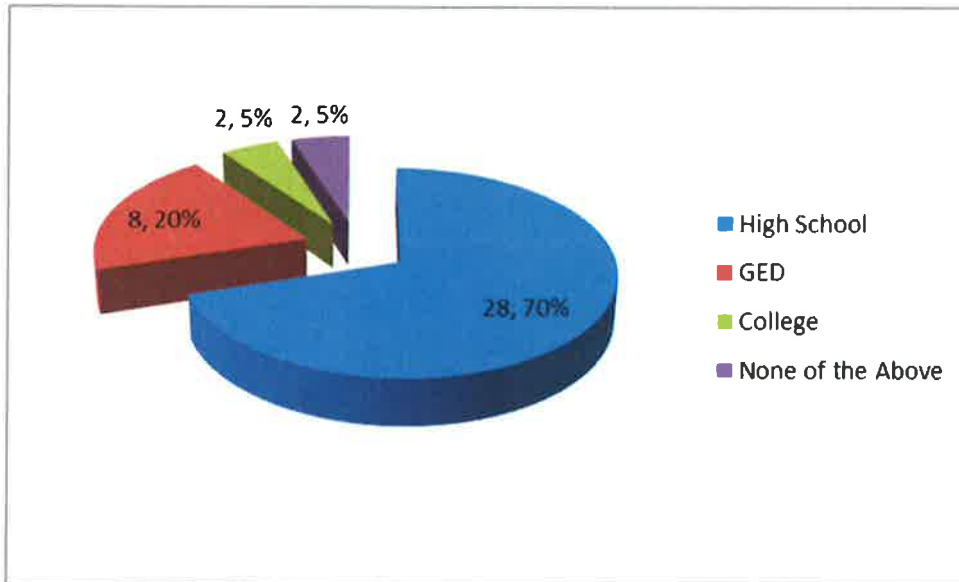

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

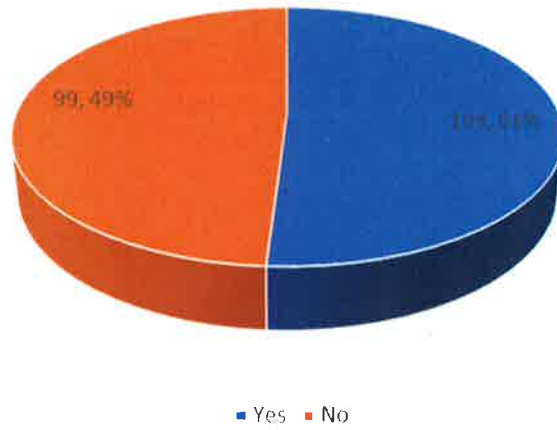

EDUCATION LEVEL

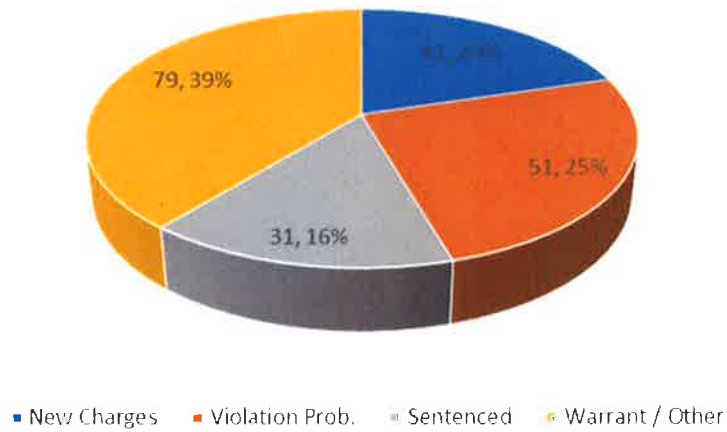

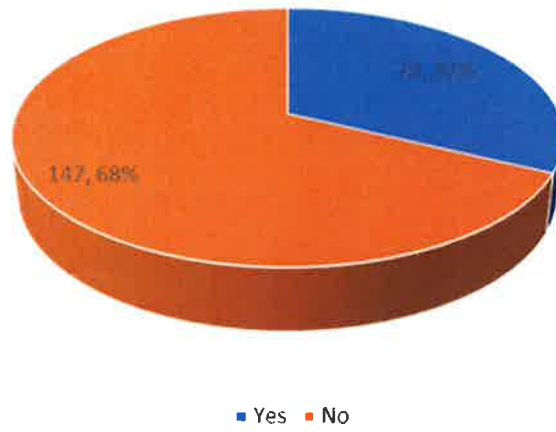
BEEN INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS

