WHAT YOU WILL DO

The Highway Department seeks a detail oriented and organized Accounting Specialist to perform accounting and payroll tasks.

SOME ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

You will be successful in this role by completing the following tasks and responsibilities:

- Maintains electronic payroll system to ensure time, machinery, and materials are accurately accounted for in the Highway cost accounting system
- Monitor time off balances to ensure accuracy
- Reviews, monitors, and prepares department invoices, vouchers, and receipts before payment; assigns and verifies account numbers for accuracy; obtains vendor and account numbers as needed
- Creates Purchase Orders following the County's Purchasing Ordinance
- Prepares journal entries and vouchers and enters information into database; prepares and adjusts financial statements based on expense and revenue account activities; prepares month end entries to appropriately capture time and expense
- Maintains inventory accounts by receipting in and charging out inventory. Assists in year-end inventory count and corresponding journal entries.

Requirements:

• Two to three years related experience and/or Associate's degree and one year experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Preferred Requirements:

• Four years related experience and/or training; or a bachelor's degree from a college or university plus one year of experience; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
