Amending Traffic Ordinance to change speed limit on County Trunk Highway B (Johnson Creek School speed reduction)

Executive Summary

The Jefferson County Highway Department received a request from the Johnson Creek School District to lower the speed limit on County Highway B at the location of the new Johnson Creek Middle and High School. Speeds will be reduced to 45 miles per hour where the current speed is 55 miles per hour and be reduced to 35 miles per hour where the current speed is 45 miles per hour. After reviewing the request, the Highway Committee approved the following speed zone changes for County Highway B.

THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF JEFFERSON COUNTY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of the County Traffic Ordinance (Speed Zones on County Trunk Highways) is amended to include the following:

COUNTY TRUNK HIGHWAY "B", TOWN OF AZTALAN, JEFFERSON COUNTY

Forty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from a point 2,600 feet west of the Johnson Creek Village Limits to a point 1,120 feet west of the Johnson Creek Village Limits.


Thirty-five miles per hour for all vehicles from a point 1,120 feet west of the Johnson Creek Village Limits to the Johnson Creek Village Limits.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon passage, publication and erection of official signs.

Fiscal Note: Funds for the additional sign installation will come from the Highway Department General Maintenance Account No. 53311.



Resolution creating a full-time Nutrition Program Supervisor position and eliminating a vacant, full-time Nutrition Program Coordinator position at Human Services

Executive Summary

Jefferson County operates eight Senior Dining Sites, offering congregate dining and home delivered meal options. Congregate meals are available to individuals age 60 or older, regardless of income and home-delivered meals are available to any person age 60 or older who is homebound and has an assessed need. These meals provide a minimum of one-third of the daily nutritional needs for an older adult and follow the most updated Dietary Guidelines for Americans. In addition, special diets may be provided upon medical recommendation. According to the Wisconsin Aging Network, "the purpose of the Senior Dining Program is to provide nutrition services that assist older individuals to live independently, by promoting better health through improved nutrition and reduced social isolation through programs coordinated with nutrition related services."

The Senior Dining Program is funded with federal Older Americans Act dollars, United States Department of Agriculture funds, state tax dollars and county tax dollars. The program also relies heavily on voluntary contributions. Therefore, no fee is charged, but all individuals are encouraged to donate toward the meal.

After 37 years of service to Jefferson County, the current Nutrition Program Coordinator will be retiring on October 7, 2016. In addition, new federal guidelines mandate stricter requirements for senior dining sites, necessitating the need for a supervisor to manage the County's Nutrition Program. Therefore, the Human Services Director is requesting to eliminate the full-time Nutrition Program Coordinator position, upon the incumbent's retirement, and create a full-time Nutrition Program Supervisor position. On July 19, 2016, the Human Resources Committee met to discuss the request of the Human Services Director. In consideration of the changes in regulations and the forthcoming vacancy, the Human Resources Committee concurs and is recommending eliminating the full-time Nutrition Program Coordinator position and creating a full-time Nutrition Program Supervisor to oversee the Nutrition Site Managers, the volunteers and the overall Nutrition Program.

WHEREAS, the Executive Summary is hereby incorporated by reference into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, Human Services provides an invaluable service to older adults of Jefferson County by providing nutritious meals that allows our elderly to live independently and remain healthier, both physically and socially, and

WHEREAS, new federal guidelines under the Older Americans Act have mandated additional responsibilities for Senior Dining Sites that require a higher-level of monitoring and accountability, and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Director is requesting, and the Human Resources Committee is recommending, the elimination of one full-time Nutrition Program Coordinator position (upon the incumbent's retirement) and the creation of one full-time Nutrition Program Supervisor position to fulfill the requirements of new Nutrition Program federal guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the creation of one full-time Nutrition Program Supervisor position and the elimination of one full-time Nutrition Program Coordinator position at Human Services is authorized effective October 8, 2016, and the 2016 County Budget setting forth position allocations in the Human Services Department is hereby amended.

