1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order by Judge Dehring at 12:00 p.m.

Draft minutes were provided for review.

Motion by Wallace/Hamre Incha to approve the minutes from March 23, 2022 as amended. Motion passed 11-0.

5. Public Comment

6. Evidence Based Decision Making and Data Gathering Subcommittee update. Update on Driver’s License Clinic.

Holler said that the first two Driver’s License Clinics were successful. Rumpf said that people are receptive to the program and hopes more people will be made aware of the program so that they can take advantage of it. No action taken.

The CJCC/Treatment Coordinator report was provided for review. Holler talked about the additional TAD Grant Funding categories that will be available in 2023. No action taken.

6. A: A Driver’s License Restoration Clinics was held on 08/18/2022 at the Watertown Public Library. Four people showed for the clinic and all were given an Action Plan with steps detailing how they can reinstate their licenses. Outcome data is still being collected by LIFT WISCONSIN from those attendees as well as the attendees from the July clinic.

B: A clinic was scheduled for the Waterloo Public Library on 09/13/2022. However, no attendees registered for this event and the clinic was postponed, date pending. Jefferson County and LIFT WI are examining more effective outreach efforts for that community before setting a new date in early 2023.

C: A track for defendants facing Operating After Revocation or Operating While Suspended charges to have their charges dismissed through a Deferred Prosecution Agreement is nearing completion. This will be available to defendants as soon as next week.

D: Remaining clinics for 2022 are as follows:

C: Community Service continues to be utilized for sanctions in lieu of short-term jail sanctions. For 2022, participants have been ordered and have completed the following:

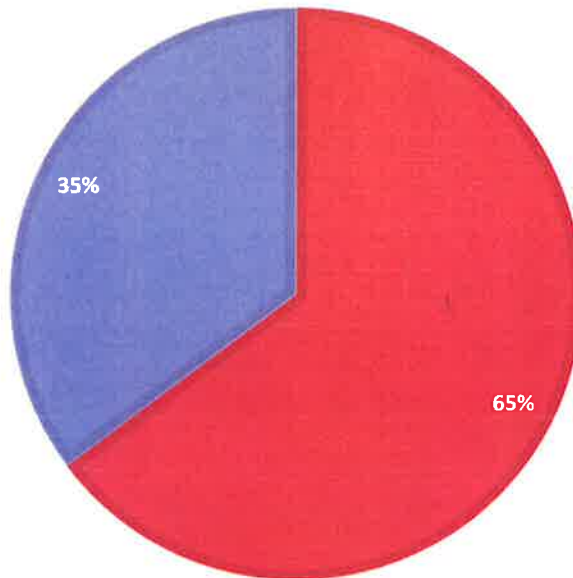

9. The Treatment Court Team recommends the Peer Support Specialist be made a permanent member of the Team.

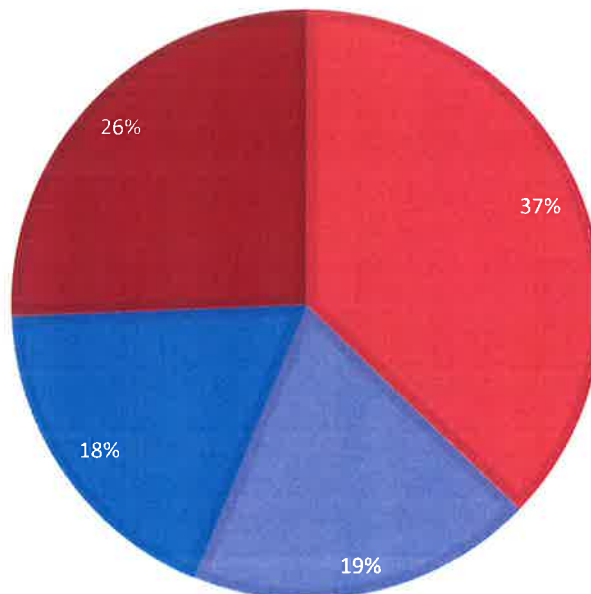
INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS

