Wehmeier said that it may be time to revisit holding something like the heroin summit that was held years back. Brantmeier brought up mental health concerns. No action taken.

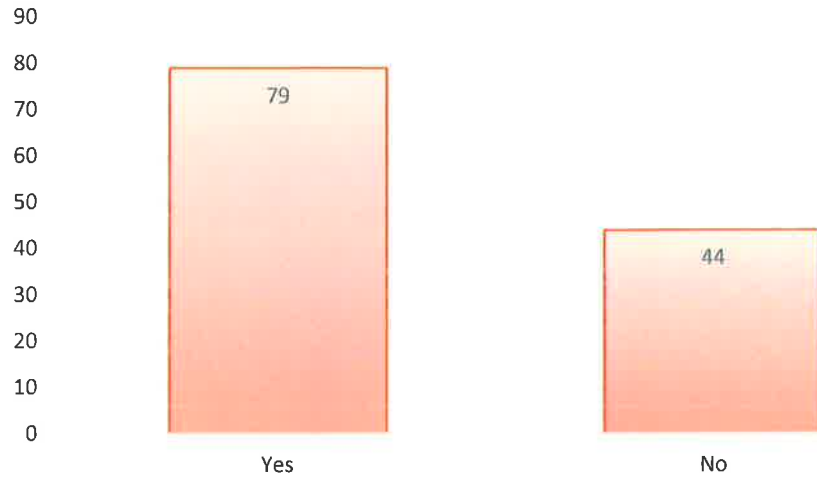

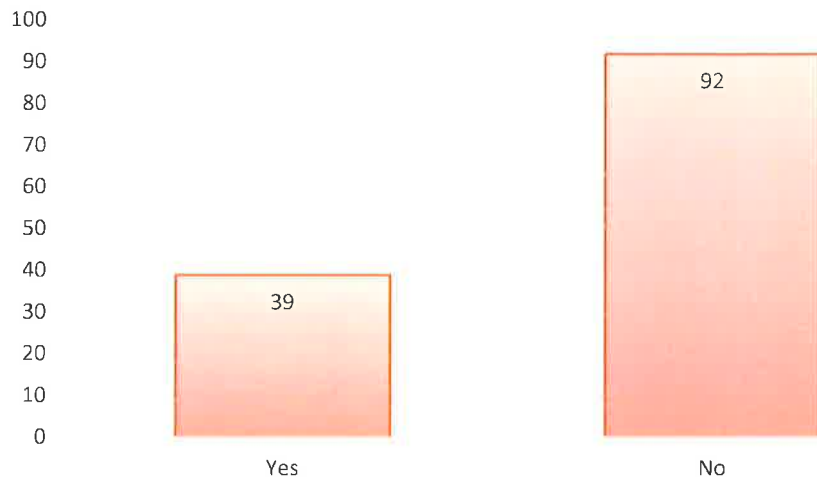
INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS



