They also expand the parks system for environmental and land use benefits, as well as, for the health and enjoyment of Jefferson County residents and others.

In order to maintain high quality parks, the department is looking to hire a summer worker that is experienced, dedicated, and passionate about our Parks system to assist with the below tasks:

- Operating vehicles and powered equipment, such as mowers, tractors, twin-axle vehicles, electric clippers, sod cutters, and pruning saws
- Caring for established lawns by mulching, aerating, weeding, grubbing, removing thatch, trimming, and edging around flower beds, walks, and walls
- Mixing, spraying, and spreading fertilizers, herbicides, and/or insecticides on grass, shrubs, and trees
- Completing general service on equipment including sharpening, greasing, oil changes, and general repairs and replacements