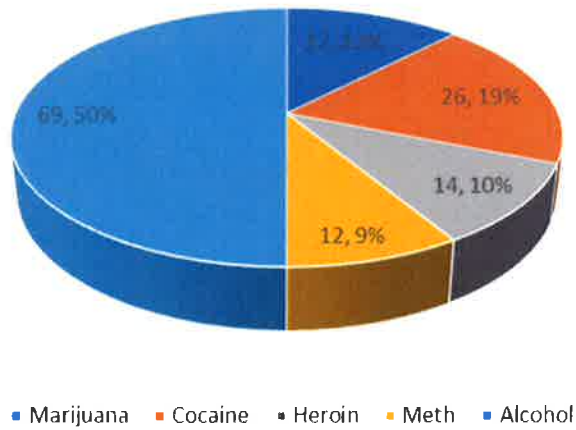
REASON FOR INCARCERATION

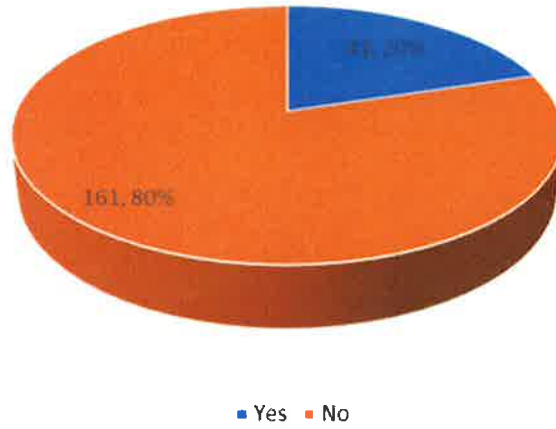
DRUGS OR ALCOHOL RELATED

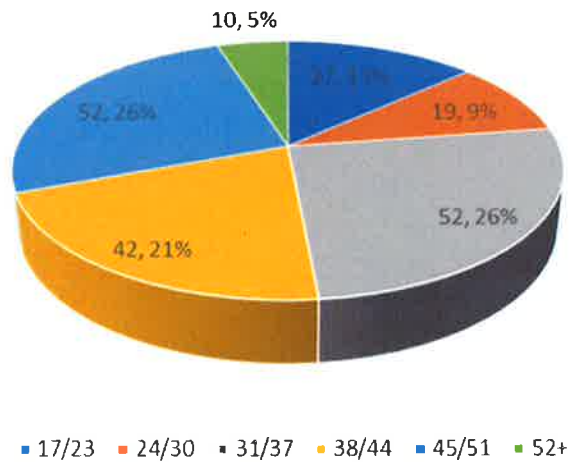
TYPE OF SUBSTANCE USED

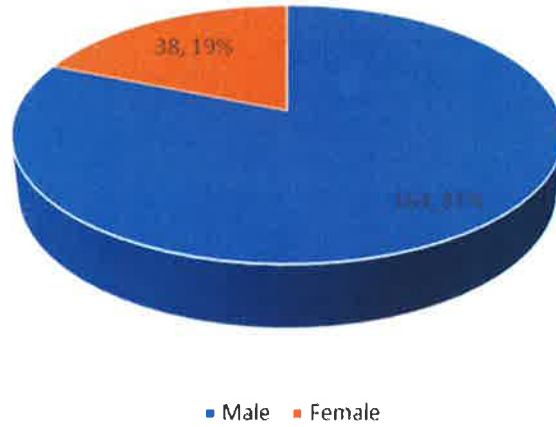
UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING