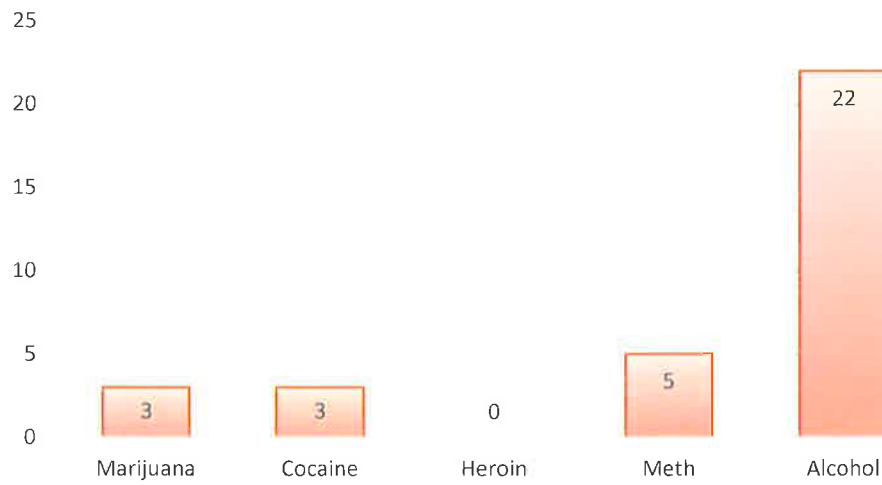
REASON FOR REINCARCERATION



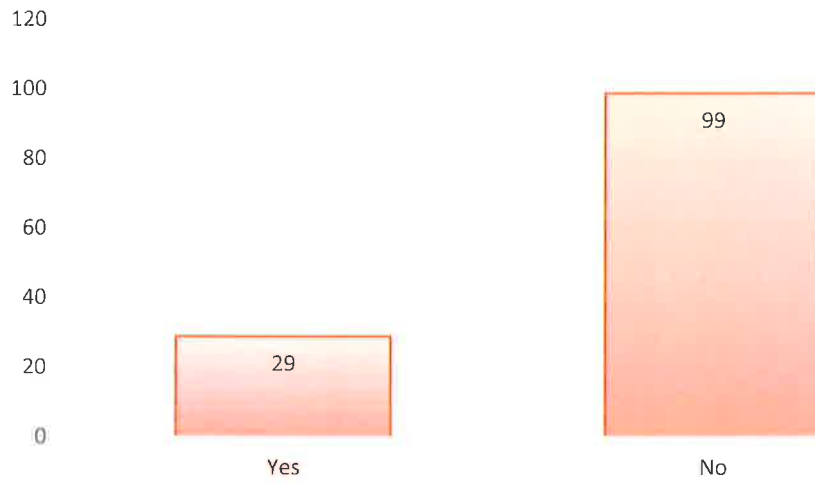
ALCOHOL OR DRUG RELATED?



