<u>9a. Discussion and possible action on purchasing salt brine blending equipment and storage tanks</u>

Commissioner Kern updated the Committee regarding Jefferson County being a pilot county for the State of Wisconsin for brine usage on I-94 and STH 26 roadways. He stated there would be a need for more brine/blending systems and storage to do this. He stated that WisDOT has agreed to pay for the upgrade of the brine mixing equipment and storage at the three Highway Department sites. Jefferson County will be fully reimbursed for all costs totaling \$138,400.00. There would be an 8-10 year lease. The County would pay costs up front, and the State would reimburse us. This item would need to be forwarded by resolution to County Board.

It was moved by Mr. Schultz and seconded by Mr. Kannard to purchase and forward to County Board by resolution, the liquid salt brine blending equipment and storage additions for the three respective shops for \$138,400.00.
