#### **Highway Operations Summary**

#### **Design Work**

• CTH D-Bark River Bridge (Ayres Associates): Scheduled for letting on April 8, 2025, with construction expected to begin no later than June 16, 2025. The contract allows for 80 working days.

#### **General Maintenance**

- Crews are engaged in sign maintenance, general bridge and guardrail repairs, and finalizing brushing and tree removal.
- Mechanics are preparing mowers for spring operations and dismantling some plow trucks.
- WisDOT DMA Contracts:
  - \$50,000 for shoulder work on STH 12 (from 26 to Cambridge).
  - \$95,100 for bridge deck sealing on various state-owned bridges.
  - \$82,500 for concrete patching on US 12 and STH 26.
- Crews have begun retrieving gravel shoulders.
- Crack sealing operations are set to commence next week.

#### **Town/City/Village Projects**

- Town of Aztalan
  - Town Hall parking lot improvements.
  - Miscellaneous ditching work.
  - Shoulder retrieval.
- Town of Jefferson
  - Cushman Road Overlay.
  - Switzke Road Pulverize and pave.
- Town of Farmington
  - Marsh Road Pulverize and pave (LRIP).
- Town of Palmyra
  - Tamarack Road Pulverize and pave (LRIP).
- Village of Johnson Creek
  - Linmar Lane Mill and overlay (LRIP).

#### **Office Updates**

- Accounting staff are finalizing 2024 financials and preparing the 2024 Financial Report.
- Bid Express was used for bid submissions on March 12, and the platform performed well; future use is planned.

- Hiring efforts are underway to fill vacancies: 5 Highway Workers and 2 Mechanics.
   Management positions are now fully staffed following the promotion of the last foreman from a Highway Worker role.
- Equipment training sessions are scheduled for March and April for select machinery.
- The Annual Safety Day is set for April 8, including hearing tests for all highway staff.

#### **Construction Projects**

- The 2025 construction schedule is in development.
- CTH D (US 18 to STH 106): Construction begins April 14, with expected completion by the end of June. Project updates have been shared via Facebook, the county website, and local newspapers.
- CTH D (STH 106 to STH 59): Work is scheduled to start after July 4 and conclude by the end of August.

#### **Equipment Updates**

- A new skid loader trailer has been received.
- Staff continue researching replacements for a semi/trailer and a sign truck.
- Four remaining quad-axle trucks are expected to arrive this spring.

#### **WisDOT Projects**

- 194 base patching and resurfacing work starting at Airport RD to the Dane County Line. Most of the work takes place at night starting in March and has a November 25<sup>th</sup> completion.
- STH 16 reconstruction Watertown to Ixonia. Work will begin Marc h17th and has an October 31st completion date.