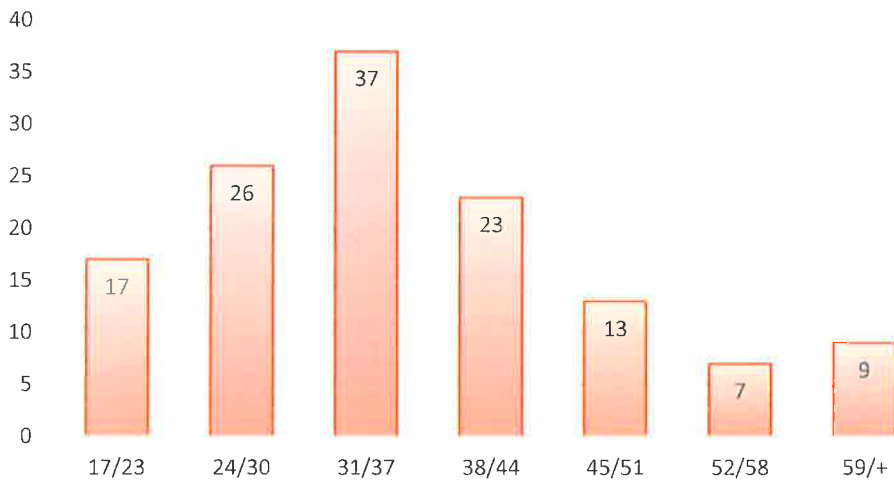
TYPE OF DRUG USED?



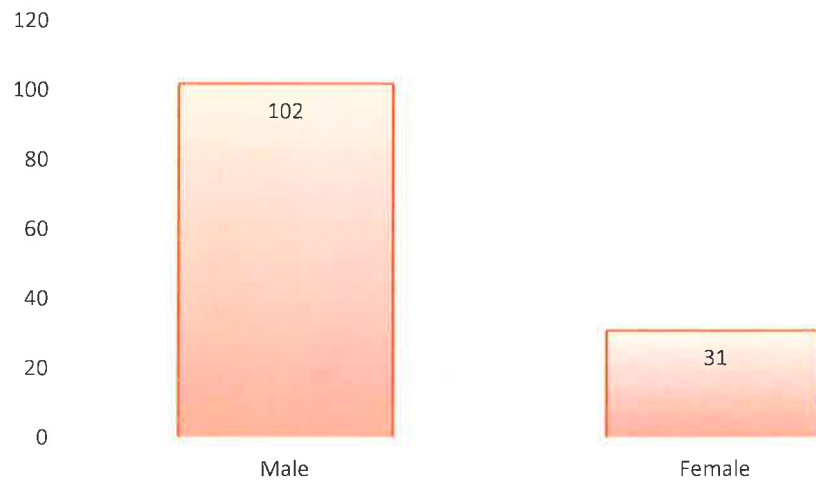
UNDER INFLUENCE AT BOOKING?



