#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mr. Jones called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

#### 2. ROLL CALL/ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM

All present/Quorum was established.

#### 3. CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW

Mr. Ruehlow certified that we are in compliance.

#### 4. REVIEW OF SEPTEMBER 9, 2025 AGENDA

#### 5. PUBLIC COMMENTS

#### 6. APPROVAL OF AUGUST 12, 2025, BOARD MINUTES

Mr. Lund made a motion to approve August 12, 2025 board minutes.

Ms. Abrahamsen seconded.

Motion passed unanimously.

#### 7. COMMUNICATIONS

Mr. Ruehlow shared an article published in the Jefferson County Daily Union highlighting the Youth Justice Kickball event held last month. The event successfully brought together youth and key stakeholders to promote community engagement and relationship-building in a positive setting outside of the courtroom.

#### 8. REVIEW OF THE JULY 2025 FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Mr. Bellford reviewed the June financial statement (attached) and reported that we are projecting a positive year-end fund balance of \$820,312. This balance includes our carryover from 2024, including \$650,000 from our reserve carryover. We are, at this point, \$170,312 favorable to the budget when the reserve is excluded.

#### 9. DISCUSS AND APPROVE AUGUST 2025 VOUCHERS

Mr. Bellford reviewed the summary sheet of vouchers totaling \$765,660.15 (attached).

Mr. Wineke made a motion to approve the August 2025 vouchers totaling \$765,660.15.

Mr. Lund seconded.

Motion passed unanimously.

### 10. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON NEW 2025 PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACTS (CCS REGIONAL SERVICE ARRAY)

Mr. Ruehlow reported that we have three new service providers. (attached)

Mr. Jones made the motion to approve the contracts listed.

Ms. Callan seconded.

Motion passed unanimously.

### 11. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER AS "RECOVERY MONTH"

Ms. Abrahamsen made a motion to approve the proclamation recognizing September as Recovery Month.

Mr. Lund seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.

#### 12. DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON THE GIFT CARD PURCHASING PROCESS

Mr. Ruehlow presented the process for purchasing gift cards used as youth incentives. We have purchased from multiple parochial schools throughout the years. We also contacted public schools in the County to determine if they provide them. These purchases have been made with State grant dollars.

Mr. Jones made a motion to approve the current purchasing process and continue using the guidelines as presented.

Mr. Lund seconded.

Motion passed unanimously.

### 13. PRESENTATION ON THE SUGGESTED HUMAN SERVICES REMODEL PROJECT TO SATISFY SPACE AND SAFETY CONCERNS

Mr. Bellford presented an overview of a proposed remodel of the Human Services office space. The project aims to address space limitations and safety concerns for both staff and clients. No formal action was taken. The presentation was informational only.

#### 14. DIRECTORS REPORT

Mr. Ruehlow reported on the following items:

- Both Mr. Ruehlow and Mr. Bellford presented the Human Services 2026 Budget last month to the Finance Committee.
- Provided and updated on the Safe Space Grant discussed in the previous board meeting.
   Although the board had ultimately supported postponing the grant, it was later brought before the County Board, where it was voted by the majority to postpone the grant indefinitely with the idea that Mr. Ruehlow would work with the group of youth to find an alternative partner to carry out the grant.
  - He noted that he was approached by an organization in Fort Atkinson, Heart of the City, as well as by Pastor Sara Rabe from First Congregational UCC Church in Fort Atkinson. Following a discussion and a vote by the youth, the decision was made to begin working with the First Congregational Church. The group is currently waiting for the church council's decision on whether to move forward with the partnership.
- Kim Propp, our Emergency Mental Health (EMH) Supervisor, serves on the Jefferson County Suicide Prevention Committee. This weekend, the committee is hosting the Path for Hope Color Run/Walk at Brandt-Quirk Park in Watertown. All proceeds from the event will support suicide prevention and awareness initiatives throughout Jefferson County.
- Mr. Jones announced that he will not be running for an additional term as a County Board Supervisor. His term on the Human Services Board expires November 1, 2025. The October Board meeting will be his last meeting.

#### 15. ADJOURN

Mr. Racanelli made a motion to adjourn the meeting.

# Financial Statement Summary August, 2025

We are projecting a positive year-end fund balance of \$736,811. This balance includes our carryover from 2024, including \$650,000 from our reserve carryover. We are, at this point, \$86,811 favorable to the budget when the reserve is excluded.

