Authorize Highway Department to Purchase Asphalt Rollers

Executive Summary

The Jefferson County Highway Department is requesting approval to purchase three new asphalt rollers to replace the department's aging fleet of three existing rollers, which have collectively exceeded their reliable service life. The current equipment includes one 1992 model that lacks rollover protection and two 2010 models that are increasingly experiencing electrical and mechanical failures. These issues present ongoing safety concerns and contribute to downtime during critical paving operations.

The acquisition of new asphalt rollers will significantly enhance the department's ability to safely and efficiently perform roadway maintenance and construction. Modern equipment will reduce the risk of operator injury, minimize mechanical interruptions, and support consistent, high quality asphalt compaction essential for long lasting pavement.

This purchase aligns with the County's strategic goals of maintaining safe, reliable transportation infrastructure and ensuring the safety of county staff and the traveling public. The procurement process followed the County's purchasing ordinance and competitive bid requirements. Bids for the new asphalt rollers were received on Wednesday, May 20, 2026, at 10:00 a.m.

Approval of this resolution supports continued investment in dependable, modern equipment necessary for efficient service delivery and responsible stewardship of County roadway assets. This resolution was reviewed and recommended for approval or denial by the Highway Committee on June 2, 2026.

**Approving Changes to the Rural Functional Classification
System in Jefferson County, WI**

Executive Summary

This resolution approves updates to the functional classification of certain roadways within the county as recommended by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT). Functional classification is the process by which public roads are categorized based on the type of service they provide, such as mobility, traffic volume, and access to adjacent land.

WisDOT periodically reviews and adjusts these classifications to reflect changes in traffic patterns, land use, and roadway function. The proposed updates align the county's roadway network with current conditions and statewide planning standards. Adoption of these changes ensures consistency with state and federal transportation systems and supports eligibility for certain types of state and federal transportation funding.

This resolution approves the recommended changes to the functional classifications of certain Jefferson County roadways. The Highway Committee considered this resolution at its meeting on 06/02/2026 and recommended forwarding it on to the County Board for approval.

WHEREAS, the Executive Summary is incorporated into this resolution; and

WHEREAS, functional classification categorizes roads and streets based on the level of mobility and access they provide; and

WHEREAS, functional classification impacts eligibility for state and federal transportation funding; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in coordination with local officials, has reviewed and recommended updates to the functional classification system within Jefferson County; and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Highway Committee has reviewed and supports the recommended changes; and

WHEREAS, maps and documentation of the proposed functional classification updates are attached and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, WisDOT will submit the locally approved changes to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for final approval;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that Jefferson County Board hereby approves the recommended functional classifications as set forth in the attached.