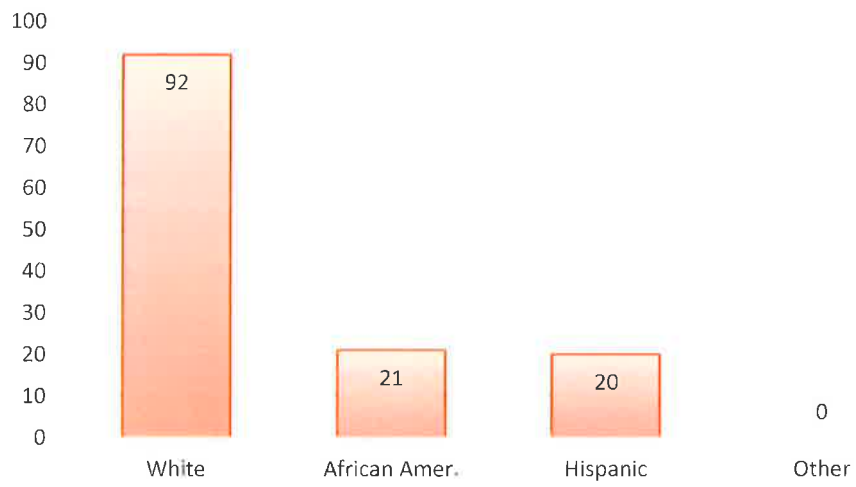

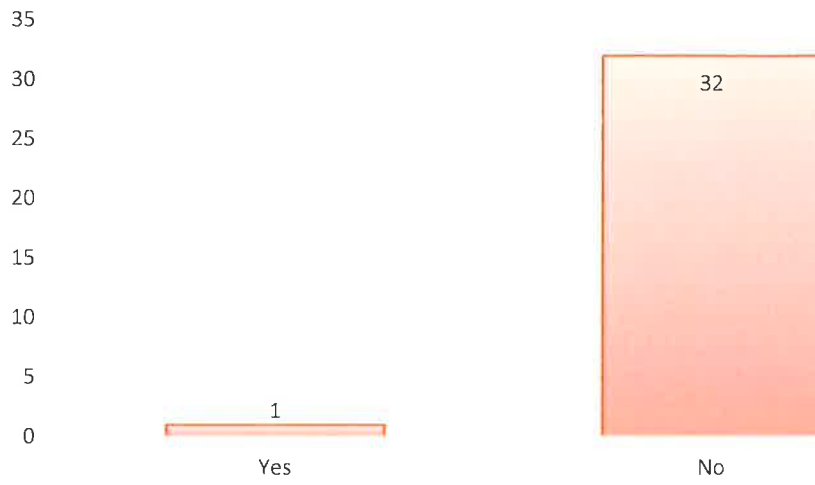

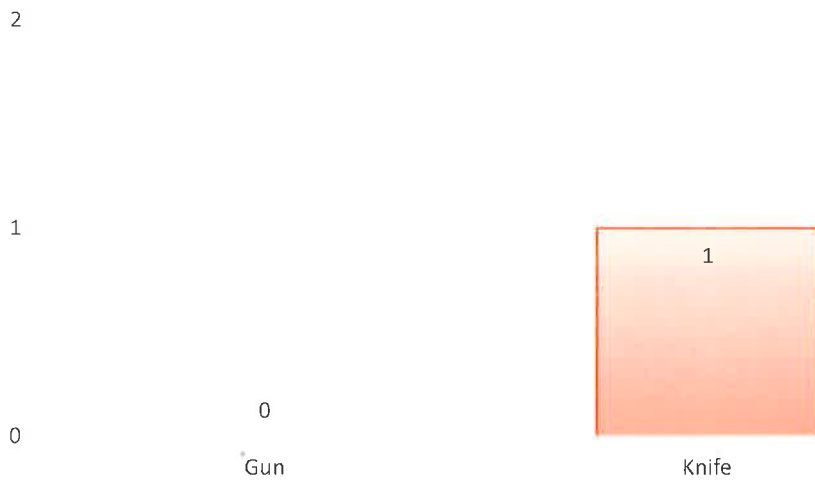

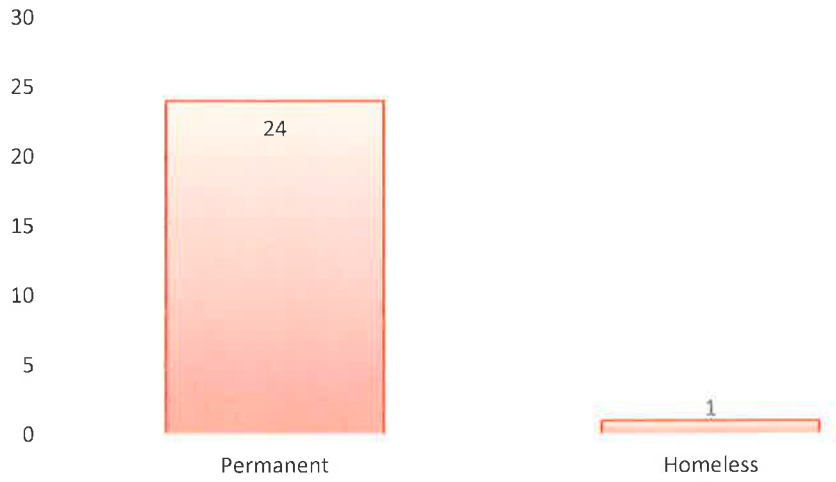
WEAPON USED?



