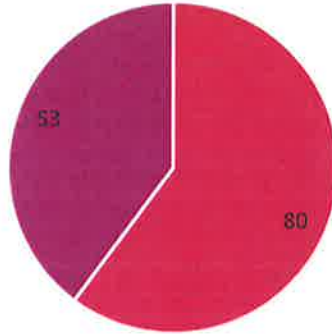

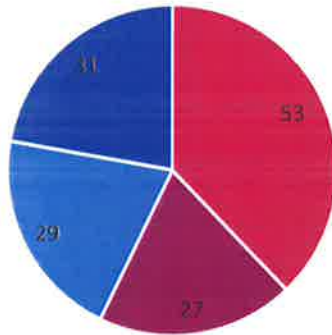
SEPTEMBER 2023 REINCARCERATION GRAPHS

INCARCERATED AT JESO WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS?



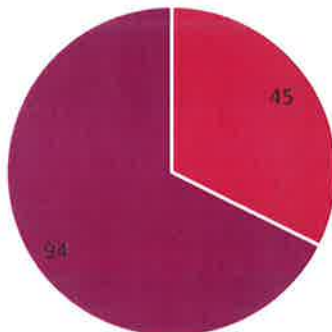

REASON FOR REINCARCERATION



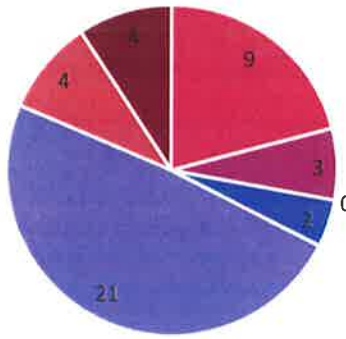

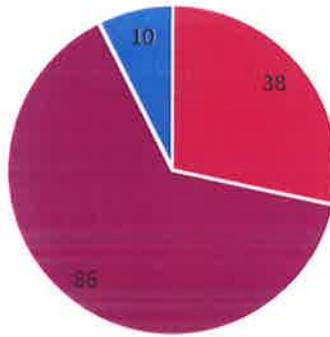

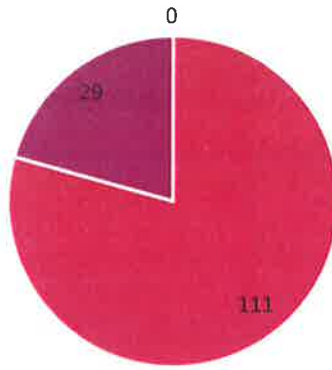

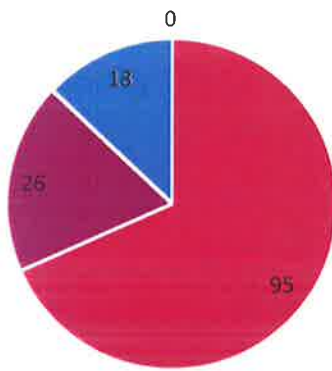

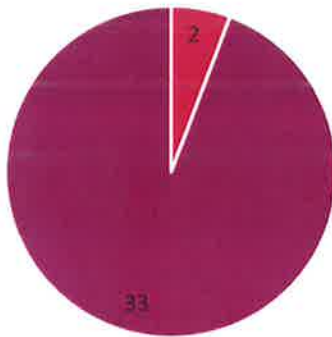

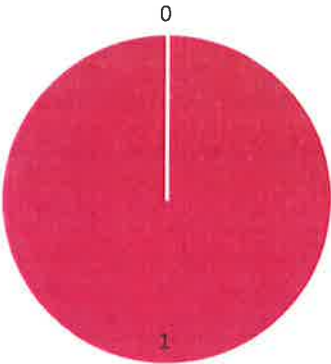

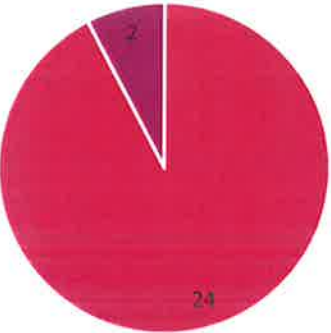

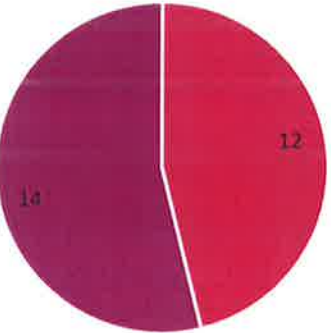

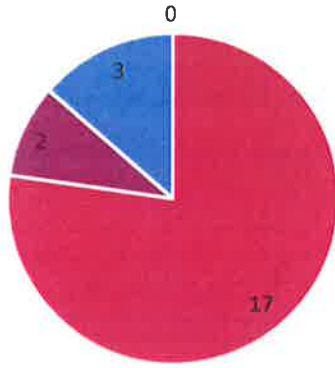