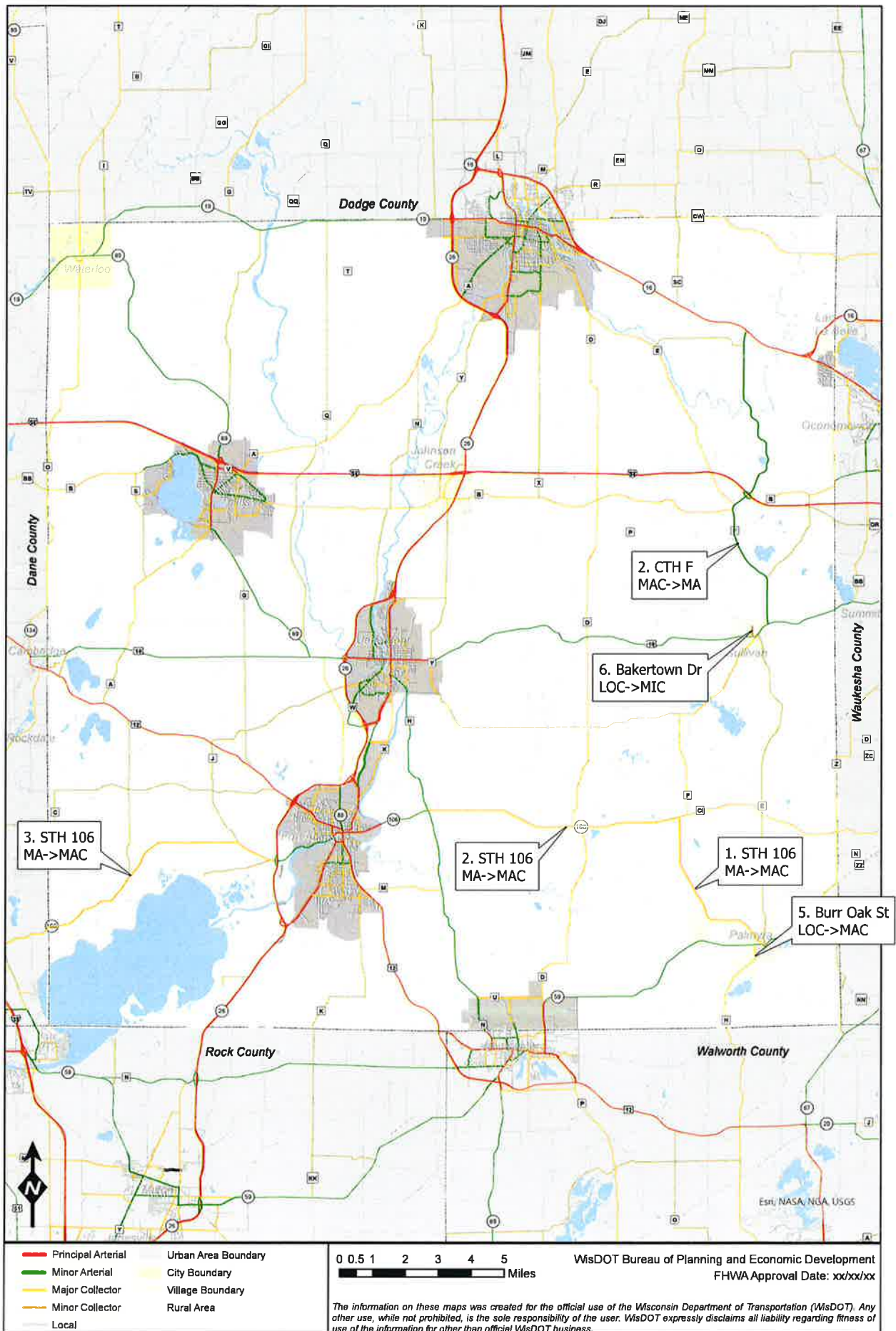

ORDINANCE NO. 2026

Amending Jefferson County Ordinance Section 20-51 "Speed Zone on County Trunk Highways" to Establish Speed Limit on Business 26 (North and South Business 26 Fort Atkinson)

Executive Summary

Following the transfer of North and South Business 26 near the City of Fort Atkinson from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to Jefferson County jurisdiction, it was identified that a county traffic ordinance was never formally adopted establishing an enforceable speed limit for the roadway.

The route is currently posted at forty-five (45) miles per hour and has historically operated at that speed limit. In order to ensure the posted speed limit is legally enforceable under Jefferson County authority, the Highway Department is recommending adoption of a new traffic ordinance formally establishing the speed limit at 45 mph for the entirety of North and South Business 26 under county jurisdiction.

The proposed ordinance formalizes the current speed limit within the Jefferson County Traffic Ordinance following the jurisdictional transfer from WisDOT to Jefferson County. This action will provide consistency in enforcement and ensure compliance with applicable state and local traffic regulations. Following review and discussion, the Highway Committee approved this recommendation at its June 2, 2026 meeting.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY DOES
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 20-51 of the Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (Speed Zones on County Trunk Highways) is amended to include the following:

(68) Business 26, Town of Jefferson and Koshkonong, Jefferson County: Forty Five (45) miles per hour for all vehicles from the State Highway 26 ramps south to the intersection of County Trunk Highway K.

(69) Business 26, Town of Koshkonong and City of Fort Atkinson, Jefferson County: Forty Five (45) miles per hour for all vehicles from the intersection of Hackbarth Road south to State Highway 26 ramps.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage, publication and erection of official signs.

Fiscal Note: Funds for the sign relocations will come from the Highway Department General Maintenance Account No. 53311.

