### 2. Community Services and Prevention

a. **Health Dept Initiatives**: McGeary gave recap of "Tall Cop" presentation – well attended, informative, noting loopholes, major risks, and what use has increased in youths.

b. **Financial Empowerment Center**: Nunez presented a summary of the FEC program as it passed its 6-month mark, noting a positive reception from the community.
