CJCC Meeting 03/27/2024

1. Program Graduations

a. Alcohol Treatment Court will have two graduations on April 17th, 2024. All are welcomed to come observe the court hearing and enjoy a light snack to celebrate.

2. 2024 Goals and Objectives

a. The Treatment Court Team is actively reviewing the 2024 Goals and Objectives submitted to the State during the 2024 TAD application process for both treatment court programs to optimize funding provided by the State and match from Jefferson County.

3. Program/Policy Manuals

a. Under review by the Treatment Court Team to ensure continued alignment with State and National Best Practice Standards as well as ensuring readability for program participants.

4. Team Building/Training

- a. On 03/20/2024, the Treatment Court Team attended a team building luncheon over pizza where the only rule was no shop talk. It was very successful and conversations carried over into staffing. The team is looking to engage in another team building activity in the next couple of months to help combat compassion fatigue and foster group cohesion.
- b. The Treatment Court Team will attend the Statewide Treatment Court conference next month (April 24-26, 2024). Additionally, the team was selected to engage in a pre-conference training facilitated by the WI DOJ and National Center for State Courts wherein the focus will be on each team members role and how to maximize staffing cases ahead of treatment court hearings.





JANUARY 2024 REINCARCERATION GRAPHS


INCARCERATED AT JESO WITHIN LAST 3 YEARS




REASON FOR REINCARCERATION








TYPE OF DRUG(S) USED








HOUSING (SENTENCED INMATES ONLY)






INCARCERATED AT JESO WITHIN LAST 3 YRS?




REASON FOR INCARCERATION








TYPE OF DRUG(S) USED