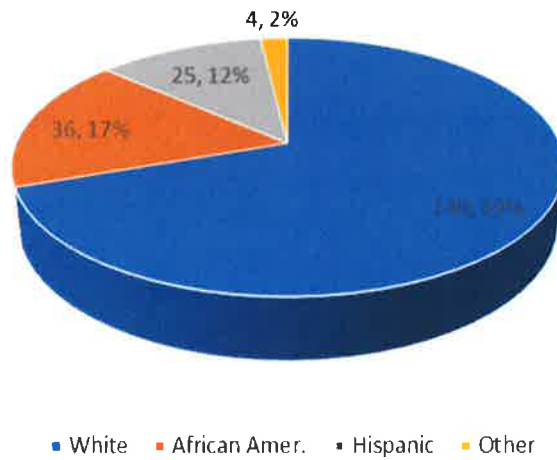
AGE PROFILE

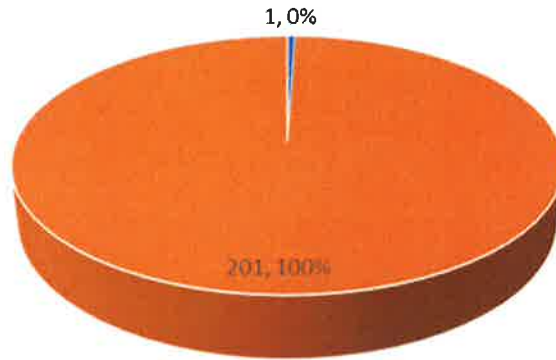
GENDER PROFILE

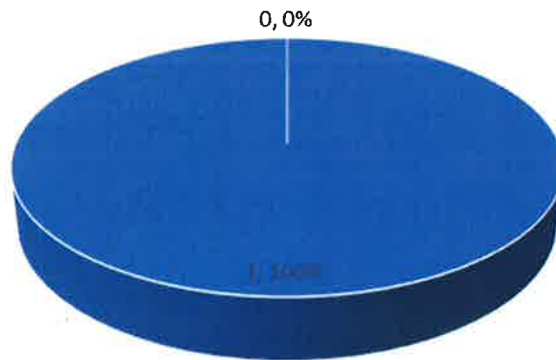

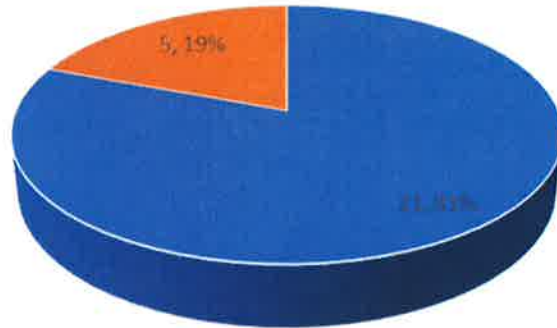


■ Gun ■ Knife

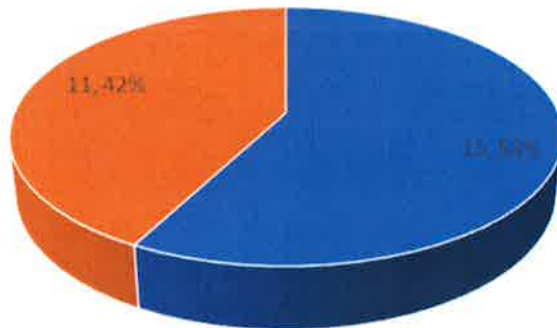

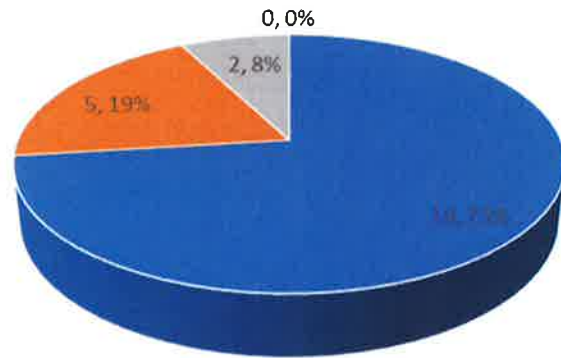


■ Employed ■ Unemployed
