Remnants of the water leak that they were fixing that went into the hole were carrying the containment. The water main was leaking that they excavated to repair. The soil in the area, not in the pressurized water main. All the containment seems to have leaked into the soil, CLEANUP: Water being pumped off into the sanitary sewer to be treated at the

- wastewater plant. Soil loaded onto a truck waiting on the paperwork to take it to a landfill (spoils from their excavation).