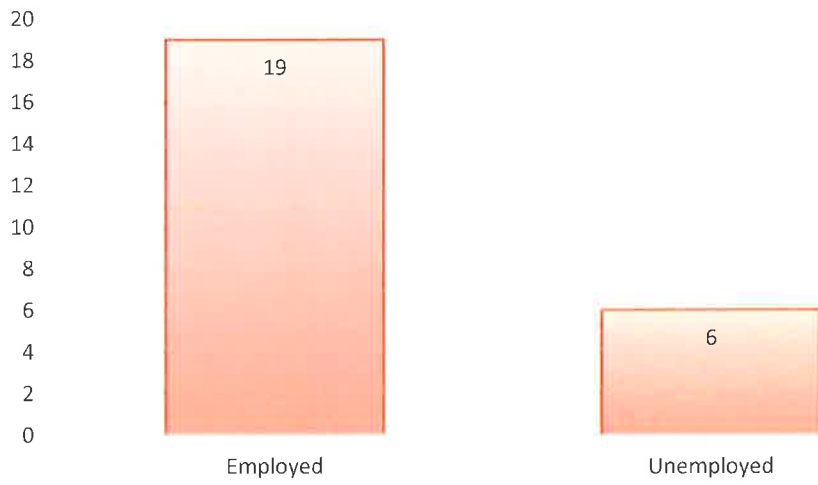
TYPE OF WEAPON USED



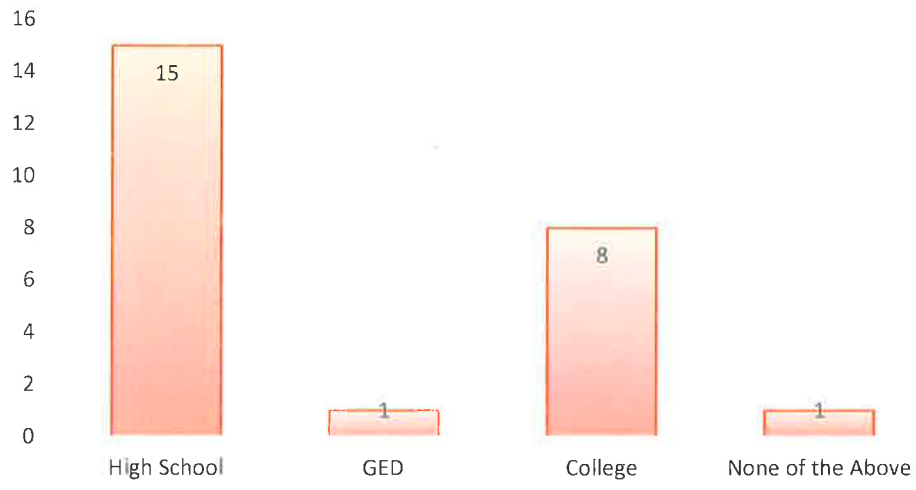
TYPE OF HOUSING (IF SENTENCED)



JOB STATUS (IF SENTENCED)

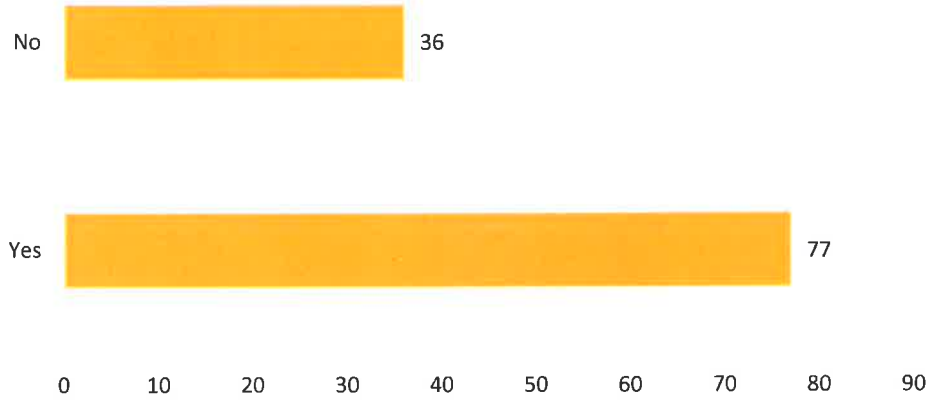


EDUCATION LEVEL (IF SENTENCED)