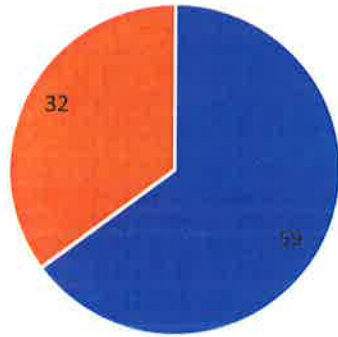

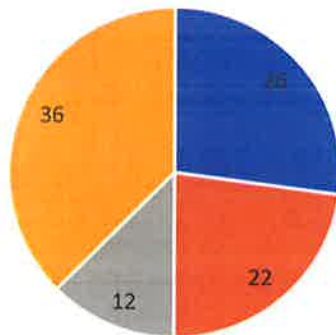
OCTOBER 2023 REINCARCERATION GRAPHS

INCARCERATED AT JESO WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS



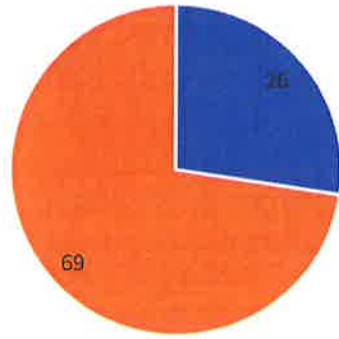

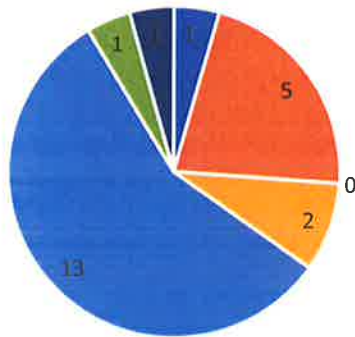

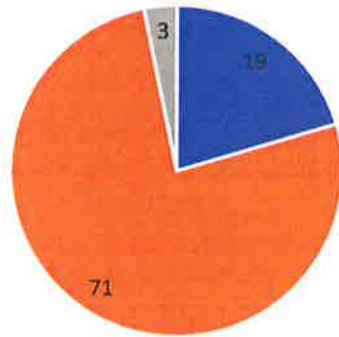

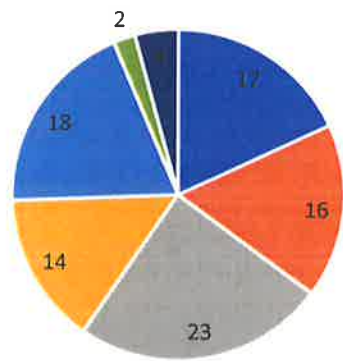

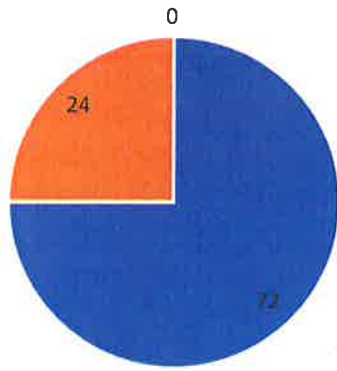

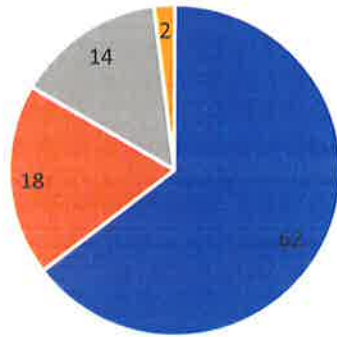

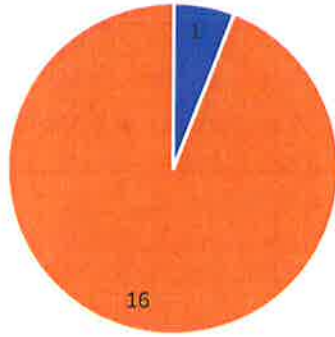

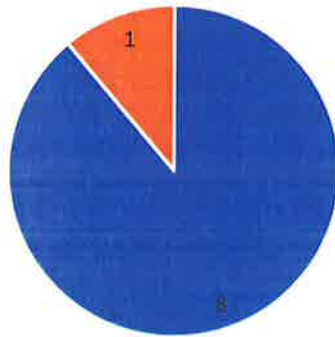

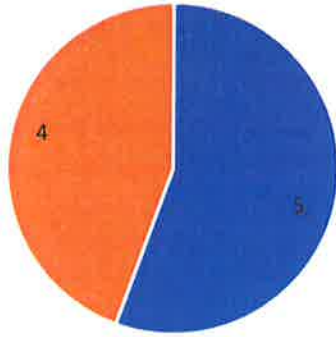

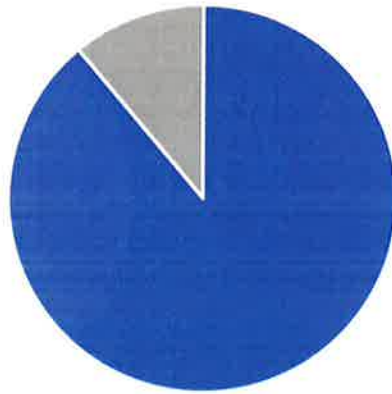