Fiscal Note: The eliminated Nutrition Program Coordinator position is fully funded in the 2016 budget. Upon retirement of the incumbent, \$15,500 in wages and \$8,800 will not have been expended. These amounts are sufficient to cover the \$10,900 in wages and \$4,700 in fringe benefits for the remainder of 2016 for the newly created Nutrition Program Supervisor position. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact. The Nutrition Program Coordinator position has an hourly wage of \$17.36-\$22.32. This range overlaps with the new Nutrition Program Supervisor position that has an hourly wage of \$20.90 - \$26.88. As a budget amendment, 20 affirmative votes are required for passage.

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors has heretofore been petitioned to amend the official zoning map of Jefferson County, and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment has been given due consideration by the Board of Supervisors in open session,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors does amend the official zoning map of Jefferson County as follows:

FROM A-1, EXCLUSIVE AGRICULTURAL TO A-3, AGRICULTURAL/RURAL RESIDENTIAL

Create a 2.2-acre lot around the existing home at **N9006 Branch Road**, and a 1.3-acre vacant lot adjacent to it. The site is part of PIN 012-0816-1231-001 (5 acres) in the Town of Ixonia. This utilizes the last available A-3 zone for the property; therefore rezoning is conditioned upon recording of an affidavit acknowledging that fact. It is further conditioned upon road access approval, receipt by Zoning of a suitable soil test for the vacant lot, and approval and recording of a final certified survey map. Rezoning shall be null and void and of no effect one year from the date of County Board approval unless all applicable conditions have been completed by that date. Supporting and authorizing Jefferson County to host 2019 Farm Technology Days

Executive Summary

Wisconsin Farm Technology Days is an excellent way to showcase Jefferson County, develop volunteerism and leadership roles and promote Jefferson County agriculture. Jefferson County businesses would receive significant economic benefits if selected to host Farm Technology Days according to a University of Wisconsin-River Falls study which found that the total economic impact of hosting Wisconsin Farm Technology Days was \$1.86 million, creation of 33 jobs, and generation of \$191,000 in additional taxes. One of the criteria used to select a host county is the amount of support and interest demonstrated by a prospective County's Board of Supervisors. This resolution formally recognizes Jefferson County's support and interest in hosting Farm Technology Days in 2019.

WHEREAS, the Executive Summary is hereby incorporated by reference into this resolution, and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Farm Technology Days is a jointly supported and planned effort by Wisconsin Farm Technology Days, Inc. and a host county's University of Wisconsin Extension Office; and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County last hosted this event in 1984, and a number of Jefferson County businesses and agricultural leaders have expressed interest and support in hosting the event for 2019, and

WHEREAS, the Jefferson County University Extension Education Committee believes that Wisconsin Farm Technology Days is an excellent way to showcase the County, develop volunteerism and leadership roles and promote Jefferson County agriculture and

WHEREAS, Jefferson County businesses would receive significant economic benefits if selected to host Farm Technology Days.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors hereby supports and authorizes Jefferson County's participation in hosting Farm Technology Days in 2019 if selected by Farm Technology Days, Inc. and a suitable site is found in Jefferson County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors recognizes the need to budget Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) in the 2017 County budget to be used prior to and/or during the 2019 Wisconsin Farm Technology Days event to support advance or ongoing activities and functions involved with the event, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors recognizes the need to budget an additional Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) in the 2018 budget to fund a limited-term Wisconsin Farm Technology Days, Inc. employee who will work prior to, during and following the 2019 Wisconsin Farm Technology Days event, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Jefferson County Board of Supervisors does authorize the Jefferson County UW-Extension Department Head to enter into a contract, after review and approval by the Jefferson County Administrator and Corporation Counsel, for services as may be necessary to host Wisconsin Farm Technology Days in Jefferson County in 2019.

Fiscal Note: This resolution will have no fiscal impact. If Jefferson County is selected to host Farm Technology Days, the fiscal impact will be addressed in the annual budget and future resolutions.