#### **Summary of Variances:**

- CCS continues to be understaffed compared to the budget, so more services are contracted out. We are projecting \$6,851,716 in total CCS expenses, compared to budgeted costs of \$7,370,684. This includes \$4,166,937 in staffing (wages, salary, fringe, overhead, and MD costs) compared to a budget of \$5,633,434. However, our contract costs are projected to be \$2,644,885 compared to a budget of \$1,700,000. Because of this, our revenue from MA is projected to be \$4,952,702, compared to a budget of \$5,899,019, while our WIMCR settlement is projected to be \$2,500,000 compared to a budget of \$2,150,041.
- Hospital/Detox is projected to be over budget (unfavorable) by \$78,844 (Net basis). This is dramatic turn from even just one month ago.

In 2023, our hospitalization net balance was (\$879,913). In 2024, our hospitalization net balance was (\$679,057). The July 2025 State Institute bill was \$95,943. The August 2025 State Institute bill was \$168,545. That is the highest single month charge since at least 2020.

- The Nutrition Programs are projected to have a combined \$44,170 unfavorable balance. This is mostly because the Nutrition Supervisor position has been vacant since July 7. The new Supervisor started on September 8. GWAAR did also provide for an opportunity to re-obligate unspent funds from other counties for 2025. We did put in for our submission, but we have not heard back.
- CLTS revenue is projected to be under budget by \$173,043. CLTS expenses are projected to be under budget by \$188,368.
- Children Alternate Care expenses are projected to be over budget by \$75,203. This projection includes Shelter and Detention costs and excludes kinship care. Kinship is included in the alternate care summary (attached), and it will be fully funded by DCF. We did decrease our alternate care budget by \$107,355 2025 when compared to 2024. The last few years of alternate care budgets are shown below.

We do have a number of high-cost placements currently. One Group Home placement did move to a Level 5 foster home, which is high-cost, but also funded, in part, by CLTS. We did have our fist Shelter placement of the year in August 2025. Additionally, we have a new Group Home placement. We also had a lenghlty detention stay starting in August that went into September. So, going forward, we will have several high-cost placements (at least 2 group homes, 1 RCC, 1 Shelter, and 1 Level 5 foster home).

- CSP is projected to be unfavorable to the budget on a net basis of \$207,591. Expenses are projected to be under budget because of vacant positions; however, revenue is projected to under significantly under budget. While we have billed several months of 2025, the billing has not increased as much as anticipated when we did our budget. We have adjusted CSP revenue in our 2026 budget.
- Outpatient Clinic Revenue (insurance, Medicare, and MA) is projected to be \$261,774 underbudget. Clinic revenue has been increasing approximately 15-20% each year for the past several years. However, it has stagnated this year for a few factors, including several vacant positions and several new staff (which take time to credential before insurance will pay us).

- Capital Projects are projected to be \$266,939 underbudget, because the preschool renovation and Lueder House repairs are coming in under budget at this point. Additionally, the appx. \$266,939 we had for lobby renovations will not be used in 2025.
- **Operating Reserve:** We are projecting a year-end balance of \$650,000 in the operating reserve this year.

**BEHAVIOR HEALTH DIVISION:** Projected unfavorable balance of \$511,223, because of increasing hospitalizations and decreasing CSP and Clinic revenue.

**CHILDREN & FAMILY DIVISION:** Projected favorable balance of \$334,003. Alternate care costs are over budget; however, staffing costs for several teams are under budget. Those teams do not typically have revenue offsets.

**ECONOMIC SUPPORT DIVISION:** Projected favorable balance of \$27,283. These programs are right in-line with the budget currently.

**AGING & ADRC DIVISION:** Projected unfavorable balance of \$11,043.

**ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION:** Projected favorable balance of \$247,790, because of capital projects.

**OPERATING RESERVE:** Projected favorable balance of \$650,000.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-xx**

### Authorizing state human services contracts, consortium agreements, and professional service and care provider contracts

#### **Executive Summary**

The Jefferson County Human Services Department contracts with state agencies, consortiums and in excess of 200 professional service and care providers to fulfill its statutory duties. Each year contracts are renewed and/or updated with additional providers. State law requires County Board approval of the state contracts set forth in this resolution. The contracts have not been reproduced and attached to this resolution because they total more than 100 pages. The Wisconsin County Human Service Association negotiates the basic agreements on behalf of the counties which are standard state forms and are not subject to negotiation by individual counties. The professional service and care provider contract list for 2026 is attached. These provider contracts are reviewed by the Jefferson County Corporation Counsel to ensure compliance with the County's Purchasing Ordinance, and contain the language and terms set forth by the State of Wisconsin Department of Health Services Purchase of Care Services Guide and section 46.036 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The Human Services Board considered this resolution at its October 14, 2025, meeting and recommended forwarding to the County Board to approve entering into professional service and care provider contracts with the providers on the attached list and entering into state contracts and consortium agreements as set forth below for 2026.