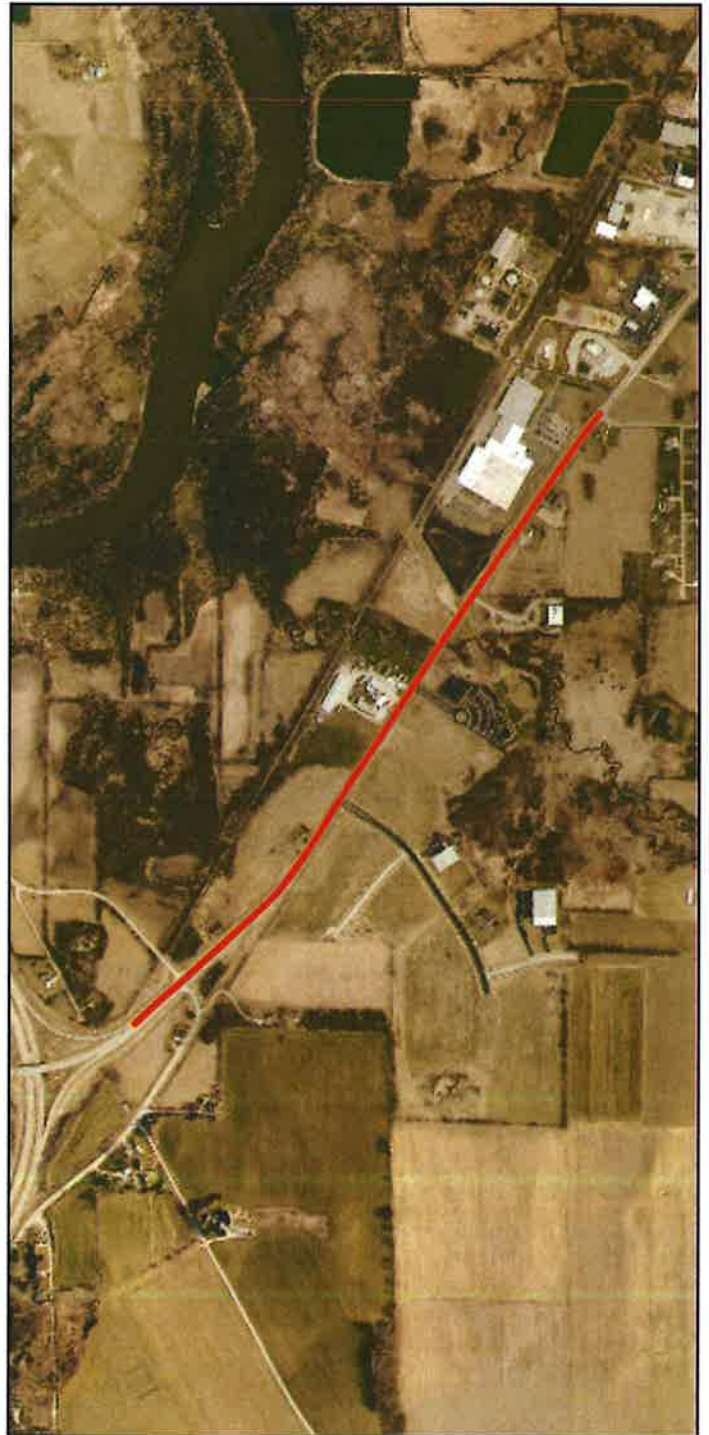
Business 26 - City of Fort Atkinson, WI



North Business 26

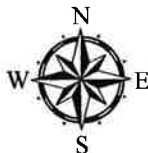


South Business 26

ORDINANCE NO. 2026

Amending Jefferson County Ordinance Section 20-51 “Speed Zones on County Trunk Highways” to Extend Reduced Speed Zone on County Trunk Highway N (Unincorporated Village of Coldspring)

Executive Summary

The Jefferson County Highway Department has evaluated traffic conditions and safety concerns along CTH N within the unincorporated Village of Cold Spring. The current ordinance establishes a 40-mph speed zone from the intersection of Carnes Road north to the intersection of Gillis Road.

