<u>CTH "H" (STH 59 – CTH Z)</u>

Pavement was pulverized and re-graded. Asphalt binder mat is all complete, asphalt surface mat and pavement marking will be completed in July or August.

<u>CTH "P" (Rome – US 18)</u>

Pavement was pulverized and stabilization was completed on the north end of the project. Asphalt binder mat is complete. Crews are finished with landscaping work on lawns in Rome section.

CTH "B" (Dane County – Rock Lake)

Pavement was pulverized and re-graded. Paving work is ongoing.

CTH "SC" (STH 16 – Dodge County)

Right of Way purchasing is in progress

8a. Review 2010 annual financial report

Commissioner Kern and the Committee had discussion on revamping the current standing buildings, Briggs & Stratton building, and the Schweiger building. There was discussion on the satellite shops and state work in the future. Mr. Peterson commented on property taxes and the need to make sure our numbers used during future meetings are accurate. 9a. Discuss new state budget details and impacts on Highway Department

Highway Commissioner Kern discussed the state budget as it pertains to the Highway Department. He stated that with this new budget process, county forces are not permitted to cross county lines for construction purposes anymore. He noted that this is not something we do a lot and will not impact us greatly. He also discussed the restriction of work within city and villages, also noting this type of work is not something our forces do a lot. He stated that there has been a 9%-10% cut in transportation aids. He said the budget allowed more money for state maintenance, and we should see an extra increase due to the STH 26 lane mileage increase. He reiterated that the restrictions are primarily with local improvement and construction, not with maintenance. No Motion.

9b. Review monthly financial account summary

The Highway Commissioner reviewed the current financial status of the Highway Department and answered questions from the Committee. The Commissioner commented on county maintenance figures being up right now, due to seal coating work. No Motion

The Commissioner reviewed the operations with the Committee regarding current operations and the construction projects. He answered any questions the Committee had. No Motion.