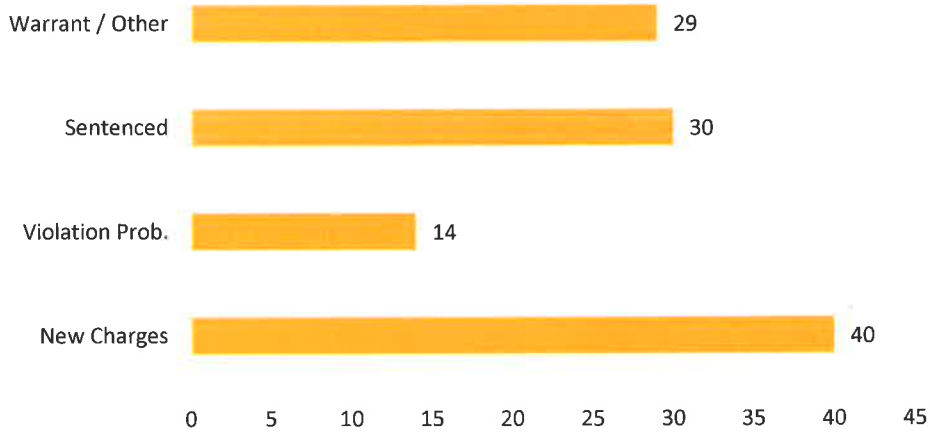


FEBRUARY 2023 REINCARCERATION GRAPHS

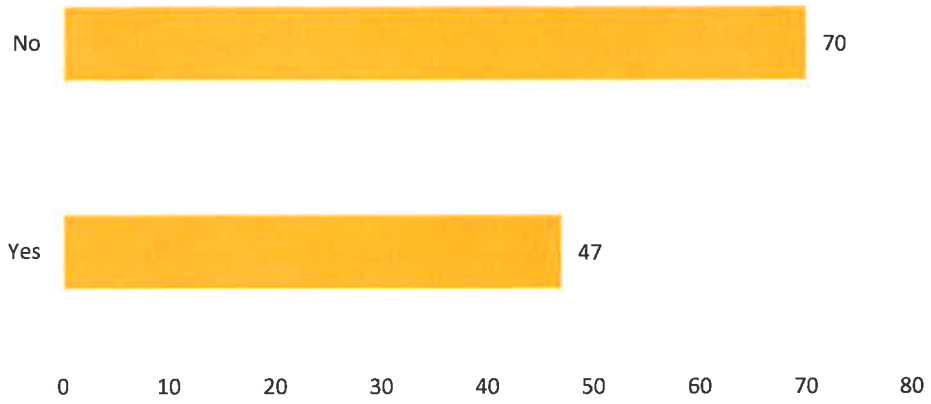
INCARCERATED WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS



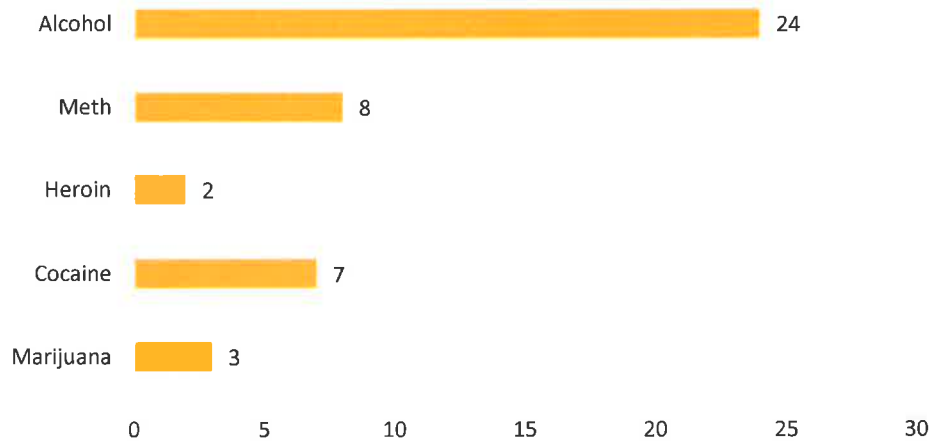
REASON FOR REINCARCERATION



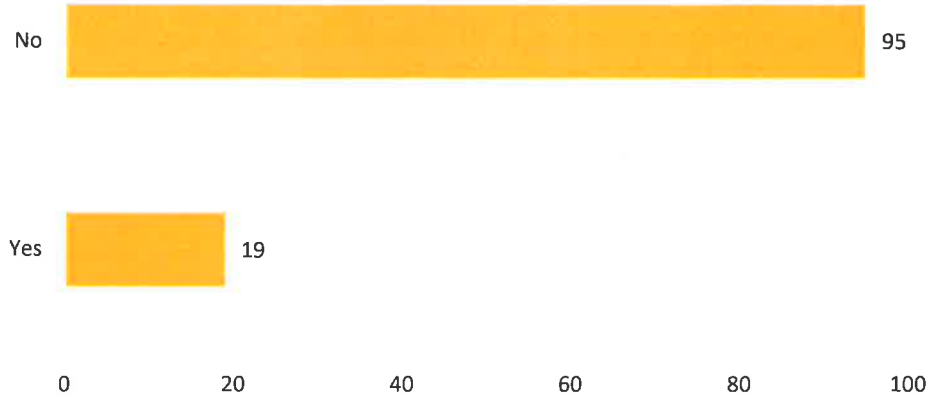
DRUGS USED?



