**CALL TO ORDER:** Wisconsin Counties Utility Tax Association (WCUTA) President William Goehring called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER 7, 2022 MEETING:** Motion by Koch, second by Englebrecht, to approve the October 7, 2022 minutes as printed. Motion carried.

**COMMENTS BY THE PRESIDENT:** Mr. Goehring welcomed everyone to the meeting and said that this was the most important meeting of the year.

**FINANCIAL REPORT:** Mr. Goehring reviewed the financial report, no action was taken.

**GUEST SPEAKER KEVIN DOSPOY:** Mr. Dospoy spoke about the impact of inflation on county budgets, specifically how the annual consumer price index doesn't capture the entire impact to counties. Discussion followed.

**LOBBYIST REPORT:** George Klaetsch discussed the three options for the Legislative Priority.

- Option A: Ensure Continued Increases in Utility Aid & Monitor Budget to Defund Current Funding
- Option B: Propose Increase Mill Payment from 9 to 10 Mills
- Option C: Update/Revise "Incentive Aid" Portion of UA Payments. Discussion followed.

Motion by Engelbrecht, second by Polzer, to use Option C. Motion carried.