A review of roadway geometry, traffic patterns, and field conditions determined that the existing speed zone limits begin within horizontal curve sections. This placement limits driver visibility and does not provide adequate distance for motorists to recognize and respond to posted speed limit changes prior to entering the reduced-speed area.

To improve safety and provide a more appropriate transition into the Village area, the Highway Department recommended extending the limits of the reduced speed zone. Following review and discussion, the Highway Committee approved this recommendation at its June 2, 2026, meeting.

The proposed amendment revises the ordinance to establish a 40-mph speed zone on CTH N beginning 1,000 feet south of the intersection with Carnes Road and extending northerly to a point 500 feet north of the intersection with Gillis Road.

This adjustment is intended to enhance driver awareness, improve compliance with posted speed limits, and increase overall roadway safety within the corridor.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 20-51 of the Jefferson County Code of Ordinances (“Speed Zones on County Trunk Highways”) is amended as follows to include the following:

(45) County Trunk Highway N, unincorporated Village of Cold Spring, Jefferson County:
40 miles per hour for all vehicles from its intersection with Carnes Road a point one thousand (1,000) feet south of its intersection with Carnes Road, thence northerly to its intersection with Gillis Road a point five hundred (500) feet north of its intersection with Gillis Road.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage, publication and erection of official signs.

Fiscal Note: Funds for the sign relocations will come from the Highway Department General Maintenance Account No. 53311.