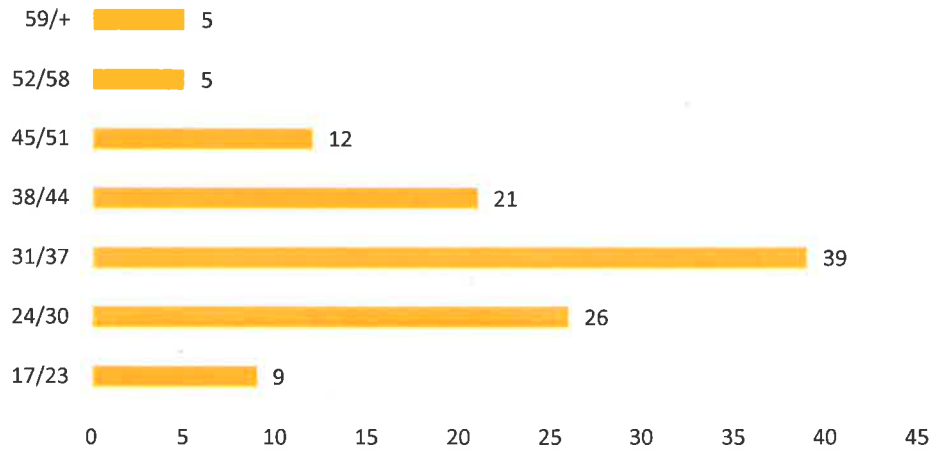
TYPE OF DRUG USED



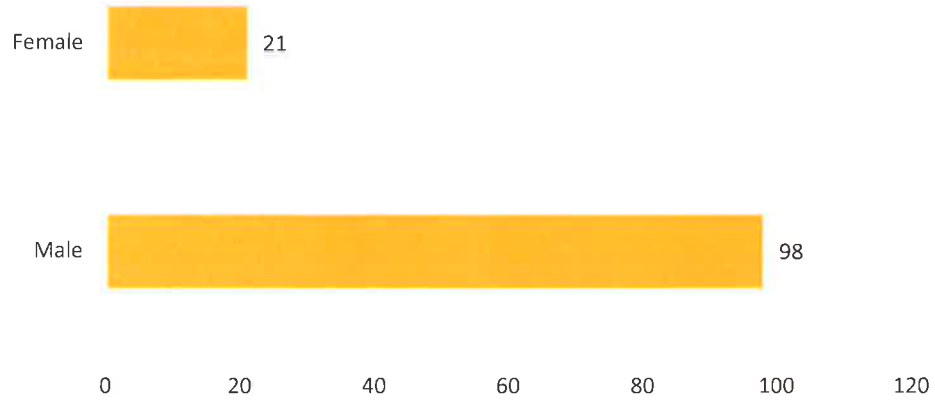

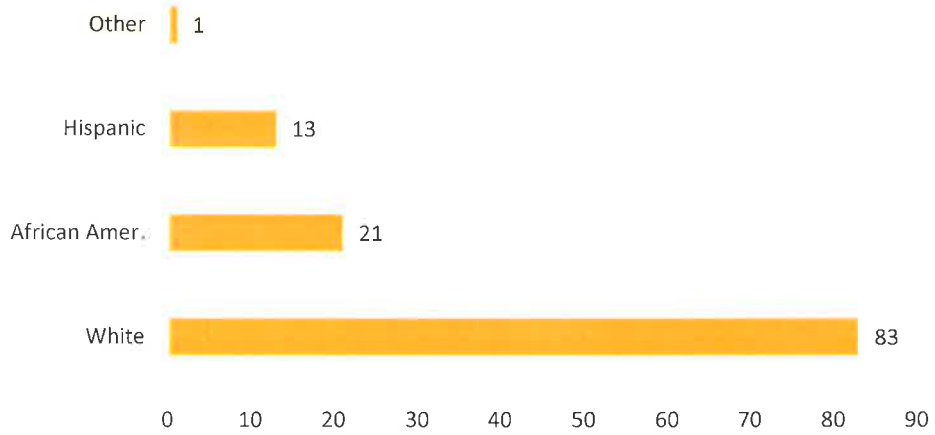