■ Yes ■ No



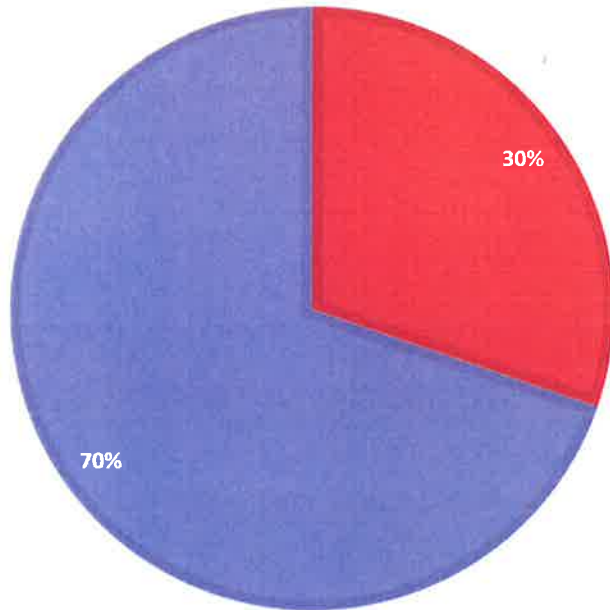
REASON FOR REINCARCERATION

■ New Charges ■ Violation Prob. ■ Sentenced ■ Warrant / Other



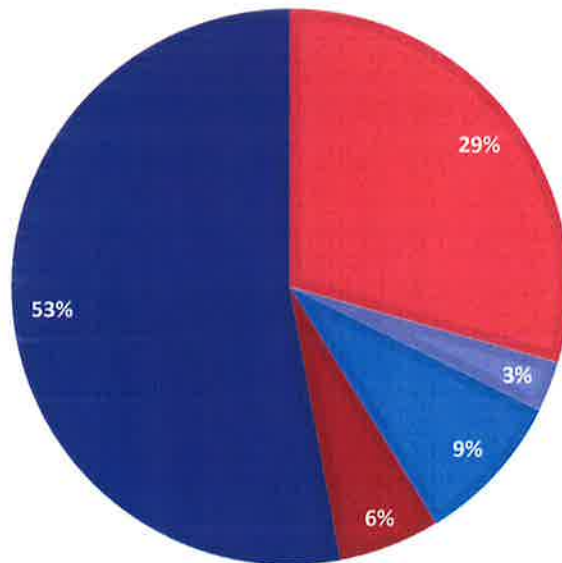
ALCOHOL OR DRUG RELATED?