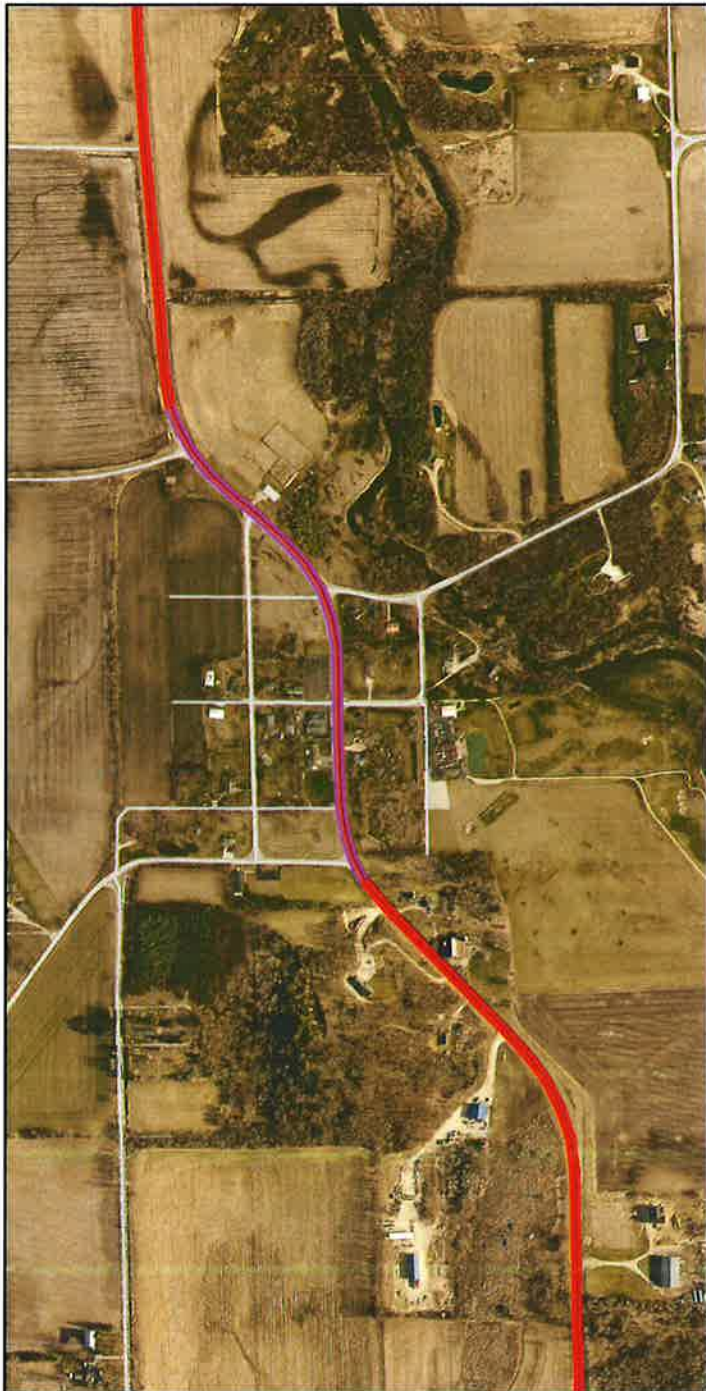


SPEED LIMIT CHANGE

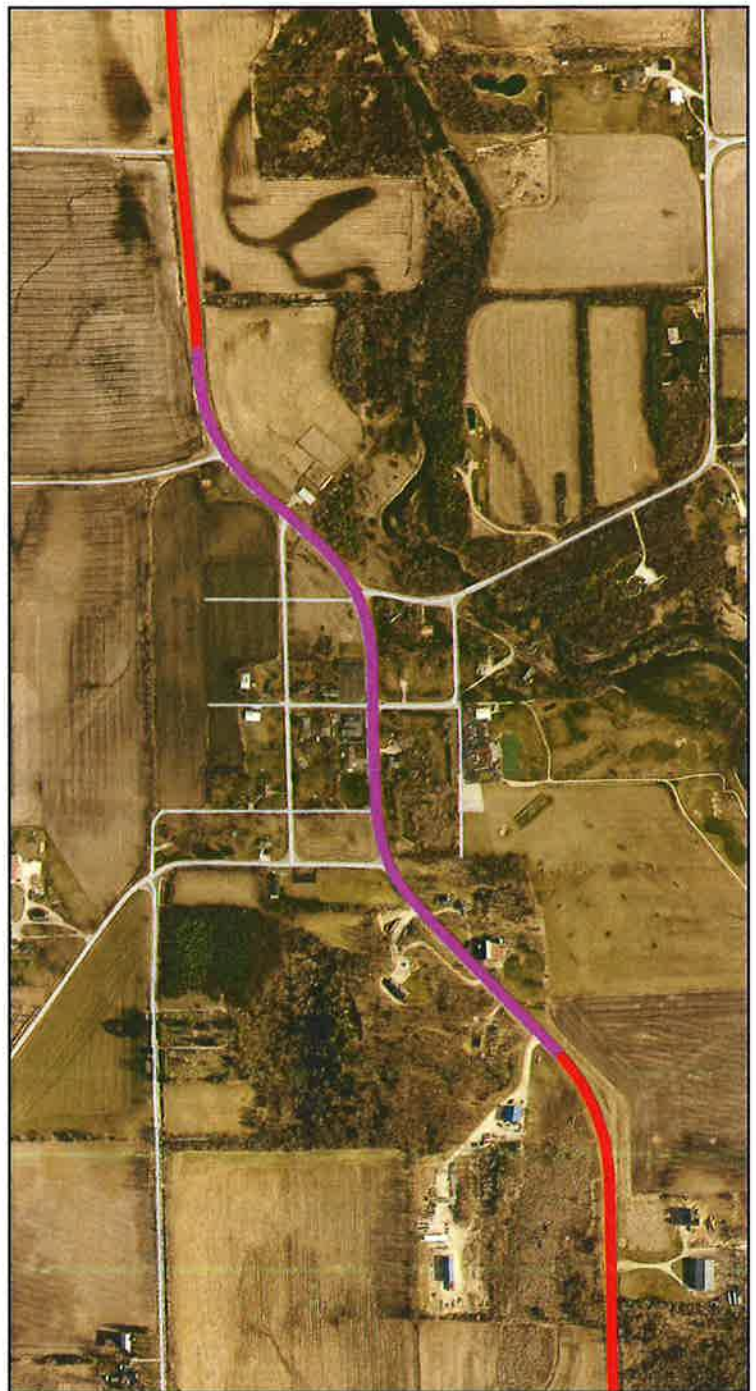
COLD SPRING, WI

Highway Operations Summary

June 2, 2026

General Maintenance

- Crews are engaged in sign maintenance, general bridge and guardrail/cable repairs.
- WisDOT DMA/LFA/TMA Contracts:
 - DMA for bridge deck sealing only.
 - LFA for concrete joint repairs on US12 under STH 26. Work has begun.
 - STH 106 Corridor TMA. Sign replacement project. In progress.
- Winter maintenance
 - State road salt bid is out to bid this year. We are planning to purchase county salt this year. Bids are due to the State by June 1st.
 - We received a state bid for Solar Salt of \$ 178.70 a ton. Last year we paid \$ 124.93 a ton. As a result, will not be purchasing Solar Salt this season to use in the brine maker and will use regular road salt to make brine.
- Crews have been removing and pouring concrete patches on STH 26.
- Crack sealing county highways continues when the schedule allows.
- Crews have finished the Concorde salt shed exterior shell replacement.
- Crews have been out ditching and cleaning culverts.
- Invasive weed and guardrail spraying has started.
- Mowing will begin June 1st.
- Pavement line striping has begun.
 - Dodge County is doing the retrace markings.
 - Dane County is doing pavement markings on projects.

Town/City/Village Projects

- **Town of Jefferson**
 - Markert Rd – Pulverize and Pave
 - Start date of July 6th.
- **Town of Oakland**
 - ~~Friedel Ave – Pulverize and Pave (LRIP):~~
 - Town has decided to do Potters Rd and Blue Jay Way.

 - Main St – Mill and Overlay

WisDOT Projects

- STH 89 between US 18 and Fort Atkinson was awarded to Payne and Dolan. 45 day working contract. WisDOT has indicated an early August start date.
- 94 and STH 26 interchange. Start date of April 27 and completion in August. Concrete pavement repair, bridge repairs, shoulder pavement overlay and ADA upgrades on sidewalks. Most of the work is taking place at night.

County Projects

- **CTH V (CTH B to CTH A):** Mill and Overlay. Completed April 23rd.
- **CTH P (CTH B to US 18):** Pulverize and Pave. Work began April 29th with a mid June completion. Asphalt paving started on May 18th.