WHEREAS, the executive summary is incorporated into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Human Services Department contracts with several different state agencies, consortiums, and in excess of 200 professional service providers and care providers to fulfill its statutory duties, usually on an annual basis, as approved by the Human Services Board, and

WHEREAS, the Social Services & Community Programs contracts with the Department of Health Services, and the Department of Children and Families and Youth Aids Program contracts, are statutorily required to be approved by the County Board, and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Board recommends approval of the Social Services & Community Programs, including the Children's Long Term Support program, and State Targeted Response contracts with the Department of Health Services in the anticipated amount of \$3,074,518; the Youth Crisis Stabilization Facility Mental Health Block Grant Award with the Department of Health Services in the amount of \$440,934 for the federal fiscal year of October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026; the Aging and Disability Resources contract, which includes additional amounts for Medicare Improvements for Patients and Providers, the State Health Insurance Assistance Program, and the State Pharmaceutical Assistance Program in the anticipated amount of \$643,475; the Department of Children and Families State County Child Welfare contract, which includes the Youth Aids Program contract and the Parents Supporting Parents contract, in the anticipated amount of \$2,657,389; the Older American Programs contract in the anticipated amount of \$413,631; the Department of Transportation contracts pursuant to section 85.21 of the Wisconsin Statutes (county

elderly and disabled transportation assistance), and section 49 USC 5310 (transportation services provided to older adults and people with disabilities), in the anticipated amount of \$318,350; the Department of Health Services Division of Long Term Care contract in the anticipated amount of \$625,097; the Intensive Outpatient Program contract with the Department of Corrections in the anticipated amount of \$33,072 per year for the state fiscal year of July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027; and other contracts from the Department of Children and Families, including the Child Care contract in the anticipated amount of \$141,812, , the Citizen's Review Panel contract for the state fiscal year of July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027 in the anticipated amount of \$10,000, the Foster Parent Incentives contract for the state fiscal year July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027 in the anticipated amount of \$5,794, and

WHEREAS, the consortium agreement requires County Board approval for the State and Federal Income Maintenance Programs through Southern Consortium in the anticipated amount of \$1,580,515.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Human Services Director or the Administrative Services Division Manager is authorized to execute the state contracts and consortium contract set forth above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Services Director or the Administrative Services Manager is authorized to sign addendums or revisions to said contracts during the course of the year as necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Services Director or Administrative Services Manager is authorized to sign all other contracts with state agencies and consortiums pursuant to section 46.23(6m)(c) of the Wisconsin Statutes, and all professional services and care provider contracts as approved by the Human Services Board in accordance with the Jefferson County Purchasing Ordinance.

Fiscal Note: The costs associated with these state and consortium contracts have been included as an appropriation in the 2026 budget.

# Jefferson County has an 85.21 Annual Allocation of \$228,147 from WisDOT based on our county population size.

We are proposing 7 Transportation Projects for 2026:

- 1) Driver Escort / Volunteer Program The driver escort program offers transportation services for citizens over 60 and individuals living with disabilities for medical appointments, grocery shopping, and errands, with standard 7AM-5PM operating hours.
- 2) Senior Dining Transportation Program Congregate Senior Dining Program participants can use discounted public transportation from the Senior Center in Watertown or Fort Atkinson, with local taxi service contracted for Jefferson and Lake Mills.

### 2026 Projects Continued:

- 3) Later Weekday Evenings & Weekend Service Hours this project will provide extended hours / days for our normal transportation program.
- 4) Day Trip Project this project offers monthly trips for seniors and disabled individuals to explore unique places and popular attractions within an hour's drive of Jefferson County.
- 5) Shopping Van Service this project offers twice-weekly transportation service for seniors and individuals living with disabilities to Jefferson for shopping at popular locations.

### 2026 Projects Continued:

- 6) 3rd Party Wheelchair Accessible Transportation This project provides rides across municipal boundaries to older adults (over 60 years of age) and persons with disabilities (any age) requiring access to medical care in another community, when there is no volunteer or paid staff available to provide this transportation..
- 7) Public Taxi Transportation Program Individuals who are approved by our copay waiver program and need medical transportation within the same city are eligible to use public transportation that is secured by Jefferson County Human Services. The local Taxi service is contracted for providing transportation in Fort Atkinson, Jefferson, Lake Mills, and Watertown.

### 2026 Projects - Funding Breakdown

### **Funding Sources:**

- Jefferson County has an 85.21 Annual Allocation of \$228, 147 from WisDOT based on our county population size.
- 2. The proposed 2026 Transportation Budget for Jefferson County is \$222,507.
- 3. We will use \$90,203 of 53.10 (Mobility Manager) Grant funds for these projects.
- 4. We estimate that we will collect \$25,000 of Passenger Revenue
- > A total amount of \$607,020 would be available to fund the 7 transportation projects.