■ Yes ■ No



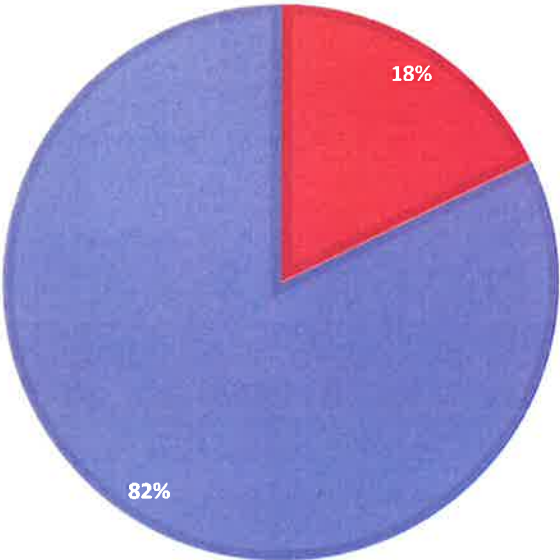
TYPE OF DRUG USED

■ Marijuana ■ Cocaine ■ Heroin ■ Meth ■ Alcohol



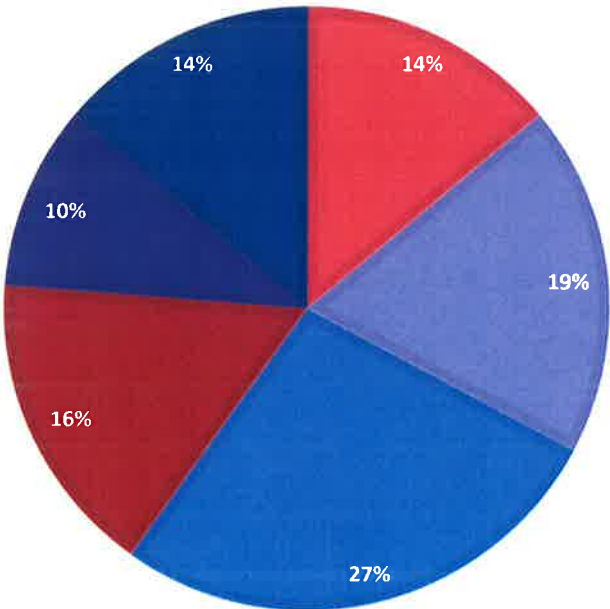
UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING?