- **CTH D (CTH E to CTH B):** Pulverize and Pave. Work is scheduled to begin June 22nd with a late August completion. (LRIP Project)
- **CTH D (CTH B to US 18):** Pulverize and Pave. Work is scheduled to begin August 31st with a early November completion. (LRIP Project)
- **CTH G (STH 89 to US 18):** Mill and Overlay. Work is scheduled to begin August 17th with a completion of middle September.
- **North Bus 26 Fort Atkinson:** Mill and Overlay. Work is scheduled to begin August 17th with a middle of September completion.
- **Korth Park:** Widen and pave walking path for Park Dept.

Office Updates

- Our spring auction with Hansen to sell a skid loader trailer, section chainsaws, outdated signs, old woodchipper, Veteran Services vehicle Human Services vehicle, Emergency Management vehicle and other miscellaneous items began on May 18th and will finish on June 10th.
- We had 1 new Highway Worker start on May 4th.
- Hiring effort for 2 open Highway Worker.
- 1 Highway Worker is retiring in July and will create a new vacancy.
- Local Small Structures Improvement Program was launched in early February.
 - Town of Ixonia applying for T Bar Ln
 - Town of Watertown applying East Gate Dr
- HVAC system upgrade was completed the week of May 11th.
- During one of April storms lightning damaged our diesel fuel pumps and our gate openers. We have filed a claim with our property insurance to repair the gate and fuel system. Fuel system is online. The gate system is offline and must be manually opened and closed.
- Abandoned vehicle on CTH B has been removed.
- May 19th, we attended the SW Region WisDOT Commissioner and Superintendent Meeting.

Equipment Updates

- Asphalt Roller bids were opened on Wednesday May 20th at 10 am. Please refer resolution for results.
- Writing spec for replacement woodchipper to replace the 2007 Bandit.
- 8 Kia minivans were ordered on May 18th through the State Vehicle Bid for the County Fleet Program. Chrysler bid was \$ 40,153 and Kia bid was \$ 38,018. Delivery will be in late July or early August. Kia will have better resale and have a better warranty of 10-year/100,000 miles versus the Chrysler 5-year/ 60,000-mile warranty.