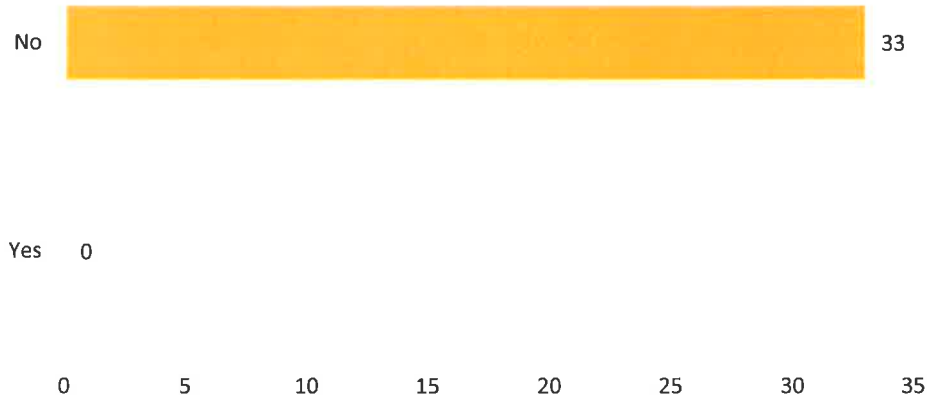

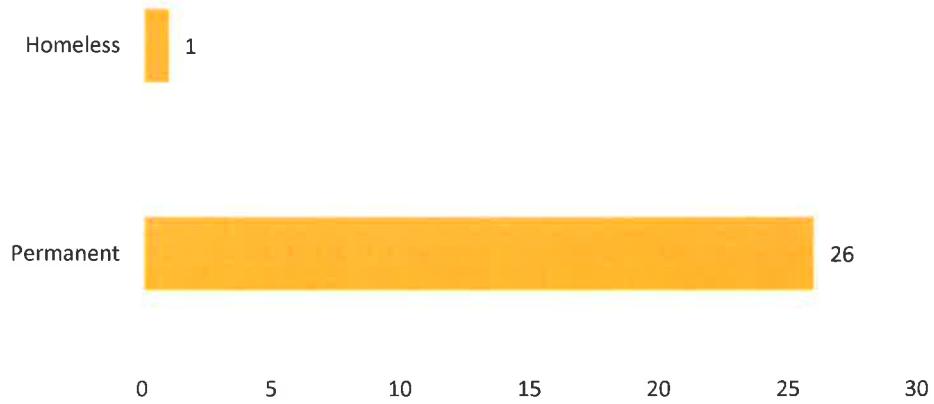

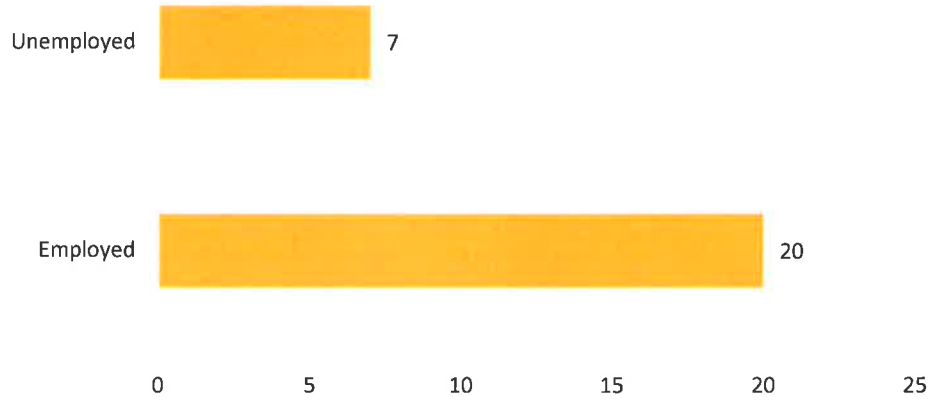
WEAPON USED (NEW CHARGES ONLY)?