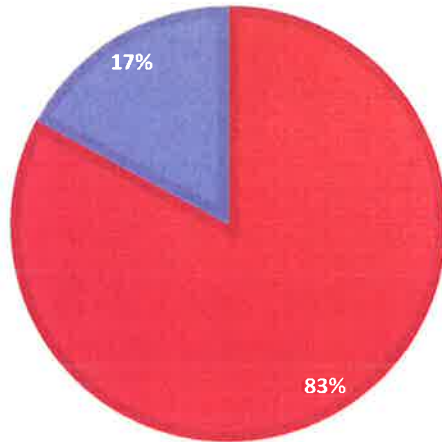

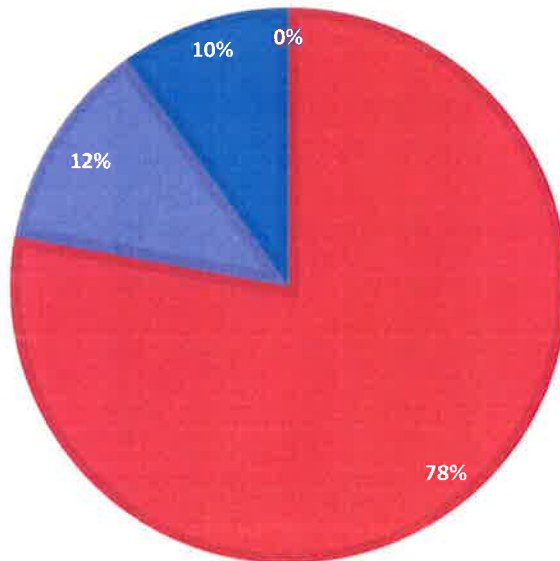
GENDER

■ Male ■ Female



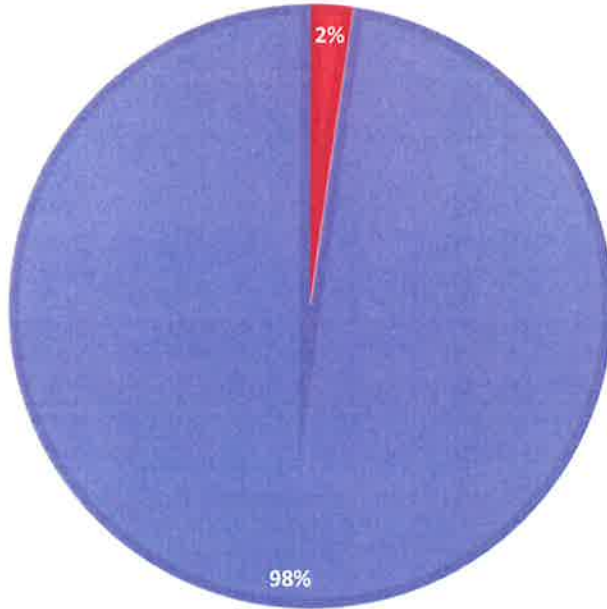
ETHNICITY

■ White ■ African Amer. ■ Hispanic ■ Other



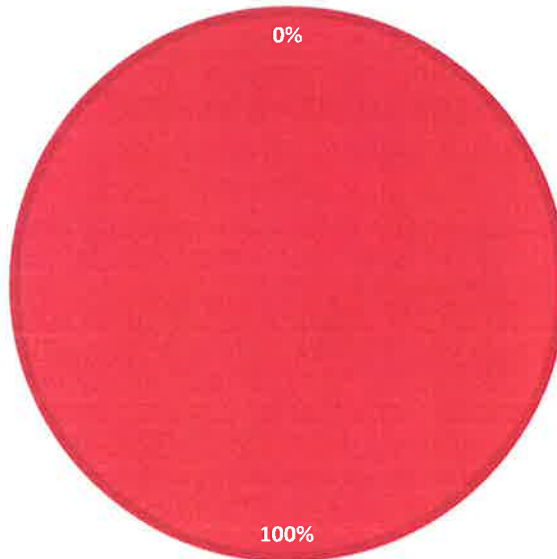
WEAPON USED?

■ Yes ■ No



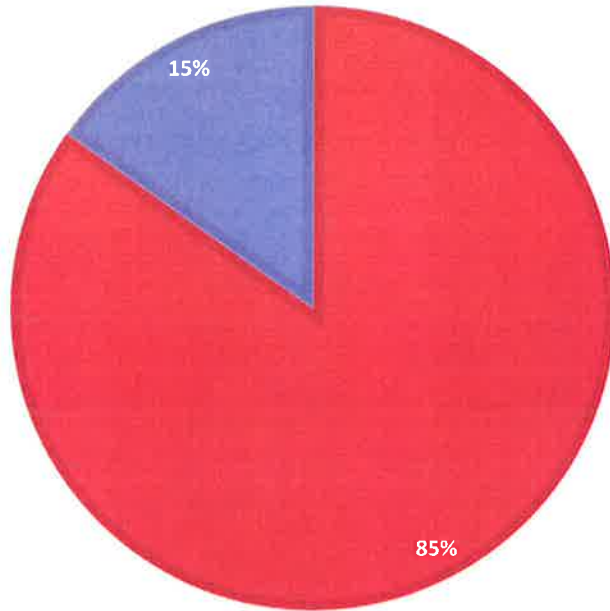
TYPE OF WEAPON USED

■ Gun ■ Knife



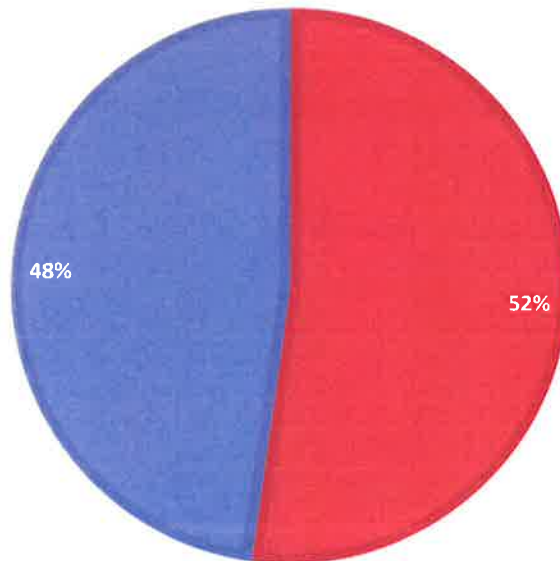
TYPE OF HOUSING
